FOOD FIGHT!!!

Today marks the 11th of 12 1st Half meetings between the Shuckers and Biscuits... The Shuckers enter today 0.5 games ahead of the Biscuits for first place in the South Division with 17 games remaining in the half... The Shuckers own every tiebreaker against the Biscuits for the 1st Half.
The Shuckers and Biscuits have won 6 of the last 8 South Division titles, including 4 consecutive titles across the last 2 seasons.

HOME COOKING

The Shuckers enter today with a 18-8 record at home this season, the 3rd-best in Double-A and best in the Southern League... At Keesler Federal Park, the Shuckers are averaging 6.0 runs per game with an .808 OPS and a +33 run differential.
Across the last 8 home games (since May 19), the Shuckers are 7-1, outscoring opponents 47-33 (+14).
Since the start of 2025, the Shuckers are a Double-A best 60-35 at home.

A MAD DASH TO THE FINISH

Entering today, the Shuckers have won 16 of their last 23 games since snapping a 7-game losing streak on May 7, 2026, when they were 12-17... Since May 7, the Shuckers 16-7 record is the best in Double-A and the 7th-best in Minor League Baseball.
Over that span, the Shuckers have outscored opponents 126-102 (+24), an average of 5.5 runs per game.
The Shuckers enter today in sole possession of 1st place in the South Division for the 1st time since April 11, when they were 5-3.

LUDICROUS SPEED

2B/OF DYLAN O'RAE enters today with a Double-A leading 31 stolen bases... In game one of Thursday's doubleheader, O'Rae became the 9th player in franchise history to record 30 stolen bases in a season... O'Rae became the 5th Shucker to achieve the feat since 2023... The franchise single-season record is 52, set by **OF JOHNNY DAVIS** in 2017 across 133 games.

STARTING OFF ON THE RIGHT FOOT

In game one of Thursday's doubleheader, **RHP TANNER GILLIS** became the 5th different Shuckers starter to work into the 6th inning... 5 of the last 7 Shucker starters have worked into the 6th inning, including 2 starts into the 7th.
Across the last 7 starts, the Shuckers rotation holds a 2.15 ERA (9er, 37.2ip) with 34 strikeouts and a .148 opponents average.
Since May 19 (14gs), the Shuckers rotation holds a 3.41 ERA, best in the Southern League and 5th-best in Double-A... The Shuckers are 1 of 2 Southern League rotations with an ERA below 4.00 over that span.

BOMBS AWAY MR. BURKE

1B BLAKE BURKE retook sole possession of the Southern League home run lead on Wednesday with his 13th home run of the season... Burke's 13 home runs are tied for the 6th-most in a half by a Shucker in franchise history (since 2015).
At Keesler Federal Park, Burke owns a .307/.377/.653 slash line with a 1.030 OPS and 17 extra-base hits.
Burke has recorded a hit in 24 of 26 home games this season, including 7 multi-hit games.

MADE FOR THE MOMENT

SS JESUS MADE enters today among the Southern League leaders in RBI (1st, 40), hits (3rd, 56), triples (T-3rd, 4), stolen bases (T-8th, 19) and average (10th, .277).
Made is the 1st Brewers Double-A player to reach 40 RBI in a team's first 50 games since **1B JASON ROGERS** in 2013 with the Huntsville Stars.

WHY DO WE LIKE HIM? HE GETS ON BASE!

C MATTHEW WOOD (17g) and **2B DYLAN O'RAE** (16g) both enter today with on-base streaks of at least 15 games, 2 of the 3 longest active streaks in the Southern League... The pair are the 4th and 5th different Shuckers with an on-base streak of at least 15 games this season.
Across Wood's current 16-game streak, he owns a .327/.477/.612 slash line with 6 extra-base hits and more walks (14) than strikeouts (8).
O'Rae enters today with a .356/.472/.458 slash line across his streak, including 13 stolen bases.

LET'S GO PROSPECTING

Baseball America included 4 Shuckers in the updated Brewers Top 30 rankings; **SS JESUS MADE** (No. 1), **RHP BISHOP LETSON** (No. 10), **1B BLAKE BURKE** (No. 13) and **RHP MANUEL RODRIGUEZ** (No. 28).

BACK IN THE SADDLE

MANAGER MIKE GUERRERO is in his 8th season as Shuckers manager and 10th as manager of a Brewers Double-A affiliate... Guerrero needs 27 wins to reach 1,500... His 1,473 wins are the sixth-most among active managers in Minor League Baseball.

TODAY'S STARTING PITCHER

RHP JARON DEBERRY (4-3, 4.84) makes his 11th start of the season and his 3rd against the Biscuits.
DeBerry has gone 6.0 innings in both starts against the Biscuits with 18 strikeouts over 12.0 innings, including a career-high 10 on May 12 at DABOS Park.
On Sunday, DeBerry recorded his 1st career complete game shutout with 7.0 innings, no runs, 1 hit, 2 walks and 4 strikeouts... It marked the 11th in Shuckers franchise history (since 2015)... The complete game shutout was the first in a non-rain-shortened game since **RHP TREY SUPAK** on July 16, 2019, against the Chattanooga Lookouts.
