BULLS BLITZ JUMBO SHRIMP 13-2

Home runs from Jordan Groshans and Avisaíl García weren't enough on Monday as the Durham Bulls cruised to a 13-2 victory over the Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp. After a Bulls run in the first. Groshans' shot tied things up in the second. Durham scored three times in their half of the second before García went deep in the third. The Bulls responded with one in the third, four in the fourth, three in the sixth and one more in the seventh for a commanding 13-2 advantage. The 17 hits allowed for Jacksonville were the most yielded by the club in 2023.

'PEN PALS

The Jacksonville bullpen struggled mightily during a seven-game stretch from April 14-26. Over that timeframe, Jumbo Shrimp relievers collectively surrendered 27 runs, 26 earned, on 38 hits (11.7 H/9) in 29.1 innings for a 7.98 ERA. However, in the 28 games since, Jacksonville relievers have combined to cede 58 runs 51 earned on 108 hits (7.0 H/9) in 139.2 innings for a 3.29 ERA. The Jumbo Shrimp bullpen has combined for 154 strikeouts (9.9 K/9) against 80 walks (5.2 BB/9) during this recent run.

AUSTIN POWERS

Austin Allen entered play on April 28 just 2-for-his-first-47 (.043) on the season. In the 18 games, since, however, the St. Louis native is 23-for-66 (.348/.434/.697/1.131) at the plate with five doubles, six home runs, 12 RBIs, nine walks and 14 runs scored. After striking out in 25.1% of his plate appearances during the 2022 campaign, Allen has whiffed just 17.7% of the time this season. His .207 BABIP is the fifth-lowest of the 192 IL players with at least 100 plate appearances in 2023.

THE BRIAN KING

Heading into play on Wednesday, Jacksonville outfielder Brian Miller has reached base in 16 of his last 17 games, with the lone miss being an 0-for-1 pinch-hitting appearance. During this stretch, the Durham, N.C., native is 22-for-60 (.367/.458/.517/.975) with five doubles, two triples six RBIs and seven runs scored. After posting an 8.2 percent walk rate in 2022, Miller is walking in 11.5 percent of his plate appearances this season. He has chopped his ground ball rate from 46.3 percent to 37.6 percent.

CHICKS ARE DIGGING IT

In the 11 games from May 14-26, the Jumbo Shrimp launched just nine home runs, tied for the fifth-fewest in Triple-A. However, over the last two contests, Jacksonville has blasted 11 long balls, including a season-high six on Saturday, their most at notoriously pitcher-friendly 121 Financial Ballpark since hitting seven against the Carolina Mudcats on June 4, 2010. Those 11 home runs are the most in Triple-A over the last three games. On the season, the lumbo Shrimp's 60 homers rank exactly in the middle of the pack in Triple-A, placing in a tie for 15th.

THE MAYOR OF STARKVILLE

An offseason trade acquisition from the New York Mets, Jacksonville outfielder Jake Mangum has had an outstanding start to the 2023 season. The former Mississippi State Bulldog is 50-for-160 (.313/.347/.481/.828) with 11 doubles, five triples, two home runs, 22 RBIs, six walks and 17 runs scored to start the campaign. Among the 128 qualified players in the IL, Mangum leads the league in line drive rate (32.8 percent) while producing the 11thhighest opposite-field rate (41.2 percent). Those figures were at 28.2 and 32.2 percent, respectively, while playing for Triple-A Syracuse in 2022.

NOT THIS WAY

Jacksonville starting pitching seemed to find their footing in the middle part of April into May. From April 13-May 5, Jacksonville starters yielded 42 runs, 35 earned on 90 hits (8.2 H/9) in 98.2 innings for a strong 3.19 ERA. However, Jumbo Shrimp lid-lifters have struggled mightly of late. Over their last 22 games, they've combined to surrender 87 runs. 84 earned, on 111 hits (12.9 H/9) in 77.2 innings for a 9.73 ERA. During this stretch. Jacksonville starters have walked 55 (6.4 BB/9) against only 59 strikeouts (6.8 K/9).

SHRIMP BITES

Jacksonville has lost its last six series openers, including Monday's game at Durham. The Jumbo Shrimp have also fallen in four of their last five game twos of series' during this span... Jacksonville has gone just 26-29 (.400) against Durham in the last three seasons since rejoining the International League. The Bulls have outhomered the Jumbo Shrimp 94-78, and as a result, outscored them 364-278.
