### JUMBO SHRIMP COMEBACK FALLS SHORT

Trailing by seven, the Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp brought the winning run to the plate in the bottom of the ninth on Saturday but their comeback fell short in an 8-5 loss to the Worcester Red Sox in front of 9,226 fans. Down 8-1 in the ninth, the Jumbo Shrimp rallied with four runs but **Xavier Edwards** flew out with the bases loaded. The Red Sox put up a five-spot in the top of the first and never looked back. Jacksonville's lone run that came outside of the ninth inning was **C.J. Hinojosa's** homer in the third.

### X MARKS THE SPOT

**Xavier Edwards** was optioned to Jacksonville on May 30 by Miami, but has been on a tear in his return to Triple-A. In the 32 games he's played since he's been optioned, the Coconut Creek, Fla., native is 53-for-136 at the plate, slashing .390/.428/.500/.928 with six doubles, three home runs, 21 RBIs and 28 runs scored. This hot streak has pushed Edwards up to second in the International League in batting average (.359) and tied for fifth in OBP (.429). Among the 267 players in the IL this season with at least 100 plate appearances, Edwards ranks second in swinging-strike rate (3.9 percent). He has registered at least three hits in six of the last nine games, going 22-for-42 (.524) in that span.

### AUSTIN POWERS

**Austin Allen** entered play on April 28 just 2-for-his-first-47 (.043) on the season. In the 43 games, since, however, the St. Louis native is 44-for-149 (.295/.382/.711/1.093) at the plate with nine doubles, one triple, 17 home runs, 43 RBIs and 29 runs scored. After striking out in 25.1 percent of his plate appearances at the Triple-A level last season, Allen is fanning just 19.2 percent of the time in 2023.

### FRIENDS CLOSE, ENEMIES CLOSER

Though Jacksonville crushed Charlotte 13-2 on Sunday, nine of Jacksonville's last 18 games have been decided by three runs or fewer. Of the Jumbo Shrimp's 86 games played thus far in 2023, 47 have been decided by these slim margins. Jacksonville is 22-25 (.468) in these contests this season, but they excelled in them during an 80-69 2022 campaign, going 44-38 (.537). In 2021, when the club went 75-55, Jacksonville was 49-28 (.636) in games decided by three runs or fewer.

### NINTH TIME'S A CHARM!

After falling in the first two games of their series at Memphis on May 2-3, Jacksonville rallied to win the series, taking the final four games. After that, though, the Jumbo Shrimp lost four consecutive sets before finally splitting a pair of series with Nashville and Memphis. They then lost four of six at Gwinnett before splitting their series with Durham from June 28-July 3. However, by taking five of six games of their series at Charlotte, Jacksonville has finally snapped an eight-set drought without a series victory. It was the club's longest such drought since June 11-August 11, 2015, when they went 12 consecutive series' without a win in what turned out to be a 57-81 (.413) campaign.

### ODDS & ENDS

Jacksonville looked like world beaters in a six-game series at Charlotte from July 4-9. The Jumbo Shrimp took five out of six games from the Knights - their most wins in a series since 2022 - and outscored Charlotte by a whopping 58-28 margin. In the other five games of the second half of the season, Jacksonville is just 3-5, with all three victories coming by one run. In the other five games, the Shrimp have lost by a combined 30 runs. Thus, while the club was +30 in their run differential in the Queen City, they are -27 against their other second-half opponents (DUR, WOR).

### STOCKING STUFFER

Jacksonville opened the season last year with Worcester in a six-game slugfest that saw the WooSox take five of six. The Jumbo Shrimp slugged six home runs and scored 28 runs (4.7 per game) while the WooSox walloped 13 home runs against Jacksonville pitching and scored 39 runs (6.5 per game). The club's 6.17 ERA against Worcester last year was the worst amongst 2022 IL opponents in 2022.

### SHRIMP BITES

Jacksonville's 11 walks issued on Saturday against Worcester matched a season-high. The Jumbo Shrimp walked 11 Redbirds in Memphis on May 3... Jacksonville is trying to avoid being swept for the first time since losing all five games of a series from May 1-5, 2019 at Mississippi. The Jumbo Shrimp have not been broomed at home since Montgomery swept a six-game series from June 28-July 3, 2018 at 121 Financial Ballpark.

### ABOUT CHI CHI

-González was called up to the majors for the first time on May 30, 2015, and made his major league debut that day. He faced the veteran lineup of the Boston Red Sox and began the game pitching 5 2/3 innings without surrendering a hit.
