#### LAST TIME OUT

**MOOSIC, PA (March 31, 2023)** – The Scranton/Wilkes-Barre RailRiders celebrated Opening Night with a 2-1 victory over the Buffalo Bisons. Jake Bauers was the hero of the game with two solo home runs in back-to-back at bats. The bullpen shined with 5.2 clean innings of work, notching eight strikeouts and no walks.

Bauers got things started with a deep shot to center field in the bottom of the second off Bisons starter Casey Lawrence to take a 1-0 lead. Buffalo countered with a run of their own in the top of the fourth. Wynton Bernard reached on an error and was able to move to second base. He sprinted to third tagging up after a fly out. Ernie Clement doubled Bernard home for the Bisons only run of the game.

Bauers countered for the RailRiders in the bottom half. This time, a line drive to right field cleared the fence for his second homer of the contest, giving Scranton/Wilkes-Barre a 2-1 lead over Buffalo.

Randy Vasquez got the start on Opening Day throwing three and a third allowing just one unearned run on three hits. Walks got the best of him as he issued five, including loading the bases with them in the first. Vasquez recorded six strikeouts.

Matt Bowman \*(1-0) notched the win after tossing 1.2 solid innings, his first frames since 2019. He inherited one runner and stranded him on the base paths. Bowman tallied two strikeouts. \*Matt Krook proved his reliever status with a clean sixth and seventh. He got five strikeouts under his belt. Nick Ramirez \*took the eighth and set down the side in order. \*Greg Weissert was strong in his first outing of the season, facing the minimum in the ninth for the save. The pitching staff struck out 14 batters while issuing just five walks.

Lawrence (0-1) took the loss despite striking out eight over five innings.

Scranton/Wilkes Barre evens out their home opener record to 17-17 with the win.

#### NEWS & NOTES

**ATOP THE YANKS FARM** – The RailRiders will showcase top prospect Oswald Peraza (#3 per MLB prospect rankings in the Yankees system) alongside outfielder Elijah Dunham (#18). Randy Vasquez (#14) and Sean Boyle, (#29) will both be essential parts of the pitching staff. Peraza made his big league debut at the end of last season and even aided the Yankees in their postseason race.

**BOWMAN IS BACK** – Matt Bowman had not seen the mound since 2019 when he was with the Cincinnati Reds. It was his fourth season with Major League time. In the bigs he holds a 4.02 ERA in 181.1 innings. Bowman has totaled 149 strikeouts between Cincinnati and Saint Louis. Although originally signed by the New York Mets, the Yankees signed him before both the 2021 and 2022 seasons. Last night he came back with a vengeance throwing 1.2 clean innings. He inherited a runner and stranded him on the base paths. In his 15 pitches, 13 were strikes. Bowman recorded two groundouts and two strikeouts in the five batters he faced.

**BAUERS POWER** - Jake Bauers showed off his power last night with two homers in consecutive at-bats to provide the team's only offense. This is the first time in his career that he has had two long balls in one contest. The last time a RailRider hit two home runs in a game was on September 11, 2022 at Durham by Chris Owings.

**BEHIND THE PLATE** - Rodolfo Duran, Mickey Gasper, and Jose Godoy open the season as new manager Shelley Duncan's options behind the plate. Godoy has big league time with both Minnesota and Pittsburgh. Duran and Gasper are set to make their Scranton/Wilkes-Barre debuts. Gasper is one of just five players on the roster drafted by the New York Yankees.

**PITCH CLOCK VIOLATION**- Starter Randy Vasquez committed the first pitch clock violation of the season. He took too long to come set on the mound to deliver his pitch and an automatic ball was issued to his batter. The pitcher has :14 to come set with the bases empty and :19 seconds with runners on. While this ruling was in Triple-A last season, it is its first year making an appearance in the majors.

**KROOK KRUSHED** - Matt Krook has switched to the bullpen at the start of this season and looked spectacular in his debut. After spending most of his professional career as a starter, towards the end of last summer he migrated to the bullpen. In the 2023 opener, he tossed two frames as the third man out. He threw 21 strikes out of 34 total pitches. Issuing no free passes, he struck out five batters of the seven he faced. Krook received a hold for his efforts.

**OPENING DAY IN THE BOOKS** - RailRiders baseball in Scranton/Wilkes-Barre history dates back to 1989 when the team opened as the Red Barons. In 2007 they transitioned the name to the 'Yankees' and again in 2013 to the 'RailRiders' where it remains today. The organization is now 17-17 in their home openers with a win last night. They move to 13-21 in their overall season openers.

**WEISSERT STRONG** - Greg Weissert made his first appearance of the season last night and recorded a three out save. He induced two ground outs and one line out. Weissert had a phenomenal season in 2022 as the RailRiders closer. Greg Weissert also pitched his way into the record books. He became the third Scranton/Wilkes-Barre player and first RailRider to win the International League's top pitching honor. He was named as both the league's Pitcher of the Year as well as the top relief pitcher. Weissert appeared in 42 games for the RailRiders in 2022, going 2-1 with 18 saves and a 1.69 ERA while striking out 70 over 48 innings pitched. The Yankees signed the right-hander to a Major League deal on August 25 and he made his big league debut that night. With New York he pitched 11.1 innings and recorded three wins before returning to Scranton/Wilkes-Barre.

**PICKED OFF** - Randy Vasquez recorded two pickoffs last night to notch important outs. Rob Brantly took a walk to first but Vasquez fired quickly to Billy McKinney to catch him off the bag. Later in the game Otto Lopez was taking a large lead off of first base. As he took off for second, Vasquez sent the ball to McKinney. McKinney tossed to Peraza covering second base and Peraza sent it back to McKinney who put the tag on the runner. After a 1-3-6-3 coordinated play, Lopez was caught stealing.
