PAPILLION, NEB. - The Storm Chasers won the opening game of the series against the Indians Tuesday at Werner Park, with a 7-4 victory.

- As both teams met for the first time in 2024, Indy struck first 3-0, as four hits and three walks scored in the opening three frames, one in the 1st inning and two in the 3rd, with a stretch of 5 straight batters retired between the first and third innings.
- In the bottom of the 3rd inning, the Storm Chasers answered with their first runs of the game, quickly tying the score at 3-3 ... With hits in his first three plate appearances, **Nick Loftin** drove in his first Triple-A run of the season as **Drew Waters** scored on a Loftin single that got Omaha on the board 3-1 ... After a **Logan Porter** single loaded the bases, **Devin Mann** and **Cam Devanney** had a pair of forced ground outs that each drove in two runs to tie the game.
- The scoring continued in the bottom of the 4th inning, as **Tyler Tolbert** hammered his first of two singles to plate **Mike Brosseau** for a 4-3 Omaha lead ... Waters followed with a single to put runners on the corners and Loftin rocked his third hit of the night to left field to bring Tolbert home, then Mann followed with a single of his own and drove in Waters to increase the first Chaser lead of the night to 6-3.
- Starting pitcher **Daniel Lynch IV** earned his 2nd win on the year, striking out 6 batters over 5.0 innings to tie season-high ... He allowed an additional run in the 5th inning on a groundout to move the score to 6-4 in favor of Omaha, but worked through the end of the 5th to qualify for a win before **Jake Brentz** came in behind him.
- Brentz walked his first two batters in the 6th inning, but a double play and strikeout got him out of the inning, before handing the ball off to **Dan Altavilla**.
- Altavilla put 3 runners on in the top of the 7th inning but worked out of trouble with a double play ball that kept Indianapolis off the board for a second straight frame.
- Devanney added insurance in the bottom of the 7th inning with his fourth homer of the year to extend Omaha's lead back up to three runs at 7-4 ... That home run capped off Devanney's fifth multi-hit game of the year, the third-most on the team.
- Steven Cruz** took the mound in the top of the 8th inning and struck out one in a scoreless inning before **Will Klein** followed him with a 1-2-3 9th inning that featured a pair of strikeouts to secure his third save of the season and finish off a 7-4 win.

### NOTES AND NUGGETS

#### RELIEF AID

- Four Storm Chasers relievers totaled 4.0 scoreless innings yesterday, the 6th time in 2024 the Omaha bullpen combined for a shutout performance.
- Of the 6 games where Omaha's bullpen shut out the opponent behind the starting pitcher, 5 of them have been 4.0 innings or more ... the season high is 6.0 scoreless innings, on March 29 (Opening Day) vs. Iowa).
- In all 6 scoreless bullpen efforts, the pitchers have combined to allow 3 hits or less ... they threw 4.0 hitless innings on April 20 @ Nashville and 3.0 innings without a walk on April 14 vs. Gwinnett.
- Omaha's 3.92 ERA (45 ER in 103.1 IP) ranks 3rd out of the 20-team International League and 5th among the 30 Triple-A teams ... The Storm Chasers bullpen has combined to hold opposing hitters to a .203 average (76-for-375), which is the 3rd-best mark among Triple-A teams ... a .663 OPS against the relievers also ranks 3rd.

#### I'M DIFFERENT, YEAH, I'M (RUN) DIFFERENT(IAL)

- Omaha has outscored its opponents 131 to 101 this season, a +28 run differential.
- A +28 run differential ranks as the 2nd-best in the International League and 5th in Triple-A ... Buffalo (TOR) ranks ahead of Omaha in the IL at +2 while Sugar Land (HOU) leads the Triple-A level with a +41 run differential.
- Omaha ranks 2nd in the Royals organization, behind Single-A Columbia at +42 ... High-A Quad Cities is just behind Omaha at +24.

#### ALEXANDER THE GREAT

- Infielder **CJ Alexander** has been one of Omaha's top hitters early in the season, leading the team in many categories.
- Alexander leads the International League with 23 batted balls over 100mph or greater, 2nd-most in Triple-A... the next-closest Storm Chaser is **Drew Waters** with 13 100mph batted balls.
- He leads Omaha in homers (5), extra-base hits (11) and total bases (41 ... he is tied for the team lead in runs scored (16), doubles (6) and runs batted in (14).

#### WATERS WORLD

- Outfielder **Drew Waters** went 1-for-3 on Tuesday, one of Omaha's most consistent hitters in 2024.
- He enters today having reached base in 14 straight games, the longest streak among Storm Chasers hitters this season ... since May 5, he is hitting .352 (19-for-54) with a .462 on-base percentage ... Waters has hits in 11 of 14 games in this stretch, with a walk in 8 of 14 games, including the last 5.
- Waters currently leads the Storm Chasers in batting average (.328), on-base percentage (.423) and OPS (.960), as well as hits (22), tied for the team lead in runs scored (16) and doubles (6).
- Of the 22 players that have at least 200 plate appearances with Omaha since the start of the 2022 season, Waters has the highest slugging percentage (.563), OPS (.964), BABIP (.404) and wRC+ (149).
