SERIES HIGHLIGHTS: The New Hampshire Fisher Cats split the first two games of the series vs Hartford, winning the continuation of Tuesday's game 7-5 before falling in Wednesday's seven-inning contest 6-0. In the first game, **Damiano Palmegiani** crushed his first two Double-A home runs in the first and seventh, part of a game-high three-RBI day for the corner infielder. **Will Robertson** tied up the score at five in the seventh with his second home run of the season and **Dylan Rock** put New Hampshire ahead 7-5 with a go-ahead two-run home run in the eighth into the Hilton Garden Inn. It was Rock's first Double-A home run in his home debut. **Alejandro Melean, Jol Concepcion, and Troy Watson** combined for six shutout innings of relief with Watson earning his first Double-A save.

In the second game, **Paxton Schultz** got the nod and struck out a season-high nine in 4.2 innings. The last time Schultz struck out nine batters in a game was August 3, 2022 vs Richmond. **Miguel Hiraldo** extended his hit streak to six games, which is now the longest Fisher Cat hit streak this season.

GOING STREAKING: Notable current on-base streaks include **Leo Jimenez** who has now reached base in all nine games played. **Steward Berroa** is on an eight-game on-base streak after walking three times in four plate appearances yesterday. **Miguel Hiraldo** has hit safely in six consecutive games after starting out the season 2-for-18 at the dish. He now has the longest hit streak on the team.

ROBBINS HOOD: Thursday starter **Jimmy Robbins** makes his fourth start of the season and his second home start. The left-hander last time around at Somerset struck out five over two runs, four hits and three walks in 4.2 innings in his lone start at Somerset over the week, receiving the loss. Robbins has struck out five batters each in his last two starts. Last time out vs Hartford, he made his first Double-A start vs the Yard Goats on 8/21/22 at Dunkin Donuts Park and was impressive with four scoreless innings.

DAMIANO-B-P: IF **Damiano Palmegiani** is back at the top of the Eastern League leaderboard in on-base percentage. The corner infielder is getting on-base at a .446 clip, third-best in the league. The Blue Jays No. 29 prospect hit his first two Double-A home runs in Tuesday's win after hitting 24 total last season across two levels of Single-A. Palmegiani has the same number of walks (15) as strikeouts.

MARTINEZ MAGIC: IF **Orelvis Martinez** is ranked the No. 4 prospect in the Blue Jays system to start the 2023 season. The 21-year-old Dominican Republic native currently leads the Fisher Cats with three home runs to start the season after hitting a team-high 30 home runs last season, breaking the Fisher Cats single-season record of 27 home runs previously set by Chip Cannon (2006) and Eric Thames (2010). Martinez was second in the Eastern League in home runs and had four multi-homer games.

CESAR MARTIN LEADS FIELD STAFF: Manager **Cesar Martin** is leading the Fisher Cats for a third straight season. Pitching coach **Drew Hayes** and hitting coach **Mitch Huckabay** are in their first season in New Hampshire, while position coach **Chris Schaeffer** returns for his third season in Manchester. The Fisher Cats hit a team-record 166 home runs in 2022.

THIS DAY IN FISHER CATS HISTORY (April 27, 2019) – The Fisher Cats scored seven times in the first four at bats enroute to an 8-5 win at Reading. Forrest Wall had the only New Hampshire homer, a two-run shot in the second to make it 5-1. Andrew Sopko picked up his first Double-A win and Bryan Baker had a save. Baker is working out of the Orioles bullpen in 2023.

MANCHESTER-BOSTON REGIONAL AIRPORT FLIGHT TO THE MAJORS: The Blue Jays extended the win streak to four with an 8-0 win over the White Sox to sweep that series. **Bo Bichette** hit his fifth homer. Toronto is off today before hosting Seattle. Jays at 16-9 have the third best record in the American League, but Tampa Bay (20-5) and Baltimore (16-8) are ahead of them in the AL East...Triple-A Buffalo (9-13) lost 2-1 to the Gwinnett Stripers. **Addison Barger** had three of the four hits for the Bisons. Just promoted **Nick Fraze** took the loss, giving up the game-winning home run in the bottom of the fifth. Fisher Cat alum **Forrest Wall** had tied the game with a single off **Yosver Zulueta** in the third for Gwinnett (Braves)...High-A Vancouver (6-7) evened the series with Eugene with a 9-2 win at the Nat. Chad Dallas went five scoreless, allowing only one hit, to pick up the win...Class-A Dunedin (8-9) edged Bradenton (Pirates) 2-1. **Robert Robertis**, who finished last season in New Hampshire, had the game-winning homer in the fourth.

COMING UP: The Fisher Cats continue their two-week homestand this week vs Hartford. Promotions include Bark in the Park night, Atlas Fireworks, Gatos Feroces de New Hampshire night, and a Phone Grip Giveaway, courtesy of Coca-Cola Northeast.

LAST TIME OUT: Took the loss at Somerset last Friday night, 3-2. Allowed two earned runs in 4.2 innings pitched. Took a 1-0 lead to the fifth, but gave up three hits in that frame including a go-ahead double by MLB rehabber Harrison Bader before being lifted.

v. **HARTFORD** – Made his first Double-A start vs. Yard Goats on 8/21/22 at Dunkin Donuts Park and was impressive with four scoreless innings.

2023: Opened season with his third consecutive outing at Double-A without allowing a run. Earned the win 4/8 at Altoona. Has suffered setbacks in his last two starts, falling to Portland and Somerset.

2022: -AA debut at HFD 8/21- made 5 starts in all with the Fisher Cats and did not allow a run in three of them. At the time of his promotion to NH on August 15, Robbins had an 0-2 record and 3.08 on the season across two levels. Had 72 Ks in 52.2 innings. Started the season with Single-A Dunedin, where he had a 1.56 ERA in six outings (one start). Struck out 26 batters in 17.1 innings with the D-Jays. Promoted to High-A Vancouver on June 7. Was primarily a start with the C's (10 outings, 9 starts). Had a 3.82 ERA and 0-2 record with Vancouver, throwing a career-high 11 strikeouts vs. Everett on July 31.

2021: Missed the entire season due to Tommy John surgery

2019: Threw in seven outings with three starts between Bluefield Blue Jays and GCL Blue Jays. Had a 2.84 ERA with 24 Ks in 19.0 innings across both levels. Totaled season-best seven strikeouts in 3.0 innings on August 7 against the Greeneville Reds.

Obtained: Drafted in the 20th round of the 2019 MLB Draft out of Rollins College in Rollins, Florida.

Personal: Spent the 2017 season with the Troy Trojans before transferring to Rollins for the 2019 season. Played four years at Boone High School (Braves) in Orlando and won a metro championship junior year. Threw a no-hitter against Dr. Phillips HS and also had a 8 inning shutout in his HS career.
