John Cangelosi hit the ground running when he got to Goodland Field at the start of the 1983 season and never stopped. Cangelosi, the fourth-round pick of the Chicago White Sox in the 1982 draft, stole 87 bases in 128 games with the Appleton Foxes in 1983. He had 124 hits, walked 99 times, and only struck out 81 times in 558 plate appearances.

The stolen base total was in some dispute. In a September 7, 1983 edition of The Post-Crescent, a story by Gary Shriver covered the controversy. John Boles, the manager of the Foxes, had 91 stolen bases for Cangelosi. Howe News Bureau of Boston, the official compiler of Midwest League stats, had Cangelosi at 86 stolen bases. After a check and a few rechecks, the final official total was 87 after a discovery that someone forgot to put in one stolen base into the computer.

Cangelosi missed out on four stolen bases, which would have broken the old Midwest League record of 90, but he did not miss out on a Midwest League title in his first full season as a pro as he had big contributions to the Foxes beating the Springfield Cardinals for the 1983 pennant.



In Game Three of the Championship Series at Goodland Field, Cangelosi stole four bases, including home

in the first inning. He also drove in a run and scored another run in the Foxes 8-7 win for a 2-1 lead in the best-of-five series. In Game Four, it was Cangelosi's arm that helped the Foxes. The score was tied 3-3 in the fifth inning with one out and the bases loaded for Springfield. Cangelosi caught a fly ball to center and threw out the runner at the plate for an inning-ending double play. The Foxes would take the lead in the sixth and went on to a 4-3 victory for their second straight title.

Cangelosi left Appleton after that season to play 11 seasons in the Majors with the White Sox, Pittsburgh Pirates, Texas Rangers, New York Mets, Houston Astros, Miami Marlins, and Colorado Rockies with 154 steals. He also was part of the 1997 Miami Marlins World Series title team.

When it was time for Cangelosi to be inducted into the Appleton Professional Baseball Hall of Fame in 2007, Milt Drier called to let him know. Milt also told Cangelosi that he had to bring all those stolen bases back with him!

The Timber Rattlers beat Kane County 2-0 at home. Tristan Archer allowed five hits and struck out 11 over seven scoreless innings to get the win for Wisconsin.

#### July 31, 2004:

Wisconsin won 6-2 at Battle Creek. Adam Jones hit two homers and drove in five runs for Wisconsin. Iones hit a two-run homer in the first and a three-run homer in the fifth. Jones hit both homers against Yankees starting pitcher Tyler Clippard.

#### August 1, 2011:

The Rattlers beat Burlington 8-5 in 10 innings at home. Reggie Keen




and Nick Shaw had back-to-back RBI singles to tie the game in the bottom of the ninth. In the bottom of the 10th, Mike Brownstein won the game with a two-out, three-run, homer!

#### August 2, 2002:

Wisconsin won 2-1 at Beloit. Eddie Menchaca broke a scoreless tie with an RBI triple in the fifth inning. Hunter Brown followed with an RBI double. Ryan Ketchner allowed one run on two hits with six strikeouts over seven innings. Prince Fielder hit a homer for Beloit in his debut for the Snappers. It was Fielder's first Midwest League hit.

#### August 3, 2011:

Greg Hopkins broke a 1-1 tie with an RBI single in the bottom of the 12th inning to lift the Rattlers to a 2-1 victory over the Clinton LumberKings.



#### August 4, 2007:

Position player Leury Bonilla was called on in the bottom of the 12th inning to pick up the save in Wisconsin's 6-5 victory at Fort Wayne. Bonilla committed a balk to move the tying run to second before he struck out Matt Stocco on a 3-2 pitch to end the game.

# IIIPROSPECTS

The group of Milwaukee Brewers prospects collectively known as The Freshmen – Sal Frelick, Garret Mitchell, Joey Wiemer, Brice Turang, and Jackson Chourio – received a lot of attention last season, all were considered huge prospects in the system. They were the top five Brewers prospects when the 2023 Top 30 list was revealed in March of 2023 after all.

As we write this in early March of 2024 only Chourio, a Timber Rattler very briefly in 2022, has not made his MLB debut. By the time you read this, that will probably no longer be the case.

