

#### **Leading Off**

Tonight, the Reading Fightin Phils continue a six-game series on the road at the Somerset Patriots. It's the fifth of 18 matchups between the teams this season, with the Patriots holding the 3-1 edge. Reading returns to Somerset from July 4-9 and the Patriots come to Reading from August 15-20. In 2022, Reading went 7-11 vs Somerset, going 5-5 at home and 2-7 on the road.

#### Walkoff Heartbreaker

Last night, the Fightin Phils fell 4-3 after Somerset walked them off in the bottom of the ninth innning. Reading jumped out to a 3-0 lead thanks to two runs in the first and another in the third. But, Somerset's bullpen shut down the R-Phils the rest of the way and the Patriots' bats chipped back. Nick Podkul had three hits and two RBI, and Mick Abel bounced back with five strong innings.

#### **Shutout Streak**

Through 36 games this season, Reading has yet to be shut out. The Fightin Phils are one-of-three teams in double-A and one-of-16 in all of Minor League Baseball who have yet to be blanked. The other Eastern League team to not be shutout was Altoona, but the Curve were no hit at Bowie last night. The R-Phils have also not thrown a shutout as a pitching staff yet in 2023.

#### Oliver Getting It Dunn

Oliver Dunn continues to put up big numbers, this time against his former team Somerset. Dunn has reached base in a season-high 13-straight games, which is also a team-high on-base streak. Against his former team Somerset this week, Dunn is hitting .385, a home run and six RBI.

#### **McCarthy Mashes**

McCarthy Tatum is another Fightin Phil who is bouncing back strong after a recent dry spell. Tatum has hits in his last five games and is hitting .389 over that span with a home run and seven RBI. In seven games prior, from April 21-May 11, Tatum was just 1/27 (.037) and was hitless in six of those seven games.

#### Around the Organization

The Philadelphia Phillies opened up a series at home agains the Cubs and suffered a 10-1 loss to Chicago. Lehigh Valley had another extra-inning game at Worcester last night, but fell this time 9-8. Jersey Shore stayed hot with a 9-4 win over the Wilmington Blue Rocks, to imrpvoe over .500 to 17-16. Clearwater earned a 5-3 win at home over Bradenton to improve to a Minor League Baseball best record of 28-9 on the season.

#### This Day in Baseballtown History

May 20, 2016: At Reading, the Fightin Phils build an 8-0 lead over the first 5 innings, then hold on to beat Trenton, 8-7. Dylan Cozens homers and drives in 4. Miguel Nunez strikes out all 4 batters he faces to preserve the win and notch his 3rd save.

#### 'Sup Somerset

This is the first series of the season between Reading and Somerset. The Patriots sit second in the Northeast Division with a 23-13 record. Last week at Portland, Somerset split the six-game series, with the teams alternating wins in the series between the top-two teams in the division. Next up, the Patriots hit the road for a six-game series at Erie next week before welcoming Portland to Jersey the week after.

#### The Patriot Pitcher

Righty Gray Fenter gets the start tonight for Somerset. He is 2-1, with a 3.68 ERA over five starts so far this season. Over 22-innings pitched, Fenter has 30 strikeouts, 10 walks and 16 hits allowed. At Portland last Saturday, he went 4.2 innings, allowing three hits, one run, four walks and six strikeouts. He spent 2022 in Richmond and 2021 in Bowie. He was released by the Giants last summer and finished the season with the Lancaster Barnstomers, who won the Atlantic League Championship. He signed with the Yankees in February.

They found a bargain later on in the period, in January of 2018, when they inked Rojas for just \$10K. In each of his two years of full season ball, he's started slowly but finished well offensively, showing off his plus speed and defense at all stops. He made it to Double-A for the first time in 2022 and then finished with a strong performance in the Arizona Fall League before getting added to the 40-man roster. Rojas has shown he can be an impact player on both sides of the ball thanks to his near-top-of-the-scale speed. He's an elite baserunner, one who stole 62 bases in 67 tries last season and then went 13-for-13 in the AFL. His speed is an obvious asset in the outfield, where he is a premium defender in center field, one who could be a Gold Glov.
