Tonight: It's the first Dog Days of Summer of the year, with dogs welcome to the ballpark, as the Lugnuts play the second game in a three-game series against the Great Lakes Loons. Right-hander **Grant Judkins**, who started the Crosstown Showdown last week and tossed four one-hit scoreless innings against Michigan State, makes his first MiLB appearance in 604 days, opposed by Loons right-hander **Jacob Meador**, who is making his first MiLB appearance in 578 days.

Last Night: Lugnuts 7, Loons 2. The Nuts scored six runs in the 5th inning, buoyed by a **Will Simpson** two-run single and a **Jonny Butler** two-run double, to win their 28th home opener. With the victory, Lansing improved to 19-9 all-time in openers.

On the Air: For the fifth straight year, **Jesse Goldberg-Strassler** and **Adam Jaksa** collaborate to deliver the call of Lansing Lugnuts baseball. Tune in via Bally Live, MiLB TV and StreamGuys.

On Deck: Tomorrow is the first Coors Light Thirsty Thursday of the season, with \$3 domestics and \$5 craft drafts.

Leading the League: The Lugnuts' offense is 1st in the circuit with 24 walks and is tied for 1st with eight doubles, ranking 3rd in team batting average (.244) and 2nd in OBP (.369) and OPS (.697). Around the rest of the MWL, five teams are batting below .200, with the Great Lakes Loons' .163 team average ranking last.

2023 Retrospective: The Lugnuts finished the season with a 60-71 record... catcher **Daniel Susac** won the Midwest League batting title with a .303 average... 11 former Lugnuts (**Ryan Noda**, **Hogan Harris**, **Mason Miller**, **Garrett Acton**, **Samad Taylor**, **Tyler Soderstrom**, **Lawrence Butler**, **Hagen Danner**, **Drew Millas**, **Joey Estes** and **José Espada**) made their Major League debuts, bringing the total to 184 MLB Lugnuts all-time... **Vladimir Guerrero, Jr.** who played in the 2016 Crosstown Showdown, won the 2023 All-Star Home Run Derby... reliever **Kumar Nambiar** represented the Minor League Baseball Players' union in a panel of new labor unions with President Biden and Vice President Harris at the White House; Nambiar retired at the end of the season and now works in the Baltimore Orioles' analytics department... the World Series was won by the Texas Rangers, with assistant hitting coach **Seth Conner** (2013-14 with Lansing), over the Arizona Diamondbacks, starring 2019 Nuts catcher **Gabriel Moreno** and 2014 pitcher **Miguel Castro**.

A Good First Impression: The Lugnuts played the Michigan State Spartans on Wednesday in the 16th Crosstown Showdown exhibition, winning easily 18-0. Pitchers **Grant Judkins**, **Hunter Breault** and **Yehizon Sanchez** combined to hold the Spartans to two base runners on a pair of base hits while the offense blasted four home runs: a solo shot and a grand slam from **Will Simpson** and three-run homers by **Joshwan Wright** and **Henry Bolte**. Wright reached base in all four plate appearances (single, homer, two walks), but was outdone by **Colby Halter**, who reached base five times thanks to two singles, two walks and an HBP.

Prospecting: The Nuts' Opening Day roster includes two MLB Pipeline Top 30 A's prospects in outfielder **Henry Bolte** (No. 12) and first baseman **Will Simpson** (No. 30). Bolte, the A's No. 2 outfield prospect, was selected 56th overall in 2022 from Palo Alto High School, where he led all California high schoolers with 13 home runs. He spent the 2023 season with Single-A Stockton, where he slashed .257/.356/.421 in 112 games, collecting 17 doubles, five triples, 14 home runs and 32 stolen bases. Simpson, the A's No. 2 first base prospect, impressed with a .319/.367/.543 line in his professional debut after he was drafted in the 15th round from the University of Washington last year.

Familiar Faces: Lansing returns 17 players from the 2023 ballclub, not including second-year manager **Craig Conklin** and fourth-year pitching coach **Don Schulze**. The returners include **James Gonzalez**, **Euribiel Angeles**, **Brayan Buelvas**, **Jonny Butler** and **Joshwan Wright**, each of whom appeared in games for the Lugnuts in both 2022 and 2023, as well as lefty **Jack Owen**, who has pitched effectively for the Lugnuts during each of the last three seasons.

Come Together: The Lugnuts' Opening Day roster includes players representing 10 states, Puerto Rico, and six countries: Canada, Colombia, Cuba, Dominican Republic, Panama and Venezuela.

TODAY IN LUGNUTS HISTORY

2018: The Lugnuts came back from 2-0, 4-2 and 5-4 deficits, taking a 6-5 victory at Fort Wayne on Ryan Noda's go-ahead two-run single in the seventh off eventual All-Star Travis Radke. The game ended on a brilliant game-saving catch by right fielder Chavez Young with the tying run aboard, hauling in a Gabriel Arias drive on the warning track, falling to his left, crashing into the wall, and ending up on the ground – with the ball secured.

2022: Tyler Soderstrom's first Lugnuts hit was an RBI double, and the Nuts beat the Captains at home, 6-5, for Phil Pohl's first career managerial victory. Starter Jeff Criswell struck out four in 4 2/3 innings, allowing two runs on three hits and two walks..

