Syracuse Mets RHP Tylor Megill (1-0, 0.00) vs. Worcester Red Sox RHP Grant Gambrell (3-6, 4.72)

Post Holiday Blues – The Worcester Red Sox look to rebound from their first-ever July 4th loss last night and even this 3-game set at a victory apiece when they play game two of their 3-game series (and 6-game home and home series) against the Syracuse Mets tonight at 6:45 pm at Polar Park. The game will be followed by another patriotic UniBank Fireworks display and can be seen live on NESN+ and heard on NASH 98.9 FM and the rest of the WooSox Radio Network. The WooSox began their first home series of the second half on a down note last night with a 9-1 loss to the Mets to snap their perfect 3-0 record on the 4th of July since they began play at Polar Park in 2021. The defeat last night evened the overall home and home series at two victories apiece (Sox went 2-1 in Syracuse earlier this week and are 0-1 here in Worcester) with games remaining tonight at 6:45 pm and tomorrow at 4:05 pm.

This Homestand – The Sox and Mets face each other tonight & tomorrow afternoon here in Worcester. Then, after rare back-to-back off days this Sunday & Monday, the WooSox will continue their 9-game homestand when they resume play on Tuesday with the opener of a 6-game series at Polar Park vs. the 1st-place Rochester Red Wings thru next Sunday, July 14 leading up to the All-Star break (July 15-18). While Rochester lost top prospect OF James Wood to the Nationals this week, OF Dylan Crews (the #2 draft pick in the country last year for Washington after his fellow LSU teammate RHP Paul Skenes went #1 to Pittsburgh) was recently promoted to Rochester. The Red Wings currently own the best record in the league in 2nd half at 8-2. The teams will play Tuesday 6:45 pm, Wednesday at 12:15 pm, Thursday & Friday both at 6:45 pm, next Saturday at 4:05 pm, and next Sunday at 1:05 pm.

First in On-Base Pct. and Nearly Batting Average Too — Worcester's hot-hitting over the last month+ had propelled them to the top of league in Team Batting at .263 heading into play last night. However, the WooSox were held to just 4 hits and 1 run last night and their Team Average is now .262 (good for 3rd in the IL). However, the WooSox are still 1st in on-base pct. among all 20 International League clubs with their .372 on-base pct. The Sox are also tops in the league with 436 walks (most in all of Triple-A in fact) as well as leading the IL with 61 hit batsmen. It all adds up to an impressive .372 OBP.

This Season vs. Syracuse – The WooSox are 4-6 vs. Syracuse this season (going 4-5 in Syracuse as the first 9 games were all played in the 'Cuse and 0-1 here at Polar Park thus far). The Sox dropped 4 of 6 in their first series at Syracuse this season back from April 8-14. The Sox blanked the Mets, 9-0 on Monday, April 8 in the series-opener (after the Great Eclipse earlier that afternoon), but Syracuse then posted three consecutive victories by 3-2, 5-4, and 4-2 scores. After a rainout on April 13, the clubs split a make-up doubleheader the next day with Syracuse winning the opener, 10-5 before the WooSox bounced back with an 8-4 victory in Game 2. This week, Worcester won the first two games in Syracuse on Monday & Tuesday by 5-3 and 16-4 scores, while the Mets took the finale on Wednesday, 8-6. Syracuse got the jump in this current 3-game set at Polar Park with their 9-1 triumph last night.

Stats vs. the Mets – Worcester is 4-6 vs. Syracuse this season as pitchers have posted a 5.35 ERA (47 ER in 79 IP) with 18 HRA while Sox batters are hitting .251 (81-for-322) with 15 HR. The WooSox have out-scored the Mets, 58-50 in the first 10 games.

Last Season vs. Syracuse - The WooSox won the season-series over Syracuse last year by a 14-7 margin. The Sox went 10-5 at home vs. the Mets and were 4-2 here in Syracuse. Pawtucket/Worcester leads the all-time series over Syracuse by a 472-459 count.,

Second Half Adjustments – The WooSox are 5-4 to begin the 2nd half of the season (the final 75 games from June 25 through September 22). Worcester went 35-40 during the 1st half good for 7th-place in the IL East and 11½-games in back of division champ Syracuse who went 46-28 and won the division. However, Omaha from the IL West had the best overall record in the first half and the Storm Chasers earned the one playoff spot as first half champs.

July Underway – Worcester is 2-2 in July. The Sox are in the midst of playing 18 of 27 games on the road between June 25 and July 28. Starting July 30th, the WooSox will play 18 of 30 games at Polar Park through September 1.

June Over – The WooSox finished 12-13 in June. The team batted .284 in June (241-for-850) with 30 HR – their best month of the year and the 3rd highest average in the league in June. Sox pitchers had a 4.99 ERA during the month (118 ER in 212.2) with 26 HRA. Worcester out-scored their opponents, 160-137 in June. Worcester went 2-1 in March, 10-14 in April, and 14-14 in May.

One is a Lonely Number – The WooSox are 3-12 in 1-run games this season (the worst mark in the league). However, all three WooSox 1-run wins this season have come against Scranton/Wilkes-Barre, May 16 (13-12) and May 17 (9-8) both at home vs. the RailRiders, and June 25 (6-5) in Moosic, PA. Worcester is 7-10 in 2-run games this season. Last year the WooSox went 21-24 in 1-run games and they were 13-10 in 2-run affairs.

Home Goods – Worcester is back at the .500 mark at Polar Park this year with their 21-21 record in Worcester (compared to 19-23 away from home). The Sox have been up and down at Polar Park throughout this season. They started 1-4 at home from April 2-7, then went 14-5 at Polar Park from April 16 – May 21, were recently 0-7 from May 22 – June 5, then went 3-0 from June 6-8, before currently going 3-5 in their last 8 games at home.

