SEA DOGS SPLIT THE TWIN BILL The Sea Dogs took down the Somerset Patriots 4-2 in game one and fell in game two 3-0 to the Somerset Patriots in last night's doubleheader. In the fourth inning of game two, the Sea Dogs offense went to work, as they took the lead. A leadoff single from Allan Castro coupled with a walk to Blaze Jordan put Castro in scoring position. The next batter Tyler Miller, cracked an RBI single to tie the game at 1-1. After a walk to Mark Kolozsvary loaded the bases, Ahbram Liendo lined a two-run single that scored Jordan and Miller to make the score 3-1. In the next at-bat, Max Ferguson singled home Kolozsvary and brought the Sea Dogs lead to 4-1. In game two, Garrett Martin ripped an RBI single that brought Lombard Jr. into score, which gave the Patriots a 1-0 advantage in the third inning. In the fifth inning, Max Burt cracked an RBI single that pushed the lead to 2-0. In the bottom of the sixth, Somerset tacked on one more run courtesy of a solo home run from Dylan Jasso.

STILL RACKING UP THE STRIKEOUTS The Sea Dogs rank third in the Eastern League in strikeout with 338 through 32 games so far. Portland is fifth in the league with a 3.42 ERA. Yordanny Monegro currently leads the Sea Dogs with 37 strikeouts in 21.1 innings.

OFF TO THE WOO RHP Tyler Uberstine was promoted to AAA Worcester on Thursday. At the time of his promotion, he led the Sea Dogs with 35 strikeouts. In six starts, he tossed 29.2 innings allowing 13 runs (12 earned) on 27 hits while walking four.

ON BRAND RHP Jonathan Brand has had a great start to the season for Portland. In seven appearances out of the bullpen, he is 1-0 with a 0.00 ERA. He has tossed 10.0 innings allowing five hits while walking six and striking out 16. Brand has also recorded two saves.

WHERE DO WE STAND The Sea Dogs have sole possession of first place of the Northeast Division of the Eastern League. They have a 0.5 game lead over the Binghamton Rumble Ponies and Hartford Yard Goats. The Somerset Patriots are in third place, 5.5 games behind Portland.

THIS DAY IN SEA DOGS HISTORY May 16, 2015 – One night after hitting for the cycle, Tim Roberson went 4-for-5 in Portland's 9-4 win at New Britain. Jantzen Witte fell a double shy of the cycle, going 3-for-5, HR and 3 RBI.

ON THE MOUND LHP Dalton Rogers will start for the Sea Dogs tonight making his Double-A debut. In five games (one start) with the High-A Greenville Drive this year, he is 2-1 with a 1.31 ERA. Rogers has tossed 20.2 innings allowing six runs (three earned) on 13 hits while walking 10 and striking out 28. He only gave up one home run.

Leading the Sea Dogs

Manager - Chad Epperson

Manager Chad Epperson will lead the team in his fourth season in Portland. In 2024, he led the Sea Dogs to a 78-60 record, the best record in the Northeast Division of the Eastern League, and third best in the league. In his fourth season with the team, he is tied for the longest serving manager in Sea Dogs history with Arnie Beyeler who managed Portland for four seasons from 2007 to 2010. Before managing the Sea Dogs, Epperson spent 12 seasons as the Red Sox Catching Coordinator.

Pitching Coach - Sean Isaac

Sean Isaac will serve as Portland's pitching coach for a third season. Under his leadership, the Sea Dogs' pitching staff led Double-A in strikeouts (1,329) and were second in saves (40) in 2024. In 2022 he was the assistant pitching coach for the Nashville Sounds, the Triple-A affiliate of the Milwaukee Brewers. Previously, Isaac served as the Director of Player Development at UC-Santa Barbara.

Pitching Coach - Juan Rivera

Juan Rivera will join Sean Isaac as a second pitching coach with Portland. Rivera spent the last three seasons as Salem Red Sox' pitching coach and led the pitching staff to a 3.61 ERA, fourth-best in Single-A. A graduate of Eastern Nazarene College, he has been in the Red Sox organization since 2022 as a Development Coach with Salem.

Hitting Coach - Chris Hess

Chris Hess returns to Portland for his second year as the Sea Dogs' hitting coach after serving as the Greenville Drive's hitting coach in 2023. Last season, Portland's hitters led Double-A in runs (711), doubles (285), RBI (658), slugging (.412) and OPS (.753). They ranked second in average (.257), hits (1,221), and OBP (.348). He was a coach for the Sea Dogs in 2022 and in Fort Myers during the 2021 season. This year will mark Hess' fifth year in the Red Sox organization.

Assistant Hitting Coach - Johnny Reina

Johnny Reina will serve as Assistant Hitting Coach after working as a Hitting Trainer at Driveline Baseball in Seattle, Washington. Driveline Baseball's mission is to develop the future of baseball training by finding industry-leading insights, all while publishing those insights back to the baseball community.

Defensive Coach - Kyle Sasala

Kyle Sasala will be on staff for his second season in Portland after previously working as the Associate Head Coach at Grove City College from 2016 – 2023. Sasala helped the 2023 Wolverines to a school-record 30 victories, along with a 16-4 conference record.

Athletic Trainer - Bobby Stachura

Stachura returns to Portland for his third season as the Sea Dogs' Athletic Trainer. Stachura has served as the Athletic Trainer for Single-A Greenville for the past four seasons. He started in the Red Sox organization in 2017 as the Athletic Trainer for the Lowell Spinners. He also spent four years as an athletic trainer at the University of Rhode Island. Stachura graduated with a B.S. in Athletic Training from Lasell College in 2013.

Strength and Conditioning Coach - Jonah Mondloch

Strength and Conditioning Coach Jonah Mondloch joins the staff for his first season in Portland, but his second year in the Red Sox organization. He was previously an Assistant Rehab Strength and Conditioning Coach. In that role, he assisted in the strength and conditioning for players returning to the field.
