TONIGHT'S GAME: Welcome to LoanMart Field for tonight's game, as your Rancho Cucamonga Quakes (Los Angeles Dodgers) host the San Jose Giants (San Francisco Giants) in game two of a six-game home stand. Tonight is Raising Cane's Bark in the Ballpark, as four-legged friends are welcome with the purchase of a \$3 Pet Pass. Tickets for all Quakes home games are available at rcquakes.com.

VS THE GIANTS: Today's game is the second of 12 against the Giants here in 2024 and the second of six at LoanMart Field. Last season, the Quakes went 8-4 against the Giants, 4-2 here at LoanMart Field.

LAST GAME: San Jose rallied from a two-run deficit, scoring the game's final three runs to take down the Quakes on Tuesday night, 3-2 at LoanMart Field. Bo Davidson's two-run, two-out single off Christian Ruebeck put San Jose ahead to stay in the eighth inning, sending Joseilyn Gonzalez (3-1) to his first loss. Giants relievers Ryan Vanderhei (2-1) and Junior Flores (4th save) combined to work the final four innings of scoreless relief, allowing just one hit. Kendall George had three of Rancho's five hits and drove in both runs for the Quakes. Starter Christian Zazueta enjoyed his best outing to date, scattering three hits over four scoreless innings in the no-decision. The loss ends Rancho's three-game winning streak, while also ending San Jose's three-game losing streak.

TRADE DEADLINE LEADS TO ROSTER MOVES: The annual MLB Trade Deadline was Tuesday afternoon and the Dodgers were busy over the last few days. Moves that impacted the Quakes specifically included INFs Jeral Perez and Alexander Albertus leaving Rancho for the Chicago White Sox, as part of the three-team trade with the St. Louis Cardinals that returned INF Tommy Edman and RHP Michael Kopech to Los Angeles. Taking one of those spots on the roster is Rancho's first 2024 draft addition, infielder Elijah Hainline, a seventh-rounder from Oregon State University. In addition, RHP Callum Wallace was placed on the Injured List.

WELCOME BACK HOPE: Zyhir Hope's return to the Rancho lineup was incredible on Saturday, as he went 4-for-5 with a walk in six plate appearances. Hope drove in a season-high five runs and smashed a 445-foot home run (4), his first round-tripper since April 7. Hope has been on the Injured List since April 29, after injuring his right shoulder during an at-bat against Lake Elsinore on April 28. Hope was acquired in a trade with the Chicago Cubs earlier this year and is ranked as the Dodgers' 20th best prospect according to MLB Pipeline.

SERIES WINS: The Quakes won their second series in San Bernardino over the weekend by virtue of taking five of six games in the series. The Quakes won their other series at Inland Empire back in April by taking five of six. This is also their third series win of the second-half, after taking four of six over Inland Empire at LoanMart Field to open the second half, as well as five of six at Stockton just two weeks ago.

ALEX MAKAREWICZ: Right-hander Alex Makarewicz makes his seventh start and eighth overall appearance, his first against the Giants. Recently spent almost a month on the Injured List, as today will be just his third outing since June 23, when he allowed four runs on two hits with three walks, while recording just two outs in a no-decision against Inland Empire. In his last start, he scattered one hit, two walks and a hit batter in a scoreless 1.2 innings of work in a no-decision at Inland Empire on July 25. Makarewicz was drafted by the Dodgers in the 13th round of the 2023 draft out of Northwestern State.

JOSH BOSTICK: Right-hander Josh Bostick makes his 20th appearance and 17th start, his first against the Quakes. In his last outing, Bostick allowed two runs on one hit, but with four walks in a no-decision against Modesto on July 25. Bostick was drafted by San Francisco in the eighth round of the 2023 draft out of Grayson CC in Texas.
