Bourbon and Baseball... The Bowling Green Bootleggers return to the diamond for Thursday's matchup with the Greensboro Grasshoppers. The alternate identity honors the rich history of bourbon in The Bluegrass State. Bowling Green holds a 7-1 record as the Bootleggers this season.

Resetting the Record Books... Bowling Green is up to a new franchise-record 265 stolen bases this season. The Hot Rods stole five bases in Wednesday's contest from five different players. The 265 swipes surpasses the 2024 Hot Rods squad, who stole 262 bases.

McCoy Mashesh... First baseman Ryan McCoy launched a two-run home run on Wednesday night. McCoy leads Bowling Green with a 1.309 OPS, six home runs and 11 extra base hits against Greensboro this season.

Brendan's Back... Outfielder Brendan Summerhill recorded his first three-hit performance in High-A in Wednesday's defeat, adding an RBI and a stolen base. The Tampa Bay Rays' No. 28 prospect is hitting 7-for-15 (.467 AVG) with a grand slam against the Hub City Spartanburgers.

Flew Takes Flight... Nathan Flewelling belted his 21st home run of the season Tuesday night. Flewelling tied 2018 Bowling Green backstop Ronaldo Hernandez for the most single-season home runs by a catcher in franchise history. The Rays' No. 4 prospect has now homered in each of Bowling Green's last five series dating back to July 30.

Setting the (Ay)bar High... Nicandro Aybar has now reached base in all 16 games with Bowling Green following a promotion from the Charleston RiverDogs on July 19. The 21-year-old has torched Greensboro in particular, hitting 12-for-23 (.522 AVG) with six RBI in six games.

Morgan's On the Mound... LHP Blake Morgan makes his Bowling Green Ballpark debut on Thursday night. Morgan was promoted from Charleston on August 11, logging 5.0 innings of two-run ball in his High-A debut against the Frederick Keys. Morgan held a 4-2 clip with a 3.47 ERA for Charleston across 11 starts this season prior to his callup.