The top four Brewers Prospects – Chourio, Jacob Misiorowski, Jeferson Quero, and Tyler Black – have all played as Timber Rattlers. Not just that! All four of those former Rattlers mentioned are considered Top-50 Prospects in all baseball; Chourio (#2), Misiorowski (#33), Quero (#35), and Black (#46).

Back to the Brewers list, 12 of the Top-30 in the Milwaukee system played for the Rattlers before this season started. The number of Top-30 prospects will climb as 2024 progresses. Turn the page to see the rest of the 2024 Top 30 as it was when the list was unveiled on March 5.

MLB Pipeline updates their list every time a player spends enough time in the big leagues to graduate from prospect status or is traded. Plus, they will do major updates after the MLB Entry Draft when players who have been picked start signing their contracts.







#### VICTOR ESTEVEZ FIELD MANAGER

Estevez is in his 12th season as a member of the Milwaukee organization. He started as an infield coach for the Dominican Summer League affiliates in 2013 before becoming the manager of the DSL Brewers in 2016, a position he held through the 2021 season.

Last year was his second season in charge at Carolina. Estevez was named the Carolina League Manager of the Year in 2023 after the Mudcats compiled a 72-55 record and qualified for the playoffs for the first time since 2008. He is 302-300 in his minor league managerial career prior to this season.

A native of the Dominican Republic, Estevez was a player in the Arizona Diamondbacks organization from 2007 through 2010 after signing as an International Free Agent.

Estevez played two seasons (2009 and 2010) in the Midwest League for the South Bend Silver Hawks and played seven games against the Timber Rattlers, including three at Wisconsin in July of 2009, during his time with South Bend. Estevez completed his first season as the manager of Leones del Escogido in the Dominican Winter League in January.



#### JOSH SPENCE PITCHING COACH

Spence, who hails from Geelong, Victoria, Australia, begins his first full season as the pitching coach of the Timber Rattlers.

He took over as Wisconsin's pitching coach in June of last season after Drew Thomas took a position at the University of Central Florida.

The former major league pitcher with the San Diego Padres played for current Milwaukee Brewers manager Pat Murphy at Arizona State University and helped the team reach the NCAA Division I College World Series in 2009. Spence started his coaching career in the Padres organization in 2016 before joining the Brewers system in 2022.



#### TIM DOHERTY HITTING COACH

Doherty is in his first season with the Brewers. Last year the Kansas City native was the hitting coach for the Harrisburg Senators, the Eastern League affiliate of the Washington Nationals.

He has moved up the ranks from college as a coach at Oral Roberts University,






Fans who showed up for the April 8, 2004 home opener against the Clinton LumberKings were a part of history that they weren't aware of at the time. Play Ball! debuted on that day. Play Ball!, the magazine that you are reading right now, turns 20 this year!

The way things had been done for years in Minor League Baseball was publishing a program at the start of the season. The material inside stayed the same throughout the year. Fans bought a program the first time they attended a game, but there weren't a lot of repeat customers.

A decision was made after the 2003 season to change "the way things had been done". Other minor league teams had great success with Play Ball! starting a few years prior. The Timber Rattlers made the decision to join that bandwagon.

Technology had finally allowed for teams to publish a new program with some new material for each series. New rosters for both teams could be added. A new cover for every issue could be a photo from a recent series or of a current player. New players joining the team could be featured in a spotlight article.






Additionally, instead of charging fans \$3 or \$4 for each issue Play Ball! would be ad supported. Area businesses would buy advertisements in this new publication to cover the costs and fans would receive a Play Ball! as they entered the stadium. Our sponsors stepped up for that first season and advertising in the Play Ball! remains one of our most popular spaces for local companies to get their message out.

There have been some changes over the years with more different articles and QR codes. The number of issues each year has dropped from as many as 22 back when multiple teams came to town for one homestand with a new issue printed for each team down to just 12 issues this year.

We are extremely happy with how Play Ball! has been received since the first one was published in 2004. We thank you for supporting this experiment and for reading Play Ball! before the umpire yells, "*Play ball*."




