YESTERDAY: The Flying Squirrels snapped a three-game losing streak and a two-game scoreless streak with a 2-1 win over the Senators. **Seth Lonsway** started and threw 5.2 scoreless innings, allowing one hit with seven strikeouts. **Evan Gates** closed his second save of the season with two hitless innings. Richmond took a 2-0 lead with a two-run single by **Adrian Sugastey** in the top of the fourth inning. Harrisburg broke the shutout with a solo homer by Maxwell Romero in the seventh, one of just two hits in the game for the Senators.

TODAY'S GAME: The Flying Squirrels play the fourth of a six-game road series against the Harrisburg Senators, Double-A affiliate of the Washington Nationals. The two teams played in Harrisburg's first home series at FNB Field from April 9-13, with Richmond taking two-of-six in the series. The Flying Squirrels have been outscored 29-2 in the series.

PACKING THE HOUSE: Last year, the Flying Squirrels led all 30 Double-A teams in average (6,595) and total (435,295) attendance. Among the 120 MiLB teams, the Flying Squirrels were 10th in average attendance. It was the third straight year the Flying Squirrels led all 30 Double-A clubs in average and total attendance, which had not been done prior to 2022. Last year's total attendance is the highest since 2013 (434,769) and the fourth-highest average in team history. April 4 marked the 15th consecutive Opening Night sellout, marking every home opener in franchise history to date. This year, the Flying Squirrels are averaging 6,894 fans per home game, which ranks second among all 120 MiLB clubs. Their average of 7.290 in the season's first month was the highest April attendance in franchise history.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS split last week's series against the Patriots, winning three straight games from Thursday through Sunday for their longest win streak of the season. Their 9-21 start is the worst in franchise history. The 2015 Flying Squirrels started 3-2 before losing a franchise-record 15 consecutive games, falling to 3-17. They snapped the losing slide with a six-game win streak and finished the year 72-68, one game out of a postseason spot.

THE SENATORS have won seven-of-their-last-10 games, including taking four-of-six last week at Reading. Harrisburg lost four straight games to open the season but have gone 15-11 since. The Senators are second in Eastern League in hits (243), first in total bases (399) and rank tied for first in homers (30). Harrisburg's roster includes three players ranked in Baseball America's top-30 Nationals prospects, including RHP Jarlin Susana (No. 3), 3B Cayden Wallace (No. 9) and 1B/3B Yohandy Morales (No. 22). Harrisburg's roster also featured three players included in MLB.com's top-30 Nationals prospects list, including Susana (No. 2), Wallace (No. 10) and Morales (No. 12).

FOR RICHMOND: Left-hander Joe Whitman makes his sixth start of the season and his second against Harrisburg. On Saturday, Whitman threw six perfect innings against the Patriots at The Diamond, retiring all 18 batters he faced, and set a career high with 10 strikeouts. He was named Eastern League Pitcher of the Week on Monday. In his first full professional season last year, Whitman split the year between Low-A San Jose and High-A Eugene, going 3-8 with a 4.63 ERA in 23 starts. He finished the year ranked ninth in the Giants organization in strikeouts (108) and tied for ninth in games started. Whitman was selected in the second round of the 2023 MLB Draft by the Giants out of Kent State, where he was the MAC Pitcher of the Year that season. Before transferring to Kent State near his hometown of Akron, Ohio, Whitman pitched at Purdue. Entering 2025, Whitman was ranked by Baseball America as the No. 10 Giants prospect and No. 7 by MLB.com. For more on Whitman, see page two.

FOR HARRISBURG: Right-hander Miguel Gomez makes his fourth start and 11th appearance of the season. He last pitched out of the bullpen on Tuesday and threw a scoreless inning. He also pitched against Richmond in April, allowing one run over 3.1 combined innings. In three starts this year, Gomez has a 3.52 ERA (3 ER/7.2 IP) compared to a 7.27 ERA (7 ER/8.2 IP) in his seven relief outings. Gomez signed with the Nationals in 2019 as an international free agent. He split last season between Low-A Fredericksburg and High-A Wilmington, going 4-2 with a 2.84 ERA in 34 outings. This year is his first season at Double-A.

DON'T RUN ON RICHMOND: The Flying Squirrels' catching unit of **Adrián Sugastey** and **Zach Morgan** have combined to throw out 18 stolen base attempts this season, which is tied for first among all 30 Double-A teams and leads the Eastern League. Sugastey is tied for second in Double-A with 10 runners caught stealing, which is tied for first the EL. Morgan is fourth in the EL with eight.

THE BRYCE IS RIGHT: Northern Virginia native **Bryce Eldridge** returned to the Richmond roster last Tuesday after missing the start of the season with an injury. He hit a solo home run in his first plate appearance of the year. The 20-year-old first baseman played at four levels in the Giants organization in his first full professional season last year, including nine games with Richmond in September. For the year in 116 games, Eldridge hit .291 with 23 homers and 92 RBIs. He is ranked by Baseball America as the No. 11 prospect in baseball. Eldridge is also the fifth Virginia-born player to suit up for the Flying Squirrels in franchise history. On Thursday, he tied his Double-A high with three hits. After batting .111 (1-for-9) in his first three games of the season, Eldridge is batting .317 (13-for-41) in his last 10 games.

