LAST TIME OUT: Brooklyn emerged with its 2nd-straight victory, 5-3, on Wednesday afternoon vs. Aberdeen...IronBirds took a 1-0 lead in the top of the first, but the Cyclones tied it on a SS Jett Williams leadoff home rum...Brooklyn took the lead for good with 3 runs in the 4th on a RF Omar De Los Santos run-scoring infield single, plus a throwing error, and a RBI double from Williams... LF Jacob Teter provided a 2-run double for Aberdeen in the 7th...Cyclones added insurance on a 2B D'Andre Smith RBI single in the 8th...Smith, Williams, and DH Ryan Clifford recorded multihit games for Brooklyn...C Samuel Basallo reached base 3 times for Aberdeen, adding a double and a walk...RHP Jordany Ventura struck out a career-high 10 over 6.2 innings of 1-run and 1-hit ball to earn his 3rd-straight win...LHP Eli Ankeney recorded the final 6 outs for his 3rd save.

OUT IN FRONT: SS **Jett Williams** started the home first inning for the Cyclones with a solo home run off RHP **Trace Bright** — the first of his Brooklyn career — in Wednesday's win vs. Aberdeen...The 19-year-old's blast marked the 2nd leadoff home run for the Cyclones in 2023... LF **Alex Ramírez** was the first to accomplish the feat, smacking a solo home run to left-center field off RHP **Johan Domínguez** on May 24 vs. Winston-Salem...Both leadoff home runs came in Wednesday afternoon games on Coney Island...OF **Ross Adolph** and INF **Rylan Sandoval** are tied for the franchise record in leadoff home runs with 3 in 2018 and 2010, respectively.

AIR JORDANY: RHP Jordany Ventura set new career highs in innings pitched (7.1) and strikeouts (9), earning the win and tossing a quality start in August 2's win at Jersey Shore...He then set a new career-high with 10 strikeouts in his next start on August 9 vs. Aberdeen, allowing 1 run and 1 hit over 6.2 innings...Ventura tossed a career and team-season-high 101 pitches and 66 strikes... The 101 pitches were the most thrown by a Brooklyn pitcher since RHP Briam Campusano tossed 103 pitches (57 strikes) over 5.2 innings in a 5-2 loss at West Virginia on July 28, 2018... In 5 starts with Brooklyn, the Mets' No. 29 prospect per Baseball America is 3-0 with a 2.73 ERA (8 ER in 26.1 IP), 13 walks (12.7 BB%), and 27 strikeouts (26.5 K%)... Narrowed down to his last 3 starts, Ventura is 3-0 with a 2.37 ERA (5 ER in 19.0 IP) and 8 walks (11.3 BB%) to 23 strikeouts (32.4 K%) with only 6 hits allowed...Brooklyn is 5-0 in starts made by the 23-year-old.

BIG APPLE ELI: LHP Eli Ankeney tossed a pair of shutout innings to earn his 3rd save of his professional career on Wednesday afternoon vs. Aberdeen...Between Brooklyn and Single-A St. Lucie, the 22-year-old has accrued a 1.42 ERA (5 ER in 31.2 IP) in 21 appearances (1 start)... Among Minor League pitchers with 30.0-plus innings pitched and 1-or-fewer starts, Ankeney is 9th in ERA (1.42)...Ankeney is also tied for 3rd in fewest hits allowed (14), 7th in opposing batting average (133)...Since making his Brooklyn debut on June 3 at Jersey Shore, the Phoenix, Ariz. native is tied for 2nd among South Atlantic League relievers with 20.0-plus IP in fewest hits allowed (12), 3rd in batting average against (160), 5th in ERA (1.99), and 9th in opposing OPS (.579).

