FROM THE CROW'S NEST

THE VOICE: Pirates southpaw Steven Brault makes his first rehab start today for the Marauders. The Southern California native was placed on the 60-Day IL on April 1 with a left lat strain and was scheduled to start on Tuesday. Brault made 13 starts for the Marauders in 2015 (his first year in the Pirates organization) before being promoted to Double-A Altoona. He made his debut the following summer on July 5, 2016 in St. Louis. Brault last pitched in a live game in Spring Training on March 19 vs Baltimore

ENDY'S GAME: Endy Rodriguez had a team-best eight-game hitting streak end in Game 2 of Thursday's doubleheader, but the Dominican Republic native has still hit safely in nine of his last 10 games, batting .333 during that stretch. Rodriguez also leads the team with 15 multi-hit games, including a three-hit performance on Wednesday, which matched his season-

WALK THIS WAY: With 26 walks drawn in the series, the Marauders are now second in the Low-A Southeast with 333 walks, helping boost Bradenton's team OBP to .364 (third in the league). This comes despite facing a Clearwater pitching staff that has issued the second-fewest walks (258) in the league

EXCELLENCE FOR ESCOTTO: Maikol Escotto went 0-for-3 Saturday night, ending an 18-game on-base streak, his second-longest of the season (19 games, May 5-June 1). He still ranks second on the team with 40 hits despite missing two weeks while on the injured list in the first half of June.

AMONG THE BEST: The Marauders rank second in the Low-A Southeast in runs (339), home runs (54), and slugging percentage (.382). Bradenton's pitching staff also owns Minor League Baseball's fifth-highest strikeout total (660), behind only San Jose, Modesto, Fort Myers, and Somerset.

THE OPPONENT: The Marauders and Threshers are facing off for their first head-to-head series this season, and are in town for their first of two visits to LECOM Park in 2021 (Clearwater will visit Bradenton again August 17-22). The Threshers won each of their last two series (4-games-to-2 at home against both Daytona and St. Lucie).

TOP PROSPECTS: The Marauders roster currently includes eight prospects in MLB Pipeline's Top 30 ranking for the Pirates organization: Hudson Head (#5), Eddy Yean (#12), Jared Jones (#16), Sammy Siani (#18), Nick Garcia (#20), Endy Rodriguez (#25), Alexander Mojica (#28), and Dariel Lopez (#29). Three of the eight (Head, Rodriguez, and Yean) came to the organization via blockbuster trades. Head and Rodriguez came from the Padres and Mets, respectively, in the three-team Joe Musgrove deal, and Yean came from Washington in the Josh Bell trade.

UNDER NEW MANAGEMENT: New Jersey native Jonathan Johnston is in his first season as Marauders manager. The U.S. Naval Academy graduate spent two seasons as a catcher in the Oakland Athletics system in 2008 and 2011 in between a collective five years in the Navy as a Surface Warfare Officer. Prior to joining the Pirates organization in 2020, he held coaching roles at UC San Diego and UNC Asheville

MISCELLANEOUS: The Marauders own the Low-A Southeast's second-best run differential at +66 (Tampa is second in all of MiLB at +167, trailing only Everett's +174)... Five Marauders players rank within the league's top five in home runs: Jase Bowen and Hudson Head are tied for second in the league with 8; Endy Rodriguez and Sammy Siani are tied for third with 7 HR each, and Alexander Mojica's 6 HR is tied for fourth... Eli Wilson is in the league's top 10 in batting average (.338, 7th), OBP (.486, 4th), and OPS (.986, 7th).
