TODAY'S GAME / OPPOSING STARTER: The Curve open a split series with the Harrisburg Senators, the Curve are 7-2 against the Senators this vear

Hyun-il Choi makes his second start of the season against Altoona. The Curve put 7 runs on him in 5.1 innings on May 17. Choi originally signed with the LA Dodgers in 2018 and reached Triple-A Oklahoma City. The Nationals picked him in the minor league Rule 5 this past off-season and after allowing 14 runs in 8.1 innings in 4 appearances at Triple-A Rochester, he's settled into the Harrisburg rotation where he's recorded a 3.73 ERA in 12 starts. Choi features a good splitter, curveball and low-90's heater with his splitter being his best offering.

A MAJOR CROWD: Altoona welcomed 9,165 fans to PNG Field on Thursday, July 3, the 3rd-largest crowd in franchise history for a regular season game.

CIM CIM CIMILLO: First baseman Nick Cimillo has reached base safely in 10 straight games, punctuacted by a walk-off 2-run homer on Thursday, July 3 at PNG Field. Cimillo has 10 RBI in his last ten games and is recording a .782 OPS since June 20.

A NEW FUTURE: Outfielder Esmerlyn Valdez was promoted to Altoona, along with C Omar Alfonzo, on July 1. Valdez, who leads the South Atlantic League in nearly every major hitting category, was also chosen to represent the organization in the MLB All-Star Futures Game on Saturday July 12 at Atlanta's Truist Park, Valdez is the 23rd Curve player to participate, joining Bubba Chandler (2024), Henry Davis (2022) and Roansy Contreras (2021) as recent selections.

CLOSE WINS: Each of Altoona's last 10 wins (since June 18) have all come in a save situation for the bullpen. 40 of the team's 77 games this year (52%) have been decided by two runs or fewer.

ROCK THROWERS: Since June 2, Altoona pitchers are 3rd among Double-A teams with a 2.86 ERA. The team has allowed the fewest runs and earned runs (87, 71) and issued the 2nd-fewest walks (72) in 223.1 IP. Alessandro Ercolani (3.00 ERA, 10 ER / 27.0 IP) and Blake Townsend (1.37 ERA, 3 ER / 19.2 IP) have been two of the top performers of late with five others (Brandon Bidois (6.0 IP), Beau Burrows (12.1 IP), Ryan Harbin (4.1 IP), and Justin Meis (11.2 IP)) that are unscored upon since June 2 with Altoona.

A NEW GUY WHO THROWS HARD: Righty Ryan Harbin blew away the Baysox in his Double-A debut on Tuesday, June 24. Harbin, who has not allowed a run since May 13 set down all 5 men he faced in his team debut, earning 3 strikeouts. Since he last allowed a run on May 13, Harbin is 2-0 in 21.0 IP, 10 H, 12 BB, 34 K (.145 BAA). He has tossed a scoreless outing in 22-of-25 outings this season between Greensboro and Altoona.

Righty Brandon Bidois tossed two scoreless on Wednesday, June 25 at Chesapeake for his Double-A debut. Bidois struck out three of the 14 batters by Curve pitchers in the win. The Austrailian native has been unscored upon in 18-of-20 outings this season, going 1.0+ IP in 11 of his 20 outings this year, totaling 34 strikeouts in 29.0 innings this year.

CY YOUNG?: Lefty Cy Nielson has struck out 41 batters this season, 5th-most by an Eastern League reliever. Nielson has collected at least one strike out in 34-of-35 career outings with the Curve, racking up 73 in 54.0 IP.

THE TERMINATOR AGES: Infielder Termarr Johnson, who has not vet faced a pitcher younger than him in his professional career, turned 21 on June 11. Johnson played 67 games at Double-A, the third-most by a player under the age of 21 in franchise history. Andrew McCutchen (138 games) and Jose Tabáta (83 games) are the only players in franchise history to play more games than Johnson béfore their 21st birthday.

In his last 22 games, Johnson is 25-for-86 (.291) with 4 2B, 2 HR and 6 RBI. He had his first 3-hit game of the season on June 20 against Richmond and has 8 multi-hit games in his last 22.

