Searching For Success.... With a 4-3 win on Saturday, the Hot Rods are looking for their fourth series win of the season. Sunday games have been one of the biggest challenges for Bowling Green this season, logging a 1-4 record in finales. The pitching staff has posted a 5.18 ERA, while the lineup is hitting .212 on Sundays. This is just the second time this year that a series has come down to a Sunday matchup and the first time since April 19 in Greenville against the Drive.

Harrison the Hurler.... Trevor Harrison makes his fifth start of the season on Sunday against the Emperors. The righty has recorded at least five strikeouts in eavhe of his last three starts, logging a season-high six punchouts on April 17 in Greenville. Harrison has held opponents to a .224 batting average this season, bat has issued three walks in three of his four starts this season.

Gillen Gets On Base.... Theo Gillen has reached base safely in his last nine games. During this stretch, he has gotten on base at a .405 clip, collecting nine hits and six walks while driving in eight RBI. Not only has Gillen reached base, but he has also stolen six bases over the last five games. Gillen has mounted the longest base stealing streak for any Hot Rods hitter this season.

Santa Maria's Surge.... Infielder Tony Santa Maria has reached base safely in his last 15 games. The streak is the second-longest for any Hot Rods hitter this season, trailing only Adrian Santana reached base in 18 consecutive games between April 3 and April 28. During the streak, Santa Maria is hitting .275 (11-for-40) with one double, one homer, and 12 RBI. He has also walked 14 times with a .491 OBP. Overall, Santa Maria leads all Bowling Green hitters with a .462 OBP.

Goodbye Gary.... The Rays No. 26 prospect, Gary Gill Hill, was promoted to Double-A Montgomery. The righty joined the Hot Rods in 2025, starting 25 games for Bowling Green. Overall, Gill Hill was 10-8 with a 3.96 ERA with the Hot Rods. His last start was his best of the season, going 6.0 frames, allowing just one unearned run while striking out a season-high seven batters. Gill Hill joins T.J. Fondtain in Montgomery, both getting a promotion during the first month of the season.