THE JETT AND JACOB SHOW: INFs Jett Williams and Jacob Reimer have made an impact since making their Cyclones debut last Tuesday...Williams has reached base safely in all 8 games played with the club and is 7-for-24 (.292) at the plate with 3 runs scored, 2 doubles, a home run, 4 RBI, 4 stolen bases, and 9 walks (26.5 BB%) to 7 strikeouts...Since returning from the All-Star break on July 14, the 19-year-old is slashing .328/51f/.612 with a 1.123 OPS, 6 doubles, 2 triples, 3 home runs, 8 RBI, 24 walks, and 10 stolen bases in 21 games between Brooklyn and Single-A St. Lucie...On the season, Williams is 6th in Minor League Baseball in walks (78)...Since June 1, Reimer has recorded a .309/.439/.483 slash line with a .922 OPS, 33 runs scored, 8 doubles, 6 home runs, 30 RBI, and 28 walks in 45 games between 3 levels in the Mets' system.

STAN THE MAN: OF Stanley Consuegra smashed a 2-run home run in the 4th inning on Tuesday and has now picked up a long ball in 3 of his last 4 games dating back to last Thursday night at Jersey Shore...Since making his return from the injured list on June 29, the 22-year-old is tied with his teammate OF Ryan Clifford for the South Atlantic League in home runs (9)...He is also tied for 9th in RBI (22) and tied for 10th in total bases (59)...On the year, Consuegra is tied for 8th in the SAL in home runs (14) and 9th in slugging percentage (.467)...His 14 home runs are also tied for 5th in the Mets' organization.

JAWILME'S BIG BITE: RHP Jawilme Ramírez was outstanding in his High-A and Cyclones debut on Thursday night...The 21-year-old became the first Brooklyn pitcher in 2023 to work into the 9th inning, ultimately tossing a career-high 8.0 innings of 3-run ball...Ramírez allowed 6 hits, did not walk a batter, and struck out 4...The Dominican native was the first Brooklyn pitcher to complete 8-full innings and work into the 9th since RHP Conner Grey carried a no-hit bid into the 9th inning vs. Jersey Shore on July 16, 2021...Grey ultimately tossed 8.1 innings that day... No Cyclone pitcher has tossed a 9-inning complete game since RHP John Gant posted a 1-hit shutout on August 28, 2013, at Maimonides Park vs. Tri-City.

CLIFFORD THE CYCLONE: OF Ryan Clifford was added to Brooklyn's roster last Thursday...The 20-year-old was acquired by the New York Mets with OF Drew Gilbert from the Houston Astros in exchange for RHP Justin Verlander on August 1...Clifford smashed a 2-run home run to right in his first at-bat and closed out his organizational debut with a 2-for-3 day, adding 2 walks and 2 runs scored on August 3 at Jersey Shore...Clifford was ranked as Houston's No. 3 prospect at midseason by Baseball America and is deemed the Mets' No. 6 farmhand by MLB Pipeline... The 2022 1tht-round pick enters Thursday ranked 2nd in the South Atlantic League in slugging percentage (525)...He is also 3rd in OPS (874) and tied for 4th in home runs (17)...Among players with at least 250 plate appearances, Clifford is 2nd in isolated power (.263), 5th in OPS (.875), and 6th in wOBA (.385) and wRC+ (132).

ALEX THE AMAZING: Since the start of June, OF Alex Ramírez is tied for 3rd in the South Atlantic League in runs scored (39)...Dating back to his 6-hit game on July 21 at Hudson Valley, the 20-year-old is slashing .343/.375/.478 with a .853 OPS...Ramírez is 23-for-67 at the plate (.343) with 10 runs scored, 6 doubles, a home run, 9 RBI, 4 walks, and 5 stolen bases...Alex is scattered among the Cyclones' all-time leaderboard despite joining the team last July 4...Entering Thursday, the Dominican native is tied with INF Luke Ritter for 2nd in franchise history in RBI (80) and is 11 behind INF José Peroza (91) for the all-time mark...He surpassed Peroza for 1st in doubles (36), is 2nd in total bases (222) and hits (151), and 3rd in runs scored (79).

