**TONIGHT:** The Stripers play game three of a six-game series vs. the Durham Bulls (Tampa Bay Rays) at Coolray Field. It is the ninth of 18 games between the two clubs this season, and the third of 12 games to be played in Georgia. Tonight is the **Whole Hog BBQ** and **Thirsty Thursday™** presented by **Michelob Ultra** (fans age 21 and older can get select 12 oz. domestic beers for \$2 each and Cutwater margaritas for \$5 each).

**VS. DURHAM:** Gwinnett is 64-60 (.516) in 124 games vs. Durham all-time at Coolray Field, including 1-1 (.500) through two meetings so far in 2022. The Stripers are 7-4-1 in season home series vs. the Bulls dating back to 2009, including 2-0-1 over the last three seasons (2018-21).

**MULLDOZING:** Tonight's scheduled starter **Kyle Muller** is 3-2 with a 2.15 ERA (11 ER in 46.0 IP), 0.85 WHIP, .188 BAA, 10.57 SO/9.0 IP ratio (54 SO) and six quality starts in his last seven outings since 6/2. His last start on 7/8 vs. Charlotte (G1 of DH) was a 7.0-inning complete game (6 H, 2 R, 0 BB, 8 SO in 3-2 win), the fourth CG of his career.

• **IL Leaderboard:** **Muller leads the league in strikeouts (110)** and ranks among the top 10 in ERA (2nd, 2.95), WHIP (2nd, 1.08), complete games (T-2nd, 1), BAA (3rd, .217), innings (4th, 88.1), and starts (T-6th, 15).

**TARNOK TAMES DURHAM IN TRIPLE-A DEBUT:** Making his Triple-A debut yesterday, **Freddy Tarnok** pitched 6.0 innings (2 H, 1 R, 1 ER, 1 HR, 1 BB, 4 SO) for the win. He is the first Gwinnett pitcher to log a quality start in his Triple-A debut since **Jeremy Walker** on 9/2/18 vs. Charlotte (win, 8.0 IP, 3 H, 0 R, 1 BB, 6 SO in 2-0 victory).

• **Dominant Stretch:** Including his final four starts with Double-A Mississippi from 6/18-7/7, Tarnok is 2-0 with a 1.67 ERA (5 ER in 27.0 IP), .167 BAA (16-for-96), and 11.67 SO/9.0 IP ratio (35 SO) over his last five starts.

• **Triple-A Debuts:** Tarnok, Atlanta's No. 6 prospect according to MLB.com, is the seventh player to make his Triple-A debut for Gwinnett this season (joins **Justin Dean**, **Greyson Jenista**, **Braden Shewmake**, **Victor Vodnik**, **Allan Winans**, and **William Woods**).

**KINGS OF THE "K":** Stripers pitchers lead the International League in strikeouts with 858 in 86 games. That's third-most in Triple-A behind Round Rock (1st, 879) and Sacramento (2nd, 859) of the Pacific Coast League. Gwinnett has not led Triple-A in strikeouts since 2011 (club record 1,223 SO in 143G). **Kyle Muller** (1st, 110), **Tucker Davidson** (4th, 83), **Huascar Ynoa** (7th, 77), and **Bryce Elder** (T-17th, 66) all rank among IL leaders in strikeouts.

**DESHIELDS KEEPS REACHING:** **Delino DeShields Jr.** drew his team-leading 43rd walk (T-11th in IL) and recorded his team-leading 19th stolen base (T-7th in IL) yesterday. He has reached base safely in 49 of 59 games (83.1%) with a plate appearance with Gwinnett season, batting .262 (44-for-168, 6 2B, 1 HR, 26 R, 16 RBI, .732 OPS).

**CAN'T TOUCH TONKIN:** **Michael Tonkin** pitched the ninth inning (1.0 IP, 0 H, 0 R, 0 BB, 1 SO) and earned his team-leading seventh save (T-6th in IL) yesterday. **The outing extended his scoreless streak to 13.2 innings, the third-longest active streak in the IL.** The streak has covered his last 12 appearances since 6/5, a stretch in which Tonkin has posted a 0.66 WHIP (6 H, 3 BB), .128 BAA, 14.49 SO/9.0 IP ratio (22 SO), and four saves (4-for-4).

