YESTERDAY: The Flying Squirrels lost to the Baysox, 2-1. **John Michael Bertrand** started and threw six hitless innings with five strikeouts, issuing two walks. Bertrand has now pitched 13 hitless innings against the Baysox this season. **Vaun Brown** gave Richmond a 1-0 lead in the third inning with a lead-off homer. In the bottom of the seventh, TT Bowens broke up the no-hit bid and tied the game with a two-out, RBI double. Samuel Basallo gave the Baysox a 2-1 lead with a two-out, two-strike single in the bottom of the eighth. The Flying Squirrels were held to four hits in the game but held the Baysox to two hits. **Carter Howell** had a single and a walk. **Will Wilson** walked three times.

TODAY'S GAME: The Flying Squirrels face the Bowie Baysox, Double-A affiliate of the Baltimore Orioles, in the third of a six-game series. This is the first of two visits to Bowie for Richmond. They will return for a three-game series at Prince George's Stadium from July 1-3. Richmond won four-of-six against Bowie at The Diamond earlier this season.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS have gone 7-2 in their last nine games after going 1-12 over a 13-game span from April 28-May 12, including 1-11 on the last road trip to Akron and Erie. They had lost eight straight games before winning last Wednesday night, starting a five-game winning streak.

THE BAYSOX are in fourth place in the Southwest Division, 3.5 games behind first-place Akron. They won four-of-six last week at Binghamton. Bowie's roster includes nine of MLB.com's top-30 Orioles prospects, including C/1B Samuel Basallo (No. 2), OF Dylan Beavers (No. 7), RHP Seth Johnson (No. 10), OF Jud Fabian (No. 12), INF Max Wagner (No. 14), RHP Trace Bright (No. 16), OF John Rhodes (No. 23), RHP Alex Pham (No. 24) and INF Frederick Bencosme (No. 27). Baseball America's top-30 Orioles prospects list features 10 Baysox players, including Basallo (No. 2), Johnson (No. 9), Beavers (No. 10), Fabian (No. 12), Wagner (No. 14), Bright (No. 20), Rhodes (No. 26), Pham (No. 27), Bencosme (No. 28) and RHP Keagan Gillies (No. 29). On Baseball America's "Best Tools" list for Orioles prospects, Basallo is rated as the best power hitter, Pham is rated as having the best control, Bright is rated as having the best curveball, Silas Ardoin is rated as the best defensive catcher and Fabian is rated as the best outfield arm.

FOR RICHMOND: Right-hander **Carson Ragsdale** makes his ninth Double-A start and his third against the Baysox. In his last start on Saturday night against the Fightin' Phils, Ragsdale picked up his first Double-A win and set a season high with nine strikeouts over five scoreless innings. In that start, he allowed three hits and did not issue a walk. It was his second five-inning scoreless start of the year, with the other coming in his most recent outing against the Baysox on April 28 at The Diamond. He also faced Bowie on April 23 and allowed two runs over 4.1 innings. In the Eastern League this season, Ragsdale is ranked third in strikeout percentage (32.9%), fourth in K/9 (11.61), eighth in BAA (.198) and 11th in ERA (3.03). Last season, he made seven starts for High-A Eugene, going 0-1 with a 2.93 ERA. His season ended in May with an oblique injury. At the time of the injury, he was leading the Northwest League in strikeouts (42) and ranked third in innings pitched (27.2). In 2022, he made five appearances in the Arizona Complex League but missed most of the year after having Thoracic Outlet Syndrome surgery in the spring. Ragsdale was selected by the Philadelphia Phillies in the fourth round of the 2020 MLB Draft out of the University of South Florida. Before making his professional debut, he was traded to the San Francisco Giants on January 9, 2021 for pitcher Sam Coonrod. **For more on Ragsdale, see page two.**

FOR BOWIE: Right-hander Alex Pham makes his ninth start of the season and his second against the Flying Squirrels. He last pitched on Saturday at Binghamton and allowed one run over 4.2 innings while striking out a season-high seven batters. In his last outing against the Flying Squirrels, Pham surrendered three runs over five innings in a no-decision at The Diamond on April 24. After starting the year 0-1 with a 7.78 ERA (17 ER/19.2 IP) in his first five starts, Pham is 1-0 with a 1.88 ERA (3 ER/14.1 IP) in his last three starts since May 7. Pham faced the Flying Squirrels three times last year, going 0-1 with a 2.77 ERA (4 ER/13.0 IP). After a mid-season promotion from High-A Aberdeen, he went 0-2 with a 2.67 ERA in his 14 outings (nine starts) for the Baysox last year. Pham was selected in the 19th round of the 2021 MLB Draft out of the University of San Francisco, where he was teammates with former Flying Squirrels catcher Robert Emery. He is rated by MLB.com as the No. 24 Orioles prospect and No. 27 by Baseball America. He is also rated by Baseball America as having the best control in the Orioles system.