WEATHERFORD BOYS: The Curve roster features two Weatherford, TX natives in Beau Burrows and Brenden Dixon. Burrows, who signed with the Pirates on May 12 out of the Mexican League has tossed 9 scoréless outings with Altoona allowing just 4 hits and 2 walks with 14 strikeouts in 12.1 innings.

Dixon is batting .280/.431/.420/.851 OPS in his last 19 games, recording four multi-hit games since May 27. He's reached base safely in 16-of-19

ITALIANISSIMO: Righty Alessandro Ercolani has dialed in throughout his first trip through the Eastern League. In 8 of his 15 outings this season. he's allowed 1 run or fewer. Held under an innings count in the first half of the year, Ercolani is working on the best walk rate of his career, walking only 17 in 58.2 IP. His 2.62 BB/9 innings is the best mark of his career.

WE'LL SEE THEM ALL: For the first time since the 2019 season and the creation of the six-game series, the Curve will face every team in the Eastern League this season. Altoona will face New Hampshire and Binghamton on the road only, while Hartford and Reading will only play the Curve at PNG Field.

Andy Fox is the 16th manager in Curve history. Fox's coaching ca-reer has seen him serve in several roles, including time with the Rang-ers, Mariners, Marlins, and Red Sox. He spent the last 14 years in Boston's system, serving as the team's infield coordinator and first base coach. Prior to his time in Boston, Fox served as a first base coach for the Marlins and managed the Rangers Single-A Clinton team in 2006. Fox was drafted in the 2nd round of the 1989 Draft by the Yankees and won two World Series in his nineyear Major League career with New York (1996) and the Florida Marlins (2003) as an infielder.

Matt Ford **Pitching Coach** 1st season/12th overall

Ford joins the Curve in 2025 after serving as the Pitching Coach for Low-A Bradenton in 2024. This is his 12th season serving as an in-structor in the Pirates system, pre-viously serving in the FCL (2022), Greensboro (2021), as the team's Rehab Pitching Coordinator (2019-20), Bradenton (2017-18), both West Virginia clubs (2015-2016) as well as with Bristol (2014). Ford was Toronto's third round pick in 1999 and made his Major League debut with the Brewers in 2003. He pitched in 25 games and made four starts in his lone Major League season. He began his coaching career at the University of Akron in 2012.

Scott Seabol Hitting Coach 1st season/10th overall

Seabol comes to Altoona after spending the 2024 season as the Hitting Coach in Bradenton. This is his second season as a Pirates minor league instructor. He joined the Pirates after four seasons as a hitting instructor in the Miami Marlins system (2020-2023) and the New York Yankees (2016-2019). Seabol was drafted by the Yankees in 1996 out of West Virginia University and played 60 Major League games with New York (2001) and the St. Louis Cardinals (2005). His 14-year playing career wrapped up in 2009 after a season in Korea and two seasons in Japan. He is a native of McKeesport, PA.

Casey Harms Hitting Coach 1st season/11th overall

Harms begins his fifth season as a Pirates instructor in 2025 and ioins Altoona after serving as Greensboro's Bench Coach in 2024. Harms joined the Pirates in 2021 as the Hitting Coach in the FCL. He played outfield at Division III Occidental College in Los Angeles and went on to coach in the collegiate ranks at UC Santa Barbara (2013-2018) and Santa Barbara City College (2019-2021). He also spent two seasons as the Manager for the Waterloo Bucks in the Northwoods League (2019-20) and led the team to a 28-13 record and a league championship in 2020.

Gary Green Bench Coach 4th season/20th overall

Green returns for a fourth season in Altoona and his 20th season as a minor league instructor with the Pirates. He has previously served as the Bench Coach in Indianapolis (2022) as well as the Minor League Infield Coordinator/Roving Field Instructor for the Pirates (2011-2021). A Pittsburgh native, Green's father, Fred, won a World Series with the Pirates in 1960. Green spent 11 seasons managing in the Tigers minor league system (99-10). A former Major League infielder for parts of five seasons, Green was drafted 27th overall by the Padres in 1984 and played on Team USA in the 1984 Olympic Games.