**TUI TO THE FUTURES GAME:** On 7/7, MLB announced the rosters and coaching staffs for the 2022 SiriusXM MLB All-Star Futures Game on 7/16 at Dodger Stadium. Stripers manager **Matt Tuiasosopo** has been selected as the third base coach for the National League Team, led by former MLB manager **Mike Scioscia**. Tuiasosopo will be the first active Gwinnett coach to participate in a Futures Game.

**DEMERITTE ALWAYS ON:** **Travis Demeritte** has reached base safely in 173 of 204 career games (84.8%) with Gwinnett since 2019, batting .277 (195-for-705, 51 2B, 4 3B, 43 HR, 131 R, 139 RBI, 17 SB, .913 OPS). He is one of three players in Gwinnett history with two 20-homer seasons, joining **Stefan Gartrell** and **Ernesto Mejia**.

**OLTS IN JULY:** **Alex Dickerson** is batting .333 (10-for-30, 1 2B, 1 3B, 3 R, 4 RBI, .797 OPS) in nine games this month, leading the team in total bases (13). **Mike Ford** is batting .444 (4-for-9, 3 2B, 1 RBI, 1.323 OPS) in three games over two stints with Gwinnett this month.

**GO-GO GETTING ON TRACK:** **Ryan Goins** is batting .377 (20-for-53, 6 2B, 6 R, 9 RBI, .932 OPS) over his last 16 games since 6/14. He has notched six multi-hit games in that span, raising his season average from .143 to .212.

**THE ELDER STROLLS:** **Bryce Elder** matched his career high with 8.0 innings on 7/9 vs. Charlotte (6 H, 3 R, 3 ER, 1 HR, 2 BB, 4 SO), earning the win. It was his second career 8.0-IP outing, first since 5/30/22 vs. Louisville (2 H, 0 R, 1 BB, 8 SO in 2-0 win). Elder is the first Stripers pitcher to win consecutive starts this season (2-0, 2.63 ERA, 4 ER in 13.2 IP, 1.10 WHIP, .200 BAA in last 2 starts since 7/2).

**CASTEEL IN THE CLUTCH:** **Ryan Casteel** notched a game-winning two-run single in the sixth of the Stripers' last-at-bat 3-0 win on 7/8 vs. Charlotte (G2 of DH), his first last-at-bat GWRBI with the Stripers. It was a rare single for Casteel, who has notched 13 extra-base hits (5 2B, 1 3B, 7 HR) among his 21 total hits this year (61.9%). For his Gwinnett career, 48.2% of his hits have been for extra bases (27 of 56, including 11 2B, 1 3B, 15 HR).

**WATERS MOVING ON:** On 7/11, the Atlanta Braves traded top prospect OF **Drew Waters** to Kansas City as part of a deal to acquire the No. 35 pick in the MLB Draft. The 23-year-old switch hitter batted .246 (173-for-702, 34 2B, 4 3B, 18 HR, 113 R, 64 RBI, 36 SB) in 178 games with Gwinnett since 2019. This season, Waters hit .246 (47-for-191, 7 2B, 3 3B, 5 HR, 26 R, 16 RBI, 5 SB) in 49 games.

**PROSPECTING:** Gwinnett's active roster features six listed on the MLB.com Atlanta Braves Top 30 Prospects list: LHP **Kyle Muller** (1), RHP **Bryce Elder** (2), INF **Braden Shewmake** (3), LHP **Tucker Davidson** (5), RHP **Freddy Tarnok** (6), and RHP **Victor Vodnik** (10). Of that group, only Shewmake, Tarnok, and Vodnik have yet to make their Major League debuts.

### MANAGER MATT TUIASOSOPO

**Matt Tuiaosopo** is in his second season as the manager of the Stripers in 2022 ... He was named the seventh manager in Gwinnett history on 3/30/21, making him the first former Gwinnett player to manage the club (played OF/1B from 2016-17) ... In 2021, he guided the Stripers to a 71-58 record (3rd in Triple-A East Southeast Division) ... On 5/4/21 at Charlotte, he became the youngest manager in Gwinnett history (34 years, 11 months, 25 days) ... On 6/9/22 at Jacksonville, he became the fourth manager in Gwinnett history to reach 100 career wins ... **On 7/7/22, was selected as the third base coach for the NL Team for the 2022 SiriusXM MLB All-Star Futures Game (7/16 at Dodger Stadium)** ... Began his career with Class-A Rome in 2019, earning Atlanta's Bobby Cox Award for MiLB Manager of the Year.