THE RHY-T STUFF: In 20 games since July 4 at Wilmington, OF Rhylan Thomas is slashing .359/.393/.423 with a .816 OPS at the dish and a 135 wRC+...Thomas has added 10 runs scored, 2 doubles, a home run, 9 RBI, and 5 walks to only 5 strikeouts...The left-handed swinger has composed multi-hit efforts in 7 of his last 16 games dating back to July 18 at Hudson Valley, slashing .373/.393/.458 with a .851 OPS and 147 wRC+...Thomas already has as many RBI (9) as he did in St. Lucie in 42 fewer plate appearances (139 to 97)...Among players with 85 or more

vs. ABERDEEN: Brooklyn returns home to open up a 2-week homestand with 6 games against the Orioles' High-A affiliate...The IronBirds possess 4 of Baltimore's top 30 prospects per Baseball America: C Samuel Basallo (6), C Creed Willems (25), RHP Juan Núñez (27), and RHP Trace Bright (30)... Brooklyn and Aberdeen are meeting at Maimonides Park for the 2nd and final time and the first time since the two side split a 6-game series from May 2-7...The Cyclones are 8-6 (.571) against the Iron-Birds in the first 12 meetings of the campaign...Dating back to their first meeting in 2002, Brooklyn is 124-111 all-time against Aberdeen (.528).

plate appearances since the start of July, Thomas ranks 3rd in the South Atlantic League in batting average (.346) and has 3 fewer strikeouts (6) than any other batter.

THE ROCO SHOW: RHP Robert Colina has been on a tear since he struck out a season-high 7 on June 21 vs. Hudson Valley, which was matched on August 1 at Jersey Shore...After tossing a season-high 5.1 innings of shutout relief on Tuesday, Colina holds a 3-0 record with a 1.53 ERA (5 ER in 29.1 IP)...The 22-year-old has surrendered just 21 hits and walked 6 with 35 strikeouts over his last 8 appearances (3 start), Colina...Colina's strikeout rate is up 3.4 percent (31.8 K%) and walk rate is down 1.8 percent (5.5 BB%) during the time span.

BANANA'S FOR FOSTER: RHP Cameron Foster took the loss but punched out a career-high 12 on July 29 vs. Wilmington...The 12 punchouts are the most by a Cyclone pitcher in 2023...Foster is the 3rd different Brooklyn arm to strike out 10+ batters in a single game this year...RHP Tyler Stuart whiffed 11 on June 22, while RHP Blade Tidwell has accomplished the feat 4 times...The Houston native is the first Cyclone pitcher to strikeout 12-plus batters in a single contest sine RHP Marcos Molina collected 12 strikeouts on August 15, 2014, in a 7-0 win at Vermont...Foster is the first to accomplish the feat at home since RHP Collin McHugh collected 12 K's vs. Jamestown on August 8, 2009...Since the start of June, the 24-year-old holds a 2-2 record with a 3.05 ERA (15 ER in 44.1 IP) with 13 walks and 52 strikeouts over 9 starts...Foster's strikeout rate is up 3.7% from his overall numbers (28.3% from 24.6%) and his walk rate is down 1.9% (71% from 9.0%).

THE BEST AROUND: Since the start of a 4-game winning streak at Hudson Valley on May 17, the Cyclones' pitching staff has, statistically, been the most dominant in Minor League Baseball... Entering Thursday, Brooklyn has posted a Mil.B-low 3.01 ERA (210 ER in 628.0 IP) over their last 72 games, holding a 41-31 record in that span...The Yankees' High-A Hudson Valley (3.26) is 2nd in the minors and SAL...The Cyclones have hurled 7 shutouts in that span and hold a strikeout rate of 28.1% and a walk rate of 10.9%...Additionally, Brooklyn pitching holds the 2nd lowest opposing OPS (.620), in addition to the 3rd lowest hits-per-9 innings (6.94) and batting average against (.210) in that period...RHPs Tyler Stuart (1.80), Blade Tidwell (1.92), and RHP Christian Scott (2.35) hold the 1st, 2nd, and 4th best ERA's in Mil.B during that time (min. 65.0 IP).

BULLPEN BOOM: The Cyclones' relief staff has been exquisite at quelling fires in 2023...Entering Thursday, Brooklyn holds the best bullpen ERA (3.41) in the entire South Atlantic League and the 4th-lowest throughout Minor League Baseball...The Rangers' Single-A Down East (3.10) leads Mil.B.

