Tonight's Game: The Sounds and Redbirds play game three of their series in Memphis before coming to Nashville to finish out the week. The Redbirds rallied three times and Thomas Saggese was the hero, hitting a walk-off three-run homer for a 13-11 win in 10 innings. Right-hander Chad Patrick is back on the bump for Nashville. He'll face left-hander Connor Thomas.

Chad Patrick: The 25-year-old makes his 15th appearance and 13th start of the season. He's 7-1 with a 2.89 ERA (74.2 IP/24 ER) and leads Nashville in wins, innings pitched, strikeouts (76), WHIP (1.14) and tied for the team lead in starts. Patrick made his second relief appearance of the campaign on June 27 at Jacksonville. He allowed two runs (both earned) on five hits with five strikeouts in three innings. Patrick entered in the sixth inning, with the Sounds trailing the Jumbo Shrimp 8-0. The Indiana native leads the league in ERA, opponent batting average (.217) and win percentage (.875). He also ranks among league leaders in WHIP (2nd, 1.14), wins (T-3rd) and strikeouts (8th). The last time out against Memphis, Patrick turned in a quality start, holding the Redbirds to three runs (all earned) on seven hits and four walks in 6.0 innings. Since his start at Louisville on April 26, Patrick is 7-1 with a 2.77 ERA (61.2 IP/19 ER). He is also holding left-handed hitters to a .191 average (25-for-131). Patrick was traded to Milwaukee from Oakland on November 15, 2023 in exchange for infielder Abraham Toro. He was originally selected in the fourth round of the 2021 First-Year Player Draft out of Purdue University Northwest.

Connor Thomas: The 26-year-old makes his 33rd appearance and first start of the season tonight for Memphis. The left-hander is 3-2 with a 3.31 ERA (49.0 IP/18 ER) in what is his fourth season playing for the Redbirds. Thomas has faced Nashville in four games this season - April 9, April 12 (Game 2), April 14 and June 1. The Sounds have yet to score a run off Thomas in 5.2 innings this season (3 H, 3 BB, 5 K). Thomas worked 3.1 innings at Gwinnett on June 29. He got the final out in the fifth then got through the eighth inning. However, the Stripers would score a pair in the ninth for a walk-off win. The 3.1 innings last time out was his longest outing in both innings and total pitches in 2024. Since making his Memphis debut on May 29, 2021, Thomas has made 103 appearances and 56 starts for the Redbirds and is 20-22 with a 4.57 ERA. Though he has never won any league awards, Thomas was named the Arizona Fall League Pitcher of the Year in 2022 for the Salt River Rafters. The Georgia Tech alum was taken in the fifth round of the 2019 First-Year Player Draft by the Cardinals.

About Last Night: The Sounds and Redbirds traded the lead three times in last night's game. It was just the second time that Nashville has lost when scoring double-digit runs since joining the International League in 2021 - the only other occasion came at Memphis on August 19, 2021 (L 12-11 in 10 innings). The Sounds tied a season high with five doubles (4th time), while Memphis became the first team to hit five homers off Sounds pitching since July 14, 2022 vs. Memphis. After starting the season 5-0 in extra-inning games, the Sounds have dropped five of their last six in extras. James Meeker, Ryan Middendorf and Nick Bennett each suffered a blown save last night. Per MLB Research Tool, it is the first time the Sounds have had three blown saves in a game (data going back to the 2005 season). The last team to blow three saves in a game in the International League was Syracuse on August 31, 2023 at Lehigh Valley.

Black is Back: Since being optioned by Milwaukee on June 30, Tyler Black has had multiple hits in two back-to-back games, including a two-run homer last night. He's 4-for-7 with three RBI, three walks and three runs scored. Since June 1, Black is batting .296 (16-for-54) with 14 RBI, 10 walks, a .415 on-base percentage and .989 OPS.

Collins Crushing: Isaac Collins doubled and walked last night. That double was his 22nd of the season, putting him in a tie with Buffalo's Spencer Horwitz on the International League doubles leaderboard. Collins leads the league with 36 extra-base hits and is ninth in the IL with 51 runs scored.

Triples is Best: Patrick Dorrian came through with an RBI triple in the fourth inning as part of a multi-hit, multi-RBI night. The Sounds have 29 triples as a team, the most in the International League. It's the most for a Nashville team since having 47 in the 2018 season.

The Sweet Life: Manager Rick Sweet is in his fourth consecutive season as the Sounds manager (5th overall) and his 34th season as a manager in MiLB. Sweet is the winningest manager in Nashville Sounds history, earning his 321st victory in the 2023 season finale vs. Jacksonville. This is his 11th season as manager of the Brewers' Triple-A affiliate and boasts a 725-624 record (Nashville in 2014, Colorado Springs from 2015-18, San Antonio in 2019 and Nashville 2021-). Overall, Sweet has a career managerial record of 2,317-2,144 - that's the fifth most wins in MiLB history and second among active managers (only Buddy Bailey with Single-A Myrtle Beach has more).

Sounds Manager Rick Sweet ranks fifth among Minor League managers in wins. He has the second-most among active managers, trailing Single-A Myrtle Beach manager Buddy Bailey.

LAST OUTING: Last Thursday at Jacksonville, Patrick entered with the Sounds trailing 8-0 in the sixth inning. He pitched the final three innings for Nashville and allowed a pair of runs on five hits with five strikeouts.

AGAINST OPPONENT: This is Patrick's third career start against Memphis - each of the previous two have also come at AutoZone Park. He took a no-decision in the series finale on April 14 (4.0 IP, 4 R, 4 ER). Patrick then got a win in a quality start on May 29 (6.0 IP, 7 H, 3 ER).

- Held Omaha to a couple of hits and a run over six innings for first quality start of season on April 19