HOWELL AT THE MOON: Carter Howell opened the season batting .189 (14-for-74) in his first 20 games through April 26. In his last eight games dating back to April 29, Howell is batting .297 (11-for-37) with three homers, two doubles, five RBIs, four walks and six runs scored. After hitting three homers in his first 136 Double-A games, he homered three times over a five-game span from last Wednesday through Sunday. On Monday, he was named Eastern League Player of the Week for the first time. Last year, Howell was named Richmond's Player of the Year and led the Eastern League in doubles (30) and triples (7) and leading the Flying Squirrels in batting average (.272), OBP (.347), SLG (.391), OPS (.738), hits (121), runs (64) and stolen bases (15).

GO, DIEGO, GO: Diego Velasquez had his league-leading 13-game hitting streak snapped on Sunday afternoon. In those 13 games from April 18-May 2, Velasquez hit .392 (20-for-51) with a homer, four doubles, eight RBIs and eight runs scored. In his 69 games with Richmond dating back to last year, Velasquez is batting .314 (79-for-252). His 13-game hit streak was the longest since a 13-game streak by **Shane Matheny** in 2022.

CLOSING THE DOOR: On Thursday, Tyler Myrick closed the 14th save of his Flying Squirrels career, tying ninth place on the franchise's all-time list with Brett Bochy (2012) and Melvin Adon (2019, 2022). In his Richmond career dating back to 2023, Myrick has converted 82.4 percent of his save attempts, which is tied for fifth-highest in franchise history (min. 15 attempts). In 2023 between Richmond and High-A Eugene, Myrick went 15-for-15 in save attempts, the only pitcher in MiLB with a perfect mark and at least 12 tries.

IN THE LEAGUE LEADERS: In the Eastern League, **Diego Velasquez** is tied for first in hits (33) and seventh in batting average (.314). **Jairo Pomares** is tied for fifth in homers (5). **Jack Choate** is tied for seventh in strikeouts (34). **Seth Lonsway** is 10th in ERA (2.45), seventh in innings pitched (29.1), eighth in BAA (.184) and eighth in WHIP (1.06).

TOP SKIPPER: Flying Squirrels manager **Dennis Pelfrey** has led the team to 213 wins in his career, which is three away from tying the franchise's all-time wins record for a manager. From 2011-2013, **Dave Machemer** won 216 games as Richmond's manager, leading the team to the Eastern League postseason for in 2011. Pelfrey, who has been with Richmond since the 2022 season, led the team to back-to-back postseason appearances for the first time in franchise history in 2022 and 2023. He also managed the 2021 Eugene Emeralds to the High-A West championship.

AWARDS SWEEP: On Monday, **Carter Howell** was named Eastern League Player of the Week after homered three times against Somerset and **Joe Whitman** was named Eastern League Pitcher of the Week after throwing six perfect innings on Saturday with 10 strikeouts. It marked the fifth time in franchise history the team has swept the league's weekly awards, joining **Daniel Mayora** and **Justin Fitzgerald** (July 9-16, 2012), **Steven Duggar** and **Andrew Suarez** (July 18-24, 2016), **Brett Auerbach** and **Wil Jensen** (August 1-7, 2022) and **Grant McCray** and **John Michael Bertrand** (May 20-26, 2024).

PROSPECT WATCH: Richmond's roster includes seven players are ranked in Baseball America's top-30 Giants prospects, including Bryce Eldridge (No. 1), Joe Whitman (No. 10), Diego Velasquez (No. 13), Sabin Ceballos (No. 16), Trent Harris (No. 26), Aeverson Arteaga (No. 27) and Jack Choate (No. 28). There are also seven players ranked in MLB.com's top-30 Giants prospects list, including Eldridge, (No. 1), Whitman (No. 7), Harris (No. 11), Velasquez (No. 15), Arteaga (No. 16), Ceballos (No. 23) and Choate (No. 27). Eldridge is also ranked No. 11 overall by Baseball America and No. 22 by MLB.com.

THIS DATE IN RICHMOND BASEBALL HISTORY

1959: The Richmond Virginians beat the Columbus Jets, 9-8, at Parker Field. Richmond scored four runs in the bottom of the ninth to win the game. Columbus pitcher Dick "Lefty" Lines, who went to Manchester High School in Midlothian, left the game with an 8-5 lead, helped by his own two-run homer in the second inning. In the ninth, Fritz Brickell hit an RBI triple, Bill Shantz knocked an RBI single and Mike Baxes won the game with a two-run double. **1971:** The Richmond Braves swept a double-header against the Tidewater Tides. In the first game, Jim Breazeale hit a go-ahead, pinch-hit double in the sixth for a 6-5 win. Tommie Aaron, Darrell Evans and Fred Velazquez each homered. The R-Braves won the second game, 7-2, with starting pitcher Rick Kester striking out 11 batters over his seven innings in a complete game. 2014: The Flying Squirrels beat the Sea-Wolves, 7-6, in 13 innings. Rich¬mond led, 5-2, entering the ninth, but the Erie scored three to force extras. After the SeaWolves took a 6-5 lead in the 13th, Myles Schroder won the game in the bottom of the inning with a two-run single. Richmond set a fran¬chise record with eight stolen bases in the game. Kelby Tomlinson set the franchise single-game record with five steals and had three hits.