In a Nutshell: Making his official Lansing Lugnuts debut tonight ... one of five undrafted free agents on the Lugnuts, joining fellow pitchers Dylan Hall, Garrett Irvin and Jack Owen, and slugging outfielder Cameron Masterman... last Iowa player to suit up for Lansing: former Major League lefty Matt Dermody.

We are the World: With Iowa, took part in the 2017 World University Games in Taipei City, winning a silver medal (fell to Japan in the gold medal contest)... part of the first American team to ever advance to the gold medal game as well as the first American team to ever medal, period... team finished 5-2, losing only to Japan... started five games, four at first base, one at pitcher.

Family of Athletes: Father, Rob, played college baseball at Central College of Iowa, located in his hometown of Pella, as did both of his brothers, Jordan and Blake; his mother, Shannon, played golf in college.

At Pella High School: 2016 Iowa Gatorade Player of the Year as a senior... Des Moines Register's All-Iowa Baseball Player of the Year as both a junior and a senior, 2015 and 2016... 2015 Perfect Game Underclass High Honorable Mention... as a senior: 10-1, 0.64 ERA, 123 K, batting .421 with six homers and 12 steals... as a junior: 11-1, 0.56 ERA, 74 IP, 112 K, 10 BB, batting .520 with 14 doubles, nine triples, 13 homers, 57 RBIs, 51 runs, 15 steals... in his high school career, won 28 career games and totaled 337 career strikeouts.

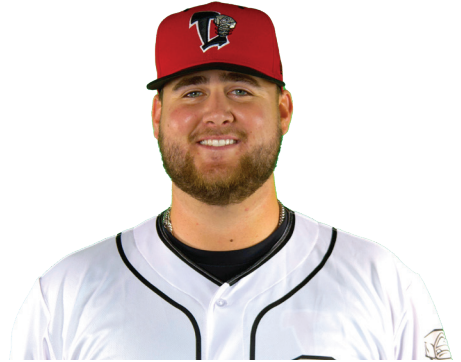
Onward to Des Moines: Entered the Big Ten ranked by Baseball America as the No. 8 freshman... two-way player in 2017, hitting .270 in 31 starts as a DH (and three starts as a pitcher hitting for himself)... 2018 Academic All-Big Ten... No. 3 starter in 2019; 2019 Collegiate Baseball Player National Pitcher of the Week (Feb. 18), tossing six no-hit innings with 11 strikeouts; ranked 7th in the Big Ten in ERA (2.72)... No. 2 starter in 2020 before season was halted early due to the pandemic: 2-0, 3.00, 4 GS, 21 IP, 24 K, 5 BB... signed with the Athletics following the shortened five-round draft.

In a Nutshell: Opens second Midwest League season in a pitching piggyback tandem with Grant Judkins... 45-pitch limit tonight... @JakeGarland25.

Hometown Hero: Started four years for Jupiter High School varsity baseball ("Warriors," wearing green and gold)... totaled 229 strikeouts, 1.49 ERA and 1.13 WHIP... named two-time FHSAA All-State... honored twice as the 9A Player of the Year... also from Jupiter H.S.: Miles Mikolas and Dante Bichette (but not son Bo, who attended Lakewood High School in St. Petersburg)... family originally from New England before moving to Florida shortly before he was born; the Garlands all root for Boston-area teams.

Jupiter? How did Jake's hometown receive its name? The Hobe tribe lived in the area, a Spanish mapmaker miswrote their name as Jobe, which was then miswritten again as Jove, which was then mistranslated to Jupiter. Misunderstandings the whole way down to the city's incorporation in 1925. Jupiter is located on the eastern coast of Florida in Palm Beach County on the Atlantic Ocean.

The Bandit Connection: Burt Reynolds was born in Lansing in 1936, and died in Jupiter in 2018.

The U: Attended the University of Miami (Coral Gables), a baseball program founded in 1940 with four NCAA championships and 25 CWS appearances... played for head coach Gino DiMare... true freshman year was the pandemic-shortened 2020 season, making six relief appearances before the year was shut down... returned in 2021 as a member of the rotation: 16 games, 13 starts, totaling a team-high 68 innings (5.69 ERA, 38 K, 14 BB, .286 avg.)... improved in 2022 to a 3.99 ERA in 65 1/3 innings (54 K, 11 BB, lowering home runs from 10 to four)... fifth of six Hurricanes drafted in 2022, going 514th overall in the 17th round to Oakland... the last Miami product drafted by the A's: Jemile Weeks (1st round, 12th overall, 2008)... two other Hurricanes have played for the Lugnuts: 3B Mark Sobolewski and OF Adam Finnieston.

Professional Debut: After signing for \$100,000, made three appearances, one start, for the Arizona Complex League A's, tossing three total innings.

2023 Season: Opened the campaign pitching in relief in Stockton's second game of the year, started by rehabbing American League All-Star Paul Blackburn... earned the honor of **California League Pitcher of the Week** with his very next outing, firing five perfect innings on April 13 at Fresno with seven strikeouts (69 pitches, 47 strikes)... finished his time in Stockton with back to back six-inning outings against Fresno and Rancho Cucamonga before getting called up to the Lugnuts to replace Jorge Juan on May 15... dominated in Lugs debut May 18 vs. Lake County: 95 pitches, 59 strikes, 7 innings, 2 hits, 1 run, 2 walks, 10 strikeouts, in 5-2 win.
