TAKE A BREATH PEOPLE: After back-to-back wins filled with late-game dramatics in Fayetteville, the series between the FredNats and Woodpeckers is tied at two wins apiece heading into the weekend. Tonight, Washington's 7th-best prospect Cade Cavalli begins his journey back to DC in his first rehab start of the year with Fredericksburg. The FredNats are currently tied with the Lynchburg Hillcats for second place in the Carolina League North Divison, four games behind the league-leading Carolina Mudcats. In addition to Cavalli, rehabbing Major League pitcher Zach Brzykcy will also make his second appearance of the week for Fredericksburg at some point in today's game.

MORE ON CAVALLI: Washington's first round draft pick (22nd overall) in 2020 out of Oklahoma, Cavalli led all of Minor League Baseball in 2021 with 175 strikeouts and made it all the way to Triple-A in his first full year. He started that year with High-A Wilmington, so this is the first time he's ever suited up for the FredNats in any capacity. He made his Major League debut on August 26, 2022 in DC against the Cincinnati Reds, but to date, that is his only Major League outing. He had Tommy John surgery on March 22, 2023, and made three rehab starts with Wilmington last summer before he was shut down due to the flu and dead arm. This is the first official game he will appear in since July of last year.

**CARDIAC FREDDIES:** The FredNats have had a flair for the dramatic through the first 13 games of the year. Five of the first 13 have been decided by one run, two games have gone to extra innings, and there's been three total walk-offs - one win and two losses. Out of Fredericksburg's five wins this season in nine inning games (two of the team's victories came in a 7-inning doubleheader), the Freddies have had the lead after eight innings only once. In the ninth inning of Thursday's game, Merrick Baldo allowed three hits and walked a man but managed to not allow a run to hold on to the save for FBG.

THIS BULLPEN IS LEGIT: The FredNat bullpen continues to be a dominant unit for Fredericksburg. After covering seven more innings last night and allowing just two earned runs, the unit has lowered its season ERA to 2.81, which is best in the Carolina League and tied for the second best in all of Single-A baseball. Last night it was two innings from Kevin Dowdell, two innings from Ryan Minckler, two innings from Robert Cranz, and then the first career save for Austin Amaral in the 12th.

**CLUTCH MOTA:** Jorgelys Mota has shown the clutch gene so far in this series in Fayetteville. The 19-year-old third baseman has a gametying or go-ahead hit in the 8th inning or later of three out of the four games in this series so far. He hit a game-tying two-run homer in the 8th inning of Tuesday's game, drove in the eventual winning run in the top of the 9th of Thursday's game, and last night, hit a gametying two-run double in the 8th inning. He then drove in another run in the 12th inning with a ground-rule double off a position player.

**ROSTER BREAKDOWN:** While the FredNats don't have a ton of Top-30 prospect talent on this Opening Day roster, the team does have a wealth of experience returning, with 20 players out of 30 on the Opening Day roster having played for the FredNats before, and eight returners who played in the 2024 playoffs. Additionally, nine members of Washington's 2024 draft class appear on the Opening Day roster. Opening Day roster players that participated in the 2024 playoffs include Merritt Beeker, Adam Bloebaum, Robert Cranz, Alexander Meckley, Kevin Bazzell, Jorgelys Mota, Nate Ochoa and Cristhian Vaquero.

**2024 CHAMPIONS**: The 2024 Fredericksburg Nationals won the franchise's sixth total Carolina League championship last September, defeating the Kannapolis Cannon Ballers two games to one to capture the crown. It was the franchise's first since moving to Fredericksburg in 2020, and the first since the Potomac Nationals won the Carolina League in 2014. The FredNats broke the Charleston RiverDogs' run of three titles in a row, and became the first non-Charleston team to win the league since MiLB realigned to its current leagues in 2021.

**NEW SKIPPER IN TOWN:** After Jake Lowery's third season as Manager of the FredNats ended in a Carolina League championship in 2024, the FredNats welcome Billy McMillon as the third Manager in Fredericksburg franchise history. McMillon, 53, has spent the last three seasons in the Nationals organization as the Development Coach for Triple-A Rochester. Prior to joining the Nationals, he coached for over a decade in the Boston organization, managing at all four full-season levels and also spending three seasons (2016-18) as the organization's base running and outfield coordinator. He also played parts of six seasons in the Major Leagues with Oakland, Detroit, Philadelphia and Florida. He's joined on the staff by returning Pitching Coach Justin Lord, returning Hitting Coach Mike Habas, Development Coach Luis Ordaz, returning Athletic Trainer Jacob Meyer, Strength & Conditioning Coach Mike Reiskind, and Performance Analyst Samantha Unger.

A LASTING LEGACY: The Fredericksburg Nationals adopt the franchise history of their predecessors in the Carolina League dating back to 1978...the Alexandria Dukes (1978, 1980-83) and Alexandria Mariners (1979) played at Four Mile Run Park in Alexandria, Virginia...the Prince William Pirates (1984-1986), Prince William Yankees (1987-1988), Prince William Cannons (1989-1998), Potomac Cannons (1999-2004) and Potomac Nationals (2005-2019) played at G. Richard Pfitzner Stadium in Woodbridge, Virginia...the franchise has won six Carolina League championships, as the Dukes in 1982, as the Yankees in 1989, and as the Nationals in 2008, 2010 and 2014. The franchise won its first league title as the Fredericksburg Nationals in 2024.