TOP OF THE CYCLONE: Brooklyn 7-series streak without losing a set came to a close with Sunday's loss at Jersey Shore...Brooklyn had not dropped a set since Greenville won 4-of-6 on Coney Island from June 6-f1, going 5-0-2...The Cyclones are 24-14 in the second half and hold a 3-game lead in the North Division of the SAL over Jersey Shore (21-17)...Brooklyn is 2.5-games behind Hickory (26-11) for the best record in the circuit during the half.

I GOT YOUR SIX: OF Alex Ramírez became the first player in Cyclones history to record a 6-hit game with a 6-for-6 performance on July 21 at Hudson Valley...The 20-year-old also stole 3 bases, scored 3 runs, drove in a tally, and robbed 3B Marcos Cabrera of a home run in the 2nd inning... Ramírez is 1-of-5 players in Minor League Baseball to compose a 6-hit game in 2023...Alex is the first player in Minor League Baseball since the stat portal began in 2005 to record 6+ hits and 3+ stolen bases in a single game...Only two players in Major League history have accomplished the feat in the modern era (since 1901)...OF Sammy Sosa (Chicago-NL, 7/2/93 at Colorado) and OF Max Carey (Pittsburgh, 7/7/22 vs. New York-NL).

DE RECORD SETTER: OF Omar De Los Santos entered as a pinch-runner and stole second base on July 21 at Hudson Valley, giving him 33 stolen bases in 2023...The current 34 swipes breaks INF Walter Rasquin's franchise record for single-season stolen bases (32) which was set back in 2017 when Brooklyn played in the short-season New York-Penn League...He is also 4th in the SAL in stolen bases for 2023...De Los Santos remains among the best base stealers in Minor League Baseball since the beginning of 2022...The Dominican native has accumulated 104 stolen bases in that span, which is 7th most in MilB...Only Aberdeen OF Luis Valdez (114), D'Backs prospect OF Wilderd Patiño (113), Mariners farmhand OF Jonatan Clasé (113), Red Sox prospect INF David Hamilton (113), Marlins farmhand INF Nasim Núñez (110), and Cardinals prospect OF Mike Antico (107) have tallied more...De Los Santos has also snagged 56 more bases than any other Mets prospect in that time...Fellow 2023 Cyclone IF/OF Jaylen Palmer is 2nd with 48.

AMAZIN' STARTS HERE: Baseball America released their updated list of Top 30 New York Mets' prospects on Wednesday...10 members of the 2023 squad are featured...OF Ryan Clifford (No. 3), SS Jett Williams (4), C Kevin Parada (7), RHP Blade Tidwell (9), RHP Christian Scott (10), OF Alex Ramírez (12), 3B Jacob Reimer (14), RHP Tyler Stuart (22), RHP Raimon Gómez (24), and RHP Jordany Ventura (29)...Former Cyclones listed include: INF Ronny Mauricio (No. 6), RHP Mike Vasil (8), RHP Dominic Hamel (19), OF Matt Rudick (20), and RHP Junior Santos (27)...In all, 15-of-30 members of BA's Top 30 have experience playing on Coney Island.

Has thrived in a starting role, tallying a 2-2 record with a 2.89 ERA (9 ER in 28.0 IP) with 6 walks and 11 strikeouts in 6 starts...In 12 appearances out of the bullpen, Ramírez composed a 2-6 record with a 6.06 ERA (33 ER in 49.0 IP), 17 walks, and 50 strikeouts.

2022: Started the campaign with the Florida Complex League Mets...Named FCL Pitcher of the Year and a FCL Post-Season All-Star...Composed a 1-0 record with a 0.84 ERA (4 ER in 43.0 IP), 1 save, 6 walks (3.8 BB%), and 40 strikeouts (25.3 K%) in 11 appearances (6 starts)...Transferred to Single-A St. Lucie on September 1...Made 2 relief appearances and accrued a 1-0 record...Did not allow a run on 2 hits over 3.1 innings, striking out 3 and walking 4.
