FIVE-RUN DURHAM THIRD TO MUCH FOR SHRIMP

Tristan Gray finished a triple shy of the cycle on Wednesday, but a five-run Bulls third inning overwhelmed the Jumbo Shrimp in a 6-4 loss. **Kameron Misner** broke open the scoring with a two-run homer, **Logan Driscoll** added an RBI double and **Alex Jackson** socked a two-run shot in Durham's third. Gray and **Will Banfield** went back-to-back in the fourth inning and Jacksonville added a pair of runs in the fourth on a **José Devers** RBI double and Bulls error. The Bulls added a run in the eighth and the Jumbo Shrimp could get no closer in the 6-4 defeat.

SHRIMP ON THE POND

Through five games in 2024, Jacksonville has mustered only 15 runs, in large part due to the club's struggles with runners in scoring position. Thus far during the 2024 campaign, the Jumbo Shrimp are a woeful 7-for-49 (.143/.271/.245/.515, ranking 30th, 28th, 28th, 29th, respectively, in Triple-A) hitting with runners in scoring position, stranding a total of 40 runners. In 2023, Jacksonville hit just .247/.336/.400/.736 with runners in scoring position, figures that respectively ranked 27th, 29th, 27th and 29th in Triple-A.

GRAY'S ANATOMY

Jumbo Shrimp infielder **Tristan Gray**, who played 331 games with the Durham Bulls from 2021-23, has been on a tear since returning to the Bull City. The Missouri City, Texas native has reached base four times in each of his two contests in Durham, going a combined 5-for-8 with a double, two home runs, four RBIs, walk and two runs scored. During his career with the Bulls, Gray batted .233/.300/.474/.774 with 59 doubles, five triples, 71 home runs, 220 RBIs and 179 runs scored.

THE CHICKS DIG IT

It took into the club's second series of the season to hit their first home run, but Jacksonville has launched four bombs through two games in Durham. Last season, the Jumbo Shrimp finished in the bottom of the IL in home runs last year (T-15, 160). Historically, Jacksonville has clobbered more home runs on the road since rejoining Triple-A prior to the 2021 campaign (82 vs 78 in '23, 109 vs 74 in '22 and 81 vs 55 in '21).

WHAT CAN BROWN DO FOR YOU?

Daren Brown returns in 2024 as Jacksonville's manager for the third straight season. A native of Holdenville, Okla., Brown holds a 1,283-1,272 (.502) record as a minor league manager. In 2022, Brown's first season with Jacksonville, he piloted the Jumbo Shrimp to an 80-69 (.537) record, placing third in the IL East. Brown also juggled a franchise-record 79 players in 2022, including a Jacksonville high for starting pitchers (25). The Jumbo Shrimp followed that up with a 70-79 (.470) record in 2023, with Brown utilizing a franchise-record 44 different pitchers throughout the campaign.

TROY MEETS WORLD

Jumbo Shrimp first baseman **Troy Johnston** is coming off an extraordinary season that saw him earn Marlins Minor League Player of the Year. Johnston finished the season leading all of Minor League Baseball in RBIs (116) while ranking fourth in extra-base hits (67), ninth in hits (157), tied for 10th in runs (102), 13th in OPS (.948), tied for 15th in doubles (36) and 17th in slugging percentage (.549). Over 134 games between Jacksonville and Double-Pensacola, Johnston slashed .307/.399/.549/.948 with 26 home runs and 24 stolen bases, becoming the first Marlins minor leaguer since 2008 to post a season with at least 20 homers and 20 steals.

DANE TIME

Originally selected by the Detroit Tigers as a pitcher back in 2017, **Dane Myers** converted to a full-time position player in 2021. The Katy, Texas native batted .292/.371/.442/.813 in 45 games in 2021 and then .267/.315/.489/.804 between Double-A Erie and Triple-A Toledo in 2022 before the Marlins selected him in the minor league phase of that winter's Rule 5 draft. In 2023, Myers unlocked a new level, hitting .316/.406/.489/.895 between Jacksonville and Double-A Pensacola while also making his major league debut with Miami. In Spring Training entering this season, Myers hit .412/.474/.735/1.209 with two doubles, three home runs, five RBIs, four stolen bases and seven runs scored in 17 games.

ABOUT YONNY

-A native of Bachaquero, Venezuela, Chirinos signed with the Tampa Bay Rays for \$10,000 as an international free agent from Venezuela in June 2012.

-On March 25, 2018, the Rays announced that Chirinos had made the Opening Day roster. Chirinos made his opening debut in a long relief role against the Boston Red Sox on April 1. He worked four scoreless innings while allowing just one hit. Chirinos set a franchise record by pitching his first 14 2/3 innings without allowing an earned run.

-Chirinos pitched for Tampa Bay on August 16, 2020 against the Blue Jays. His start that night followed a stint on the injured list due to right triceps inflammation. A week later, he underwent Tommy John surgery. Chirinos' rehab and recovery process was stalled in September 2021 when he fractured his elbow while throwing batting practice. The injury required surgery and, as it turned out, set him back another year. He wound up going 752 days between appearances for the Rays, finally returning to the mound on September 8, 2022. Chirinos allowed four hits, one walk and struck out four while blanking the Red Sox during a three-inning stint. When he took the mound in the fourth in relief of Jeffrey Springs, the game was scoreless. When he exited after the sixth, the Rays had a 1-0 lead. That is how the game finished and Chirinos had his first win since August 4, 2019.

-After more than a decade in the Rays' organization, Chirinos was claimed off waivers on July 23, 2023 by the Atlanta Braves. Atlanta non-tendered Chirinos in November and he signed a minor league deal with the Miami Marlins in February.
