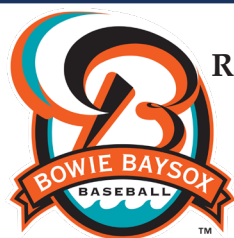

Blast the Baysox: The Patriots continue a six-game series at home against the Bowie Baysox tonight. The Patriots have taken each of the first two games over Bowie despite falling behind 2-0 in the top of the first inning each night.

On Assignment: RHP Clarke Schmidt begins a continues his stretch of rehab appearances with a spot start tonight for Somerset. Schmidt is ranked as the No. 2 prospect in the Yankees' system (MLB Pipeline). New York's first round draft pick from 2017 spent the 2020 season at the Alternate Training Site and made his MLB debut on Sept. 4, 2020. He went 0-1 with a 7.11 ERA and seven strikeouts over three games (one start) with the Yankees last year. This will be his third rehab start of the season, with previous stops with the Yankees' FCL team and Low-A Tampa.

Well Regarded: The Patriots have eight players on their active roster ranked in the Top 30 prospects in the Yankees' system: Clarke Schmidt (No. 2), Oswald Peraza (No. 4), Luis Medina (No. 8), Josh Breau (No. 14), Brandon Lockridge (No. 15), Ken Waldichuk (No. 21), Oswaldo Cabrera (No. 23), and Hayden Wesneski (No. 24).

High Water: The Patriots last night became the first team in the Double-A Northeast League to reach the 50 win plateau. Somerset is now 21 games above .500 -- a new high water mark on the year -- and has the best record in the league by 1.5 games over both Portland and Akron.

Arms Race: Somerset limited Bowie to one earned run last night. The team's pitching staff owns the lowest ERA (3.22) and BAA (.209), most shutout wins (13), third-lowest WHIP (1.16) and second-most strikeouts (887) across all levels of Minor League Baseball.

Where's OsWaldo: Infielder Oswaldo Cabrera improved his on-base streak to 24 games with a hit last night. Over the streak, Cabrera has reached base at a .318 clip. It's the longest such streak for Cabrera this season and is the second-longest on-base streak on the team this year.

Garcia Gearing Up: Infielder Dermis Garcia went 2-for-4 with two home runs last night. He is 4-for-8 with a triple, three home runs, four runs and five RBI to begin the Bowie series. Garcia has now homered five times in his last six games and seven times in his last 11 games. The Dominican slugger has reached base safely in nine-straight games and leads the Double-A Northeast League in home runs (22). His 22 home runs also mark a new career high.

What up, BREAU: Catcher Josh Breau went 2-for-4 with his first home run and first two RBI at the Double-A level last night. Breau hit 17 home runs earlier this season with High-A Hudson Valley. He now ranks second in the Yankees' organization with 18 overall home runs on the year, trailing Dermis Garcia (22) and one more than top-prospect Anthony Volpe (17).

Going Streaking: Max Burt, Isiah Gilliam and Jesus Bastidas are all enjoying impressive streaks. Burt is currently riding an eight-game hit streak, over which he is 10-for-28 (.357) with a home run, five RBI and .455 OBP. Gilliam is batting .346 (9-for-26) with a .414 OBP over his current seven-game hit streak. Bastidas is hitting .303 and getting on base at a .425 clip on his 10-game on-base streak across his first 10 games at the Double-A level.

CURRENT: Commenced a rehab assignment with Somerset on 8/5...Made one rehab start with Low-A Tampa 7/31 @ PMB: 3.0 IP, 1 H, 1 R, 1 ER, 2 BB, 4 K, 43 pitches (23 strikes)...Made first appearance of season on rehab with FCL Yankees 7/26: 3.0 IP, 1 H, 0 R, 0 ER, 0 BB, 5 K, 19 pitches (19 strikes)

2020 NOTES: Saw his first Major League action, going 0-1 with a 7.11 ERA (6.1IP, 5ER) in three games (one start) over two stints with the Yankees (9/4-13, 9/27)...Made his Major League debut in Game 2 on 9/4 at Baltimore after never having pitched professionally above Double-A in his career...was the seventh Yankee to make his Major League debut in 2020...Made his first career start on 9/27 vs. Miami, recording his first career loss after allowing 3ER in 4.0IP (4H, 2BB, 4K, 1HP, 1WP)...Was part of the Yankees' 40-man postseason player pool, but did not appear on a playoff roster...Attended spring training as a non-roster invitee for the first time in 2020, posting a 2.57 ERA (7.0IP, 9H, 4R/2ER, 3BB, 8K, 1HR) in four games (one start)...was named the 2020 James P. Dawson Award winner, presented annually to the most outstanding rookie in spring training as voted on by Yankees beat writers...was reassigned to the Alternate Site on 7/21.

2019 NOTES: Combined with Single-A Tampa, GCL Yankees East and Double-A Trenton to go 6-5 with a 3.47 ERA (90.2 IP, 79H, 43R/35ER, 28BB, 102K, 4HR) in 19 games (18 starts)...Began the season with Low-A Tampa and posted a 4-5 record with a 3.84 ERA (63.1IP, 59H, 35R/27ER, 24BB, 69K, 2HR) in 13 games (12 starts) across two stints...in his first start of the season on 4/4 at Lakeland (ND, 5.0IP, 0H, 0R, 0BB, 9K), opposed Casey Mize (5.0IP, 1H, 0R, 0BB, 8K), the No. 1 overall selection in the 2018 First-Year Player Draft...Tallied career highs in innings and strikeouts in 8/5 start at Lakeland (7.0IP, 9K)...Was promoted to Trenton on 8/15 and posted a 2-0 record with a 2.37 ERA (19.0IP, 14H, 5ER, 1BB, 19K, 1HR) in three starts...helped Trenton capture their first Eastern League Championship since 2013...went 1-0 with a 0.88 ERA (10.2IP, 4H, 2R/1ER, 3BB, 13K) in two games (one start) in the Eastern League playoffs...Following the season, was named by Baseball America as the Yankees' No. 2 prospect, No. 12 prospect in the Florida State League and No. 62 overall prospect...also labeled by Baseball America as having the "Best Curveball" in the system...

PERSONAL: In three seasons at South Carolina (2015-17), produced a 15-9 record and 3.21 ERA (229.2IP, 218H, 102R/82ER, 65BB, 254K, 17HR) in 45 games (36 starts)...as a junior in 2017, went 4-2 and ranked second in the nation with a 1.34 ERA (60.1IP, 41H, 15R/9ER, 18BB, 70K, 3HR) in nine starts, posting a 10.44 K/9.0IP ratio and .194 (41-for-211) opponents' BA...Was named to USA Baseball's Golden Spikes Award Midseason Watch List in both 2016 and 2017...was named to the 2017 NCBWA Pre-Season All-America First Team...Was Baseball America's No. 31 overall prospect (and No. 17 pitcher) in the 2017 draft...was tabbed by Baseball America as having the Best Control in the SEC...Graduated from Allatoona H.S. (Ga.), where he was the Region 5AAAAA 2014 Pitcher of the Year as a senior...His older brother, Clate, pitched in both the Tigers and Reds organizations.
