DURHAM BULLS (O-O) AT NASHVILLE SOUNDS (O-O) RHP CALVIN FAUCHER (NR) VS. LHP ETHAN SMALL (NR)

TODAY'S GAME

The Bulls begin their 2021 Triple-A National Championship title defense on the road in Nashville with a 6-game set versus the Sounds. RHP **Calvin Faucher** is slated to get the nod for Durham in the season opener, with LHP **Ethan Small** set to toe the rubber for Nashville.

TAKE THAT AND REWIND IT BACK

The Bulls finished the 2021 campaign with an 86-44 record (.662), the best winning percentage over the course of a full season in franchise history. Durham ended the year on a high note, winning 9 of their final 10 games to also claim the Triple-A Final Stretch postseason tournament. In addition to recording the most wins of any MiLB club in 2021, the Bulls also matched fellow Rays affiliate, Single-A Charleston, with a +263 run differential.

Bulls vs. Sounds

Durham & Nashville begin a 6-game series, marking the 1st time the Bulls and Sounds have played each other. The Sounds are 1 of 2 new clubs Durham are scheduled to face this year, with the Bulls slated to face off in a 6-game road series against the Worcester Red Sox between August 2-7.

LET'S GET IT STARTED

This year marks the 2nd consecutive season Durham has begun their season in the state of Tennessee after winning 5 of 6 matchups to start the 2021 campaign at Memphis. The Bulls have also started on the road in 5 of their last 9 seasons dating back to 2012. In those matchups, Durham owns a 7-2 record, including a 4-1 clip on Opening Day when starting on the road.

BULL-ET POINTS

- INF/OF Vidal Brujan (44 XBH, 44 SB) was the only MiLB player last year to record 40+ extra-base hits & 40+ steals, and only 1 of 3 players in baseball to accomplish that feat, alongside OF Starling Marte (42 XBH, 47 SB) & INF/OF Whit Merrifield (55 XBH, 40 SB)
- ■RHP Calvin Faucher is set to start for the Bulls in this evening's season opener after starting the final game of the 2021 campaign for Durham on 10/3/21 at Norfolk.
- Faucher did not allow a run over his final 6 outings with Durham last season.
- The Bulls last year posted a 15-7 record in series openers.
- Durham tallied a 41-24 mark in road contests in 2021.
- The Bulls are scheduled to play 150 regular season games this year, which would be the franchise's longest campaign since 1956, when **Johnny Pesky** in his lone season as Bulls manager led the club to an 84-69 record in 153 regular season tilts.
- Tonight marks the 1st time Durham has played in the month of April since 4/30/19, resulting in a 9-5 loss at Norfolk.

HEY, I KNOW YOU!

The Bulls' Opening Day roster sports a total of 17 players who have previously played with Durham, including pitchers Adrian De Horta (2021), Calvin Faucher (2021), Jack Labosky (2019), Easton McGee (2021), Dalton Moats (2019, 21), Colin Poche (2018-19), Cristofer Ogando (2021), Joel Peguero (2021), Tommy Romero (2021), Phoenix Sanders (2019, 21) & Ryan Thompson (2021), as well as INF/OF Vidal Brujan (2021) & Miles Mastrobuoni (2021), infielders Tristan Gray (2021) & Jim Haley (2021), and OF Ryan Boldt. Manager Brady Williams (2019, 21) & Bench Coach Reinaldo Ruiz (2021) also return with experience with Durham. Lowe & Brujan were named Triple-A East League Post-Season All-Stars last year, while Williams earned Co-Manager of the Year honors

BRADY'S BACK

Manager **Brady Williams** returns to Durham for his 3rd year at the helm for the Bulls. In his previous 2 seasons, Williams has posted a 161-108 record, including a Triple-A National Championship in 2021 and Governor's Cup Finals appearance in his 1st year in 2019. He was also named the Triple-A East Co-Manager of the Year last year. 2022 marks Williams' 11th season as a minor league manager, having compiled a 848-731 record.

I'M THE NEW GUY

11 members of the Bulls' Opening Day roster are set to make their Durham debuts when they 1st appear in a game. That includes 5 players who would make their Triple-A debuts, including pitchers Jack Labosky & Chris Muller, INF Jonathan Aranda, C/INF Ford Proctor & OF Ruben Cardenas. Hitting Coach Will Bradley & Pitching Coach Brian Reith also join the Bulls for their 1st seasons in Durham.

MEET THE NEW Boss LEAGUE, SAME AS THE OLD LEAGUE

After playing in the Triple-A East League in 2021, the Bulls return to the International League, which they had previously played in from 1998-2019. During that stretch, Durham won 6 Governor's Cup titles, along with 16 division crowns, while recording winning records in 18 of 23 seasons. Overall, the Bulls own a 1,689-1,456 record in the International League.

CHANGES IN LATITUDES

The Rays last night announced that RHP **David McKay** was acquired by the New York Yankees in exchange for cash considerations. Tampa Bay OF & 2018 Bull **Austin Meadows** was also traded to Detroit last night in exchange for INF **Isaac Paredes** & a Competitive Balance Round B draft selection. Meadows in 27 games with Durham in 2018 hit .344 (33-96) with 19 runs, 11 doubles, 10 homers & 22 RBI, which included a 3-homer game on 8/29/18 at Charlotte that helped lead the Bulls to the postseason & an eventual Governors' Cup title.

LAST TIME OUT: Faucher opened for the Bulls in the final game of the 2021 Triple-A Final Stretch postseason tournament on 10/3 at Norfolk, firing 2.0 perfect innings, adding 4 strikeouts. The right-hander threw 34 pitches (21 strikes) in Durham's 3-2 defeat to the Tides.

<u>2022 Season:</u> Rated by Baseball America as the #24 Rays prospect prior to the season, in addition to possessing the "Best Curveball" in the organization

2021 Season: Started the year with Wichita (AA) in the Twins organization. Posted a 1-1 record & 7.04 ERA (30.2 IP) with 1 save in 19 appearances. Acquired by the Rays organization on 7/22 along with DH Nelson Cruz in exchange for former Bulls pitchers Joe Ryan & Drew Strotman and assigned to Montgomery (AA). Did not allow a run over 2 appearances (4.2 IP), adding 1 save with the Biscuits. Promoted to Durham and made Triple-A debut on 8/1, tossing 3.2 scoreless frames at Norfolk. Made 1st career start on 8/28 at Charlotte, tossing 3.0 scoreless innings. Was charged with an earned run in just 3 of 11 outings with Durham & did not allow a run over his final 5 appearances (10.2 IP)

2020 Season: Was not a member of Minnesota's 60-man player pool and did not pitch after the minor league season due to COVID-19 pandemic

2019 Season: Pitched the entire season with Fort Myers (A+), compiling a 3-2 record & 4.42 ERA (55.0 IP) over 34 appearances, adding 61 strikeouts. Placed on the 7-day injured list on 6/23 with a left ankle sprain & activated on 7/6

2018 Season: Started the year with Cedar Rapids (A), tallying a 4-4 clip & 3.35 ERA (53.2 IP) with 3 saves in 30 appearances, adding 55 strikeouts.
