Homestand Part Two

The Fightin Phils remain home for the final week of the season's first half against the Hartford Yard Goats, Double-A affiliate of the Colorado Rockies. It is the 13th-of-24 matchups between the teams this season and seventh-of-12 games at FirstEnergy Stadium. Reading took the first series four to two from Apr. 7-12, then the teams split a series at Dunkin' Park from Apr. 28-May 3. Entering play today, Reading leads the season-series 7-5.

Another Series Win

The Reading Fightin Phils fell to the Portland Sea Dogs, 9-3, in the series finale at FirstEnergy Stadium, though Reading still claimed the six-game series, 4-2, for its first series win over Portland since July 2024. The game remained scoreless through four innings as Kyle Brnovich cruised early, but Portland broke it open with a seven-run fifth inning highlighted by home runs from Nelly Taylor, Stanley Tucker and Johanfran Garcia. Reading mounted a response in the seventh when Alex Binelas delivered an RBI double and another run scored on a wild pitch, cutting the deficit to 7-2. Portland added insurance runs in the eighth and ninth before Binelas capped the scoring with a solo home run, his 13th of the season. Brnovich was charged with the loss after allowing seven runs in 4.2 innings, while Portland starter John Holobetz earned the win with six scoreless innings and six strikeouts. Binelas and Raylin Heredia each reached base three times and collected two hits, but the Fightins were unable to overcome Portland's decisive fifth inning despite drawing six walks and winning the series overall.

Career Night for Seminaris

27-year old Adam Seminaris tossed arguably the best start of his professional career on Saturday night. He fired a career-high eight innings, allowing one run on three hits, while matching both a season and career-high with 10 strikeouts. His eight innings pitched marked the longest start by any Eastern League pitcher on this season and the most by a Fightin Phils' arm since Tyler Viza fired eight innings on Sept. 1, 2018, at Trenton. Following his dominant start on Saturday, Seminaris is third in the Eastern League in ERA (2.83), first in strikeouts (76), third in innings pitched (63.2) and fifth in WHIP (1.18). He joined the Phillies as a minor league free agent this past offseason after spending time in the Angels, Brewers and Marines organizations.

Going, Going, Gone

The Fightin Phils are back to hitting home runs at a torrid pace this past week, as they lifted an Eastern League-best 14 long balls through six games last week. Through 63 games, Reading has hit 79 home runs, which ranks tied for second in the Eastern League and they are on pace for 173 this season, which comes after Reading hit 118 in 2025. The Fightin Phils have been led this week by multiple home runs from Raylin Heredia (3), Caleb Ricketts (3), Alex Binelas (3) and Bryson Ware (2). Ware hit the go-ahead home run, a two-run shot, in Saturday night's 3-2 win over Portland.

Raking Raylin

Raylin Heredia has continued his steady 2026 season with another strong week against Portland. Over six games this week, Heredia slashed .348/.400/.826 (1.226 OPS), along with four runs, two doubles, three home runs and five RBI. Entering play on Tuesday, Heredia leads the Eastern League with 21 doubles, while also ranking third with 66 hits, first with 32 extra-base hits and third with 119 total bases.

Bring It Brito

Erick Brito's strong run with Reading continued last week as he slashed .400/.478/.700 (1.178 OPS) over six games, along with seven runs scored, three doubles, one home run, four RBI and five stolen bases. The highlight of his week was when he matched a career-high with four hits on Friday night, which featured a game-tying three-run home run in the bottom of the ninth with two outs. He has a hit in four of his last five games and is batting .309 (17-55) over 16 games with Reading so far.

Welcome Back Caleb

Following his transfer from Lehigh Valley (AAA) on Tuesday, Caleb Ricketts reintroduced himself to the Fightin Phils in a big way in his first game back. The 26-year old blasted two home runs, which marked the fourth two-homer game of his career, and second this season (4/21: LHV vs DUR). Ricketts also drove in a career-high six runs, surpassing his previous high of four on June 8, 2025, when rehabbing with Clearwater (A) against Bradenton. His two home runs was the third multi-homer game by a R-Phil this season and his grand slam was the fifth hit by Reading in 2026. Then, he followed it up with four more RBI and another home run on Wednesday night. Through six games with Reading, Ricketts is 8-26 (.308), with three home runs, 11 RBI and a 1.064 OPS. On the other side of the ball, Ricketts ended Thursday night's win with a caught stealing at second base to end the top of the ninth inning.

This Day in Baseballtown History

June 16, 2016: At Reading, the Fightin Phils' win streak reaches 10 games (8 of which the opponent scored first), as they rally from a 3-0 deficit again. Jesmuel Valentin is 3-for-5 with a home run, 2 RBIs and 2 runs. The 5-3 win completes a 3-game sweep of a series that was supposed to be played in Hartford.

Hey Hartford

The Yard Goats enter play this week with a 35-27, which leads the Eastern League's Northeast Division by 0.5 games, in a race that will go down to the wire. Hartford had a good week against New Hampshire last week, taking five-of-seven games. Following this week, Hartford starts the second half at home against Portland. Hartford's roster features six of the Colorado Rockies Top-30 prospects: Jared Thomas (4), Griffin Herring (9), Roc Riggio (10), Jackson Cox (19), Cole Messina (21) and Konner Eaton (25).

Goats Pitcher

Lefty, and Rockies' No. 25 prospect, Konner Eaton makes his 12th start of the season tonight for Hartford. So far, Eaton is 4-0, with a 3.43 ERA (24 ER, 63.0 IP), along with 58 strikeouts. Eaton last pitched on Wednesday against New Hampshire, allowing three runs on two hits over 6.1 innings pitched, with six strikeouts. He's faced Reading twice this season, allowing six-earned runs over 9.1 IP (5.79 ERA), along with 12 strikeouts. Eaton spent 2025 with Spokane (A+) and Hartford, going a combined 6-9, with a 3.79 ERA over 27 starts. He began his pro career in 2024 between Fresno (A) and Spokane. The Rockies drafted Eaton in the sixth round of the 2024 draft out of George Mason.
