SATURDAY'S RECAP: The New Hampshire Fisher Cats split Saturday's doubleheader against the Harrisburg Senators, winning game one 6-1 and losing game two 7-2 at FNB Field. In the first game, the Fisher Cats blasted a pair of homers off Harrisburg left-hander Dustin Saenz in his Double-A debut. Leo Jimenez hit his third homer of the year and his second of the series with a two-run shot to left-center in the second. Damiano Palmegiani extended his team-long hit streak to 11 games with a solo homer in the third. Orelvis Martinez drove in his 39th and 40th runs batted in of the season with a tworun single in the sixth to cushion the lead. On the mound, right-hander Luis Quinones made his first start of the season in the first game of the doubleheader for New Hampshire. The Puerto Rican right-hander threw 3.2 innings, allowing just one run on two hits and no walks while striking out six, a new season-high, in a no-decision. Right-hander Nick Fraze picked up the victory after a season-high 3.1 shutout innings of relief and a season-high four strikeouts. In the second game, New Hampshire scored first with a two-run homer by Martinez to left-center, his 16th of the season. Harrisburg answered with two runs in the first, three runs in the third and two more runs in the fourth off New Hampshire starting left-hander Jimmy Robbins (2-5). James Wood went 2-for-3 with two RBIs and Terone Harris III hit a two-run homer off Robbins in the third. The offense went 0-for-4 with runners in scoring position in the second game.

SHOVING THE SHOVE: New Hampshire's pitching staff is tied for the lowest ERA in the Eastern League at 3.91. Last season, the Fisher Cats had the second-highest ERA in the league at 4.95. The Fisher Cats have also struck out the secondmost hitters in the league, averaging 9.9 strikeouts a game while allowing the fewest home runs in the league (42). New Hampshire starting pitchers are second in the league in strikeouts behind Somerset while opposing hitters are hitting just .206 against the bullben, the lowest in the Eastern League.

GO ORELVIS GO: In his last 10 games, Orelvis Martinez is hitting .351 (13-for-37) with five doubles, three homers and 10 RBIs. He has collected a hit in 11 of his last 12 games and hit his team-leading 16th homer of the year in the second game of the doubleheader yesterday. Martinez is just one homer shy of sharing the Eastern League lead with Hartford's Hunter Goodman. The Blue Jays No. 4 prospect set a record with 11 home runs in the month of May, the most hit by a Fisher Cat in a single month in team history.

THE POWER OF PALMEGIANI: Damiano Palmegiani's 11 game hit streak came to an end in the second game of the doubleheader but his hit streak stands as the longest on the team this season. In that span, he went .396 (19-for-48) with three doubles, a triple, two homers and 11 RBIs. The Blue Javs No. 29 prospect also has a team-leading 14 multi-hit games on the season and six multi-RBI games, which is second on the team.

OWNAGE IS OWNAGE: A couple Fisher Cats have had good success against Harrisburg pitching this season. Leo Jimenez (.341, 14-for-41, 2 2B, 2 HR, 5 RBI) and Will Robertson (.417, 10-for-24, 2 2B, HR, 4 RBI) have posted good numbers so far through almost two complete series against the Senators.

THIS DAY IN FISHER CATS HISTORY (June 11, 2021). The Fisher Cats scored twice in the top of the ninth - and eight times in the top of the 10th – in a 14-6 win at Hadlock Field. Gabriel Moreno homered and Kevin Vicuna singled in a run in the ninth to tie the game. Moreno, Vicuna, and LJ Talley all finished with four hits and the Fisher Cats had 20 in the game.

MANCHESTER-BOSTON REGIONAL AIRPORT FLIGHT TO THE MAJORS: Blue Jays (36-30) try to salvage the series finale with the Twins after a 9-4 loss yesterday. Minnesota exploded for seven runs in the eighth inning, including a Carlos Correa grand slam...Triple-A Buffalo (28-34) lost 7-5 at Toledo. The Bisons rallied to tie with four in the top of the ninth, but Joe Rizzo hit a walk-off homer. Rafael Lantiqua and LJ Talley each drove in two for Buffalo. The Bisons play for a series win today...High-A Vancouver (30-25) swept a doubleheader at Everett 8-2 and 2-0. Peyton Williams homered and drove in three in the opener. The Canadians no-hit the AquaSox in the night-cap. Devereaux Harrison (Jays 9th rounder/2022 -Long Beach State) tossed the first six innings with eight strikeouts and Matt Svanson finished off the gem. It was the first no-hitter for the C's as a Blue Jays affiliate...Class A Dunedin (27-29) dropped a 7-6 decision at Bradenton. Ryan McCarty hit his fourth homer.

COMING UP: The Fisher Cats come back home to play their final home stand of the first half beginning on Tuesday, June 13 vs Akron.