PACKING THE HOUSE: The Flying Squirrels drew an average of 7,113 fans last month for their home games at The Diamond to open the season, their highest April average in franchise history, pending today's attendance. The previous high was 6,891 in 2014 followed by 6,571 in 2019. This season, the Flying Squirrels are leading all 30 Double-A teams and are ranked second among the 120 minor league clubs in average home attendance, trailing only Dayton (8,009).

HATS FOR BATS, KEEP BATS WARM: Over the last nine games since May 14, the Flying Squirrels are hitting .260 (74-for-285), second-best in the league, and have scored 49 runs, an average of 5.4 runs per game. Over the previous 13 games from April 28-May 12, the Richmond offense hit a league-worst .171 (69-for-407) and averaged 1.7 runs per game (22 runs/13 games). The Flying Squirrels broke the slump with a four-run eighth inning in a 6-4 win last Wednesday night. In winning six-of-their-last-seven, the Flying Squirrels have outscored Reading and Bowie, 49-24.

STRONG ARMS: Dating back to May 14 in the last nine games, the Flying Squirrels have a 2.37 ERA (20 ER/76.0 IP), which is the best in the Eastern League. In that span, Richmond starters are 3-0 with a 2.46 ERA (11 ER/40.1 IP). Flying Squirrels relievers have gone 4-2 with two saves and a 2.27 ERA (9 ER/35.2 IP) in that stretch.

THE 'PEN IS MIGHTY: There are three relievers on the active Richmond roster who hold a sub-2.00 ERA so far this season. Among Eastern League relievers, two Richmond pitchers rank in the top-10 in ERA, including **Evan Gates** (3rd - 1.17 ERA - 3 ER/23.0 IP) and **Nick Garcia** (7th - 1.45 ERA - 3 ER/18.2 IP). **Wil Jensen** (1.91 ERA - 6 ER/28.1 IP) ranks first the league in relief innings pitched.

SETTING THE TABLE: **Carter Howell** is batting .310 (18-for-58) over his last 16 games since May 3 with three doubles, a homer, six RBIs, 10 walks and six runs scored. Last Thursday night in the second game of a doubleheader against the Fightin' Phils, he hit a go-ahead, two-run homer in the fifth inning in a 3-1 win. In his 11 games batting first in the lineup, Howell is batting .310 (13-for-42) with two doubles and six walks. When leading off an inning, Howell is batting a team-best .419 (13-for-31).

GRANTING WISHES: In his last eight games since May 15, **Grant McCray** is batting .478 (11-for-23) with two homers, four doubles, a triple, six walks, seven RBIs and 12 runs scored, raising his season batting average from .135 to .197. He picked up a season-high three hits on Tuesday night at Bowie. For the season, McCray is batting .135 (14-for-104) when batting first in the lineup compared to .478 (11-for-23) when batting third, fifth or sixth in the order. He is tied for fifth in the Eastern League with 16 extra-base hits this year.

THOMAS THE TANK ENGINE: **Andy Thomas** is batting .346 (9-for-26) over his last seven games since May 15 with three doubles and five RBIs, raising his batting average for the year from .193 to .228. Thomas has picked up two hits in three-of-his-last-five games played dating back to the second game of last Thursday's doubleheader and has picked up three doubles in that same stretch.

WILL POWER: **Will Wilson** has reached base six times in the first three games of this season. On Tuesday, he went 1-for-4 with a two-run homer. He followed with a 2-for-5 performance on Wednesday and added a solo home run. On Thursday night, Wilson went 0-for-1 but walked three times. In this week's series, Wilson is batting .300 (3-for-10).

PROSPECT WATCH: Seven of Baseball America's top-30 Giants prospects are on the roster, including **Hayden Birdsong** (No. 6), **Grant McCray** (No. 10), **Vaun Brown** (No. 11), **Eric Silva** (No. 22), **Adrián Sugastey** (No. 25), **Ryan Murphy** (No. 28) and **José Cruz** (No. 30). In Baseball America's Best Tool in the Giants Organization list, **John Michael Bertrand** is rated as having the best control, Sugastey is rated as the best defensive catcher and McCray is rated as the best defensive outfielder and best outfield arm. Six players landed on MLB.com's top-30 Giants prospects list, including Birdsong (No. 6), McCray (No. 13), Brown (No. 15), **Victor Bericoto** (No. 20), Sugastey (No. 24) and OF **Jairo Pomares** (No. 26).

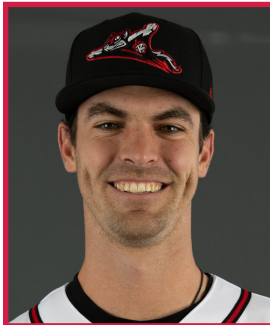
