NINTH INNING RALLY FALLS SHORT IN 3-2 LOSS

The Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp mounted a ninth inning rally but fell just short in a 3-2 loss to the Memphis Redbirds Wednesday night. Trailing 3-0 in the ninth, Jacksonville (32-38) battled back against Memphis (36-34) reliever Kolton Ingram. Victor Mesa Jr. started the inning with a double and went to third on a groundout from Griffin Conine. Jonah Bride drove in Mesa Jr. with a base hit, cutting the deficit to 3-1. After a fly out, Tristan Gray drew a walk, pushing Bride up to second. Jhonny Pereda knocked a base hit, scoring Gray from second pulling the Jumbo Shrimp to within one. With runners on first and second. Jonathan Davis walked to load the bases but a fielder's choice in the next at-bat ended Jacksonville's threat.

X MARKS THE SPOT

In 2023, Xavier Edwards registered one of the most illustrious seasons in Jacksonville's Triple-A/Double-A history (1962-present). His .351 batting average was the best in club single-season history, with his .429 on-base percentage ranking second. Despite starting the season on the IL, Edwards has picked up right where he left off in 2024. The Coconut Creek, Fla., native has hits in 13 of his first 16 games with the Jumbo Shrimp, compiling a remarkable seven multi-hit contests. In all, he is 21-for-65, slashing .323/.362/.415/.777 with four doubles, one triple, three RBIs, four walks and four runs scored.

LITTLE GUY BIG RESULTS

Over his first 11 games in Triple-A, Javier Sanoja was just 6-for-39 (.154) at the plate. However, the 5-foot-7 Venezuelan struck out in only two plate appearances. His contact ability has manifested itself in a huge way of late: Sanoja has reached base safely in 33 of his last 38 games, notching 17 multi-hit contests. During this span, he is 53for-151 (.351/.406/.497/.903) with 10 doubles, three triples, two home runs, 25 RBIs, 16 walks and 22 runs scored.

STARTING FROM SCRATCH

Jacksonville starting pitchers have tossed scoreless outings in five of the last 10 games. During this stretch, Jumbo Shrimp lid-lifters have ceded only 11 runs nine earned on 27 hits (6.0 H/9) in 40.1 innings for a 2.00 ERA. Jacksonville starters have combined for 35 strikeouts against 13 walks during this stretch.

FRIENDS CLOSE, ENEMIES CLOSER

A remarkable 46 of Jacksonville's 71 games (64.8 percent) in 2024 have been decided by three runs or fewer, including 28 of the club's last 40 contests. After beginning the year 12-3 (.750) in these narrowly-decided contests, the Jumbo Shrimp have suddenly struggled in games determined by no more than three runs; Jacksonville has lost 23 of its last 31 games decided by three runs or fewer for an overall record of 20-26 (.435) in these affairs.

GRIFFIN-DOR, WHERE DWELL THE BRAVE AT HEART

In eight games from April 26-May 5, Jacksonville outfielder Griffin Conine suffered through a 2-for-30 (067) stretch with 12 strikeouts. In the 37 games since, however, the former Duke Blue Devil has gotten hot. Conine is 40-for-hislast-123, slashing .325/.413/.667/1.080 with nine doubles, 11 home runs, 30 RBIs, 19 walks and 26 runs scored. Among the 126 gualified hitters in the IL. Conine ranks 10th in HR/ FB (28.0 percent). The 26-year-old has has driven in at least one run in 20 of those 37 games.

ROAD IS WHERE THE HEART IS?

Jacksonville's 14-25 (.359) home record is the worst such mark in the IL, while the club's 18-14 (.563) road record is one of only eight winning away records in the circuit this year. On the road, the Jumbo Shrimp have scored 169 runs in 32 games (5.3 per game), more than a full run better than what they average at home (second-fewest in Triple-A) 149 runs in 39 games, 3.8 per game). The Jumbo Shrimp have surrendered 196 runs (13th-most) in 39 home games (5.0 per game) compared to 142 (second-fewest) on the road (4.4 per game).

WALKIN' IN MEMPHIS

Jacksonville returns to Memphis for the first time since taking four-of-six from April 23-28. Since joining the International League in 2021, the Jumbo Shrimp have had a lot of success playing in the friendly confines of AutoZone Park. Since that inaugural 2021 Triple-A season, the Jumbo Shrimp are slashing .291/.357/.479/.836 with 52 home runs, 222 RBIs at AutoZone Park Those 52 homers since 2021 are the third-most in an opposing team's ballpark, trailing Durham Bulls Athletic Park (Durham, 60) and Truist Field (Charlotte, 58).

-As a sophomore in 2019. Meyer was named an All-Big Ten Second Team Selection. He made 16 appearances on the mound, including 11 starts, and went 5-3 with a 2.11 ERA and two saves 76.2 innings. He fanned a team-high 87 batters. Meyer also played in 35 games, including 30 starts, on the infield, batting .256/.323/.314 with four doubles, one home run, 12 RBIs and 15 runs scored.

-A native of Woodbury, Minn., Meyer played hockey at Woodbury High School, lettering for three seasons as a forward. He was selected by the Minnesota Twins in the 34th round of the 2017 draft, but opted to pitch collegiately at the University of Minnesota.

-Both of Max's parents, Kathy and Kent, played collegiately while attending St. Olaf College (Northfield, Minn.). Kent was a member of the Oles' football team while Kathy played on the school's women's soccer team.

2024 SEASON

-Optioned to Jacksonville on April 15.

2023 SEASON

-Did not pitch while recovering from Tommy John Surgery.

2022 SEASON

-Meyer made his major league debut for the Marlins on July 16 by throwing 5.1 innings with five strikeouts in a game against the Philadelphia Phillies at loan Depot park. He made two starts before undergoing Tommy John surgery on August 9.

-Meyer needed just 53 pitches (38 strikes) to strike out eight in 5.0 perfect innings before departing with a calf cramp on April 12 at Durham.

2021 SEASON

-Meyer was promoted to Jacksonville on September 23 from Double-A Pensacola. With the Blue Wahoos, he led Double-A South in both ERA (2.41) and batting average against (.226) while ranking second in both strikeouts (113) and WHIP (1.23) and fourth in IP (101.0).

-Meyer's 10 strikeouts in his Triple-A debut on September 24 against Memphis were the most for any Jacksonville pitcher in a level debut since at least 2005.

-Selected to the SiriusXM All-Star Futures Game, Meyer threw just seven pitches to two batters, getting Adley Rutschman (Baltimore Orioles) to fly out to left before walking Nick Pratto (Kansas City Royals).

ADDITIONAL CAREER NOTES

-Meyer competed for the USA Collegiate National Team in both 2018 and 2019. In 2018, he picked up seven saves with a 3.38 ERA in eight appearances, striking out a team-leading 15 batters in 8.0 innings. In 2019, he appeared in four games, including three starts, and recorded a 0.64 ERA across 14.0 innings with 12 strikeouts. He was named Outstanding Pitcher of the 2019 USA vs. Cuba International Friendship Series.
