SUNDAY'S RECAP: The New Hampshire Fisher Cats hit three more home runs and defeated the Portland Sea Dogs 10-8 on Sunday afternoon from Hadlock Field in the series finale. New Hampshire recorded a season-high 16 hits in the game and the offense has now hit six homers in the last two games after not hitting one in the first four games of the series. An Orelvis Martinez two-run homer over the Maine Monster in the first inning gave the Fisher Cats a 2-0 lead, his 13th home run of the season and his 10th homer of the month, which is a new Fisher Cats record. Riley Tirotta's RBI single into center field extended the first inning lead 3-0. Leo Jimenez launched his first Double-A home run with a two-run homer over the batters eye at an estimated 435 feet in the fourth inning. Zac Cook's two-run home run added some insurance in the eighth, his third homer of the season to right-center. On the mound, starting right-hander Adam Kloffenstein went five innings, allowing eight hits, six runs and two walks while striking out eight, receiving the win. He now leads the Eastern League in strikeouts and innings pitched with 59 over 46 innings pitched. Relievers Connor Cooke and Mason Fluharty threw scoreless innings out of the bullpen and **Troy Watson** picked up his fifth save of the year with a 1-2-3 ninth.

HOME RUNS AT HADLOCK: In the last two games, New Hampshire has scored 21 total runs and hit six total home runs after scoring only 13 runs and hitting zero home runs in the first four games of the series. Orelvis Martinez hit his 10th home run of the month on Sunday, a new Fisher Cats record for most home runs in a month. Martinez has 13 homers on the season, good for second in the Eastern League.

WHOLE LOTTA TIROTTA: In his first series with the Fisher Cats this season, Riley Tirotta went 3-for-9 with three RBIs four walks and four runs scored, including his first hit and RBI on a double off the Maine Monster in the fifth inning of the first game of Saturday's doubleheader. Tirotta drove in another run in the series finale with a base hit to center in the first inning. The corner infielder batted .303 with three homers and 16 RBIs in 27 games with High-A Vancouver to start the season before being promoted to Double-A.

CALL ME MAYBE: Three Fisher Cats in the past week have received promotions to Triple-A Buffalo. Left-handed pitcher Jimmy Burnette was promoted last Tuesday, infielder Trevor Schwecke was promoted last Thursday and right-handed pitcher Hagen Danner was promoted on Tuesday. They are the third, fourth and fifth Fisher Cats to be promoted to Buffalo this month, along with left-handed pitcher Sean Mellen and infielder Luis De Los Santos, Prior to their call ups. Burnette had not allowed a run in six May outings, Schwecke recorded his first five-RBI game of his career with his second career grand slam on Sunday, May 21 in game two of the doubleheader and Danner had struck out 16 over nine innings thrown this season.

WELCOME TO NEW HAMPSHIRE: In corresponding moves, right-handed pitcher TJ Brock and infielder Rainer Nunez have both been received from High-A Vancouver. Brock, a 6th round pick by the Blue Jays out of Ohio State in the 2022 Draft, posted a 1.77 ERA in 20.1 innings to start the season with 31 strikeouts over just nine walks. Nunez, a 2017 international free agent signing and the Blue Jays No. 26 prospect, has hit .309 with three homers and 26 RBIs with a .836 OPS. This is both Brock and Nunez's first stints at Double-A.

THIS DAY IN FISHER CATS HISTORY (May 30, 2018) - The Fisher Cats extended a win streak to five games with a 5-3 win over the Sea Dogs. The Fisher Cats hit three homers. Cavan Biggio's 13th in the first inning made it 2-0. Conor Panas in the seventh with a solo shot. Ryan Hissey led off the bottom of the eighth with his first homer break the tie.

MANCHESTER-BOSTON REGIONAL AIRPORT FLIGHT TO THE MAJORS: Toronto (28-26) won the series in Minnesota after a 3-0 shutout win on Sunday. Jose Berrios pitched 5.1 scoreless innings against his former club. The Blue Jays host Milwaukee for three games beginning tonight ...Triple-A Buffalo (24-27) lost four of six to Lehigh-Valley. The Bisons will host St. Paul for six games this week High-A Vancouver (24-20) won five of eight at Spokane. Two of the games were make up games after originally being postponed in April. They host Eugene this week... Class A Dunedin (24-21) split the series vs Fort Myers and will go to Clearwater this week.