**WELCOME TO FXBG:** Steven Cade Cavalli, on an MLB rehab assignment after having Tommy John surgery in 2023, is set to make his first ever appearance for the FredNats. The 2020 first round pick started his career in A+ Wilmington in 2021 and climbed all the way to AAA Rochester in the same year. He never made a stop in Fredericksburg during his trip up the Nationals system.

**GOT THE CALL:** Two years after being drafted, Cavalli made his MLB debut in 2022 for the Nationals, striking out six in 4.1 IP in a start against the Cincinnati Reds at Nationals Park. To this date, that is his only MLB appearance. He has remained a top-10 Nationals' prospect, currently ranked by MLB Pipeline as the seventh-best in the system.

**UP THE LADDER:** During Cavalli's rise up the ranks in 2021, he posted a 1.77 ERA in A+ Wilmington (40.2 IP, 71 K's), a 2.79 ERA in AA Harrisburg (58.0 IP, 80 K's) and a 7.30 ERA in AAA Rochester (24.2 IP, 24 K's). He started and finished the 2022 season in Rochester, spinning a 3.71 ERA across 97.0 IP with 104 strikeouts.

**LAST YEAR:** Cavalli also spent last year rehabbing from his 2023 surgery, making two starts in A+ Wilmington: 3.18 ERA in 5.2 IP, 8 K's. In both 2024 and 2025, he has also thrown simulated games at the Nationals' facility in West Palm Beach, FL.

## **BILLY MCMILLON - MANAGER**

1st Season | Previously: Development Coach, Triple-A Rochester

McMillon, 53, joined Washington in 2022 and has spent the last three seasons as the Development Coach for Triple-A Rochester. McMillon played parts of six Major League seasons with four different organizations, including the Oakland Athletics (2001-04), Detroit Tigers (2000-01), Philadelphia Phillies (1997), and Florida Marlins (1996-97). The former Clemson Tiger was a three-time International League All-Star and the 1996 IL Rookie of the Year with Charlotte, earning him induction into the IL Hall of Fame in 2019 and Charlotte's Round Table of Honor in 2022. McMillon was initially selected in the eighth round of the 1993 MLB Draft by Florida. He replaces Jake Lowery, who managed the FredNats the last three seasons, culminating in a championship last year. Lowery will manage High-A Wilmington in 2025.

Prior to joining Washington, McMillon coached in the Boston Red Sox organization for over a decade. He managed the Worcester Red Sox (Triple-A) in their inaugural season in 2021 after managing Boston's former Triple-A affiliate Pawtucket in 2019. He was set to lead the PawSox again in 2020 before the cancellation of the MiLB season. Prior to managing at the Triple-A level, McMillon was the Minor League Outfield and Baserunning Coordinator for Boston from 2016-18 after managing for six seasons in the organization with Double-A Portland (2014-15), High-A Salem (2012-13), and Single-A Greenville (2010-11). His coaching career began in 2008 when he was Greenville's Hitting Coach.



#### JUSTIN LORD - PITCHING COACH

3rd Season | Previously: Pitching Coach, Double-A Harrisburg

Lord, 45, returns to Fredericksburg for a third season in 2025 after leading the FredNats' championship pitching staff last season, including the 2024 Carolina League Pitcher of the Year Travis Sykora.

This is Lord's fifth total season coaching in the Washington organization after a six-year professional playing career and several seasons coaching in the Baltimore system. The Alabama native and Florida State alum was scheduled to be the Fredericksburg Pitching Coach in the canceled 2020 season, and was the Pitching Coach for one season in Double-A Harrisburg prior to joining the FredNats in 2023.



#### MIKE HABAS - HITTING COACH

2nd Season | Previously: Hitting Coach, ACL Brewers

Habas, 34, returns to Fredericksburg from the 2024 championship staff for his second season with Washington after leading the FredNat offense to a highly successful season, finishing in the top third of the league in virtually every meaningful offensive category.

Prior to joining the Nationals, he spent spending the previous four seasons coaching in the Milwaukee Brewers organization, most recently as the Hitting Coach for the ACL Brewers in 2022 and 2023. Prior to joining Milwaukee, he was an Assistant Coach for the independent Gary SouthShore RailCats. While coaching with Gary, he was also the Head Coach at Prairie State College, a Junior College in the Chicago area.



#### LUIS ORDAZ - DEVELOPMENT COACH

1st Season | Previously: Manager, FCL Nationals

Ordaz, 49, joins the FredNat coaching staff in the Development Coach role after managing the Florida Complex League Nationals in 2024.

He played parts of seven seasons in the Major Leagues, appearing in 206 career games with the St. Louis Cardinals, Kansas City Royals and Tampa Bay Devil Rays. Ordaz has coached in the Washington organization for over a decade, and was the Hitting Coach for the Potomac Nationals for four seasons from 2016-19. He replaces Carmelo Jaime, who will manage the FCL Nationals in 2025 after three seasons in Fredericksburg.