Four Below – The WooSox are 40-44 overall. Three times this season (all in June), Worcester had fallen to a season and franchise-low 7-games under .500. Those dates came most recently on June 14 (30-37) as well as on June 12 at 29-36 and on June 5 at 26-33. Worcester's low point last year was 6-games under .500 when they were 8-14 on April 26, 2023. Their low in 2022 was also 6-games below on May 15, 2022 at 15-21. And their low point in 2021 during their inaugural campaign was just 3-games under when they started 0-3. The Sox have been over .500 just once this season when they were 2-1 on March 31.

Left at the Altar – The WooSox are 2nd in the International League with 662 runners left on base this season.

Hit Me With Your Best Shot – WooSox batters are 1st in the 20-team International League by being hit by pitch 61 times this season. The Red Sox Triple-A record for Most Hit by Pitch (by batters) in a season is 79 set by the Pawtucket Red Sox in 2000 & tied by the Worcester Red Sox in 2022.

Rankings – Worcester is 3^{rd} in the IL in team batting with a .262 average while Syracuse is 9^{th} at .261. On the pitching side, the Sox are 13^{th} in team ERA (5.08) while the Mets are 4^{th} with a 4.49 ERA.

Streaks – The WooSox suffered a season-high 6-game losing streak from May 22-28 which was Worcester's longest in over a year since a 6-game losing streak from April 9-14 of last season. Worcester's longest winning streak of this season was 4 in a row from April 14 (G2 of a doubleheader) – April 19.

Series Math – Worcester is 6-5-4 in their first 15 series of 2024 (6 wins, 5 losses, and 4 splits). Worcester finished 13-8-5 in their 26 series last season...13 winners, 8 losers, and 5 splits. The Sox went 8-3-2 in 13 series at Polar Park and 5-5-3 in 13 sets on the road.

Daydream Believers – Worcester has had more success this season in day games (20-19) than at night (20-25).

Comebacks and Last AB – Worcester has 18 come-from-behind victories this season including 4 wins in their last at-bat of the game and one walk-off. They have suffered 11 losses during the opponent's final at-bat.

May Be or Might Be - The WooSox rallied to win their final three games in May and finish the month even with a 14-14 record. Sox pitchers had a 4.88 ERA with 27 HRA in May while Sox batters hit .256 during the month with 42 HR.

April Recap - The WooSox finished 10-14 in April (after going 2-1 in March) while batting .244 with 22 HR. Sox pitchers were 10-14 with a 5.55 ERA with 25 HRA. The month also featured five postponements, four doubleheaders, 29 player transactions, 10 players promoted to Boston (not including any rehabbers), and a total of 41 players used (19 position players & 22 pitchers).

A Winning Tradition – The 2023 Worcester Red Sox went 79-68 to post a winning season for the third time in as many years of existence. Worcester finished with a 43-33 home record compared to 36-35 on the road last year. The 2021 WooSox went 74-54 during their abbreviated inaugural season while the 2022 WooSox finished 75-73.

Finish Line – In the overall International League Standings for the 2023 season, out of 20 IL teams, Worcester finished in 7th-place with a 79-68 overall record. In the 1st half standings last year, the WooSox went 39-36 while they improved to 40-32 in the 2nd half.

You Need a Scorecard – The 2023 WooSox built on a pair of all-time Red Sox Triple-A records as they made **271 player transactions** during the 2023 campaign and set a new all-time Red Sox Triple-A record for players appearing in a single season. The WooSox used **79 different players** in 2023 (33 position players and 46 pitchers) to better the mark of 75 different players in 2022 (31 position players and 44 pitchers). Ironically, the 2021 WooSox set the previous mark of 72 different players (31 position players and 41 pitchers).

Two Dozen to Go - 24 different WooSox players were promoted to Boston during the 2023 season (not counting Red Sox rehabbing players) including Jarren Duran, Chris Murphy, Brandon Walter, David Hamilton, Wilyer Abreu, Ceddanne Rafaela, and many others.

PORTLAND SEA DOGS (AA) UPDATE – The Portland Sea Dogs (7-2)/(43-35) won at New Hampshire last night, 7-3 for their 5th straight victory. Roman Anthony smacked an inside-the-park HR to CF (his 10th HR), Nick Decker drilled a solo HR (#5), and Elih Marrero delivered a 2-run single. Wikelman Gonzalez started and fired 3 scoreless innings with 3 strikeouts. The win went to Christopher Troye (2-0) who tossed 3 innings and allowed just 1 run.

WOOSOX PLAYER MOVES – None today. Worcester has already used 60 players this season (27 position players and 33 pitchers). RHP Alex Speas will be #61 once he makes his WooSox debut.

The WooSox have sent 15 players to Boston since the season started...INF David Hamilton, INF Romy Gonzalez, LHP Brennan Bernardino, INF/OF Bobby Dalbec, RHP Cooper Criswell, LHP Joe Jacques, LHP Cam Booser, C Tyler Heineman, RHP Zack Kelly, RHP Naoyuki Uwasawa, INF Enmanuel Valdez, INF/OF Jamie Westbrook, RHP Josh Winckowski, RHP Isaiah Campbell, and LHP Bailey Horn. Those 15 do not include OF Rob Refsnyder, INF Vaughn Grissom, RHP Nick Pivetta, OF Tyler O'Neill, OF Masataka Yoshida, RHP Chris Martin, and OF Wilyer Abreu who were all injury rehab recalls from Worcester to Boston. Uwasawa, Westbrook, Criswell, Dalbec, Booser, Heineman, and Campbell are back with the WooSox, while Jacques was claimed off waivers by Arizona. The rest of those players are still with the Red Sox.
