SUNDAY: The Flying Squirrels lost to the Yard Goats, 6-1, to conclude the series with a split. Juan Guerrero gave Hartford a 2-0 lead in the first with a two-run single and AJ Lewis was hit by a pitch with the bases loaded to bring home a third run. In the third, Guerrero scored on a wild pitch to open a 4-0 lead. Sterlin Thompson added an RBI single in the fourth to extend the Hartford lead to 5-0. In the bottom of the fifth, **Ismael Munguia** brought home Richmond's lone run with an RBI single. Kyle Datres plated Hartford's sixth run with a sacrifice fly in the top of the sixth. **Nick Garcia** struck out three over two scoreless innings. **Mat Olsen** worked a scoreless top of the ninth

TODAY'S GAME: The Flying Squirrels face the Harrisburg Senators in the opener of a six-game series. In both previous sixgame series between the two teams, they each won three games. The Flying Squirrels went 3-3 in Harrisburg from April 16-21. The Flying Squirrels won the first three games of a series at The Diamond from July 9-14 before the Senators took the final three games. This is the final series between the two teams this year.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS have gone 5-3 in their last eight games since August 3, winning four straight prior to falling Friday night and in the first game of Saturday's doubleheader. Prior to that winning streak, they went 4-12 in their previous 16 games night and in the first g from July 13-August 2.

THE SENATORS are in last place in the Southwest Division second-half standings. In the first half, they finished in second place, one game behind Erie. Harrisburg's roster includes five of Baseball America's top-30 Nationals prospects, including INF Yohandy Morales (No. 6), RHP Andry Lara (No. 15), OF Daylen Lile (No. 18), OF Andrew Pinckney (No. 23) and RHP Tyler Stuart (No. 25). MLB.com's top-30 Nationals prospects list includes eight Harrisburg players, including INF Yohandy Morales (No. 3), OF Daylen Lile (No. 18), OF Andrew Pinckney (No. 19), OF Jeremy De La Rosa (No. 24), RHP Andry Lara (No. 25) and RHP Marquis Grissom (No. 26).

FOR RICHMOND: Right-hander Nick Sinacola makes his 10th Double-A start and his second against the Senators. He last pitched on Wednesday against the Yard Goats and threw 4.2 scoreless innings, allowing two hits. It was his second straight scoreless start dating back to July 31, spanning 7.2 innings. He faced the Senators on July 13 and allowed four runs over two innings. For the season, Sinacola is tied for third in the Giants system in wins (7). Out of Giants minor league pitchers who have worked at least 80 innings, he is first in BAA (.210), first in WHIP (0.98), second in BB/9 (1.99) and second in walk percentage (5.7%). He made his Double-A debut on June 6 against the Curve at The Diamond and allowed five runs over 4.1 innings. In his next five starts from June 12-July 4, he went 3-0 with a 1.33 ERA (4 ER/270 IP). He began the season with High-A Eugene and went 4-1 with a 2.68 ERA in 10 outings, including two starts. At the time of his promotion to Double-A, Sinacola ranked second among Northwest League pitchers (min. 40 IP) in WHIP (0.79), third in BB/9 (1.56), third in BAA (190), ninth in ERA (2.68), and 10th in K/9 (8.48). He spent the entire 2023 season with the Emeralds and went 2-5 with a 4.58 ERA over 23 outings (20 starts). Sinacola was selected by the Giants in the seventh round of the 2021 MLB Draft out of the University of Maine, where he was the America East Pitcher of the Year that season as a senior. *For more on Sinacola, see page two.*

FOR HARRISBURG: Left-hander Dustin Saenz makes his third Double-A start of the year. Last time out, he allowed seven runs over 1.1 innings in a loss at Bowie last Wednesday. He began the season on the injured list before working a rehab assignment starting in early July. He joined the Senators on July 30 and was reinstated from the IL. Last year, Saenz split the season between High-A Wilmington and Double-A Harrisburg. With the Senators, he went 5-5 with a 4.44 ERA in 15 starts. He has made two previous starts in his career against the Flying Squirrels, posting a 3.86 ERA (3 ER/7.0 IP). Saenz was selected in the fourth round of the 2021 MLB Draft out of Texas A&M.

DOUBLE TROUBLE: The Flying Squirrels have turned 74 double plays this year, which is the most in the Eastern League. Altoona is ranked second with 73. Richmond pitcher **John Michael Bertrand** has induced 15 double plays this year, which is the most in the league, ahead of three pitchers tied for second with 11. It is also tied for the second-most in the minors. The Flying Squirrels turned four double plays on July 27 against Binghamton, which is tied for the most in a game this season in the league. On July 10 against the Senators, **Seth Lonsway** induced three double plays, which is tied for the most by one pitcher in a game in the league this year. Bertrand matched that with three double plays behind him on July 19 against the RubberDucks.

TAKE THE JAIRO: In Saturday's doubleheader, **Jairo Pomares** drove in two of Richmond's three runs. In the second game, he lifted the Flying Squirrels to a 2-1 win in extras with a walk-off double. He was riding a six-game hitting streak prior to going hitless on Sunday afternoon. In his last seven games, he is batting .333 (10-for-30) with three doubles, a triple and eight RBIs while adding two stolen bases. For the season, Pomares is tied for seventh in the Giants organization with 10 homers and ranks sixth with 30 extra-base hits.

BERICOTO BASHING: In his last 47 games dating back to June 6, **Victor Bericoto** is hitting .305 (57-for-187) with four homers, nine doubles, nine walks and 28 RBIs. After leading the Giants organization in homers (27) last year, Bericoto hit just one homer in his first 34 games this season through May 21. From May 22-28, he homered three times in five games. He went deep again on June 14 at New Hampshire and added a homer on June 18 at Portland, but he had not homered in 34 games before belting a two-run shot on Friday night off the scoreboard in left-center. Bericoto has picked up multiple hits in 17-of-39 games dating backets. back to June 15

PACKING THE HOUSE: The Flying Squirrels drew an average of 7,113 fans in April for their home games at The Diamond to open the season, their highest April average in franchise history. The previous high was 6,891 in 2014 followed by 6,571 in 2019. This season, the Flying Squirrels are leading all 30 Double-A teams and are ranked ninth among the 120 minor league clubs in average home attendance (6,593), just shy of the highest average attendance in franchise history (6,689 in 2013)

PROSPECT WATCH: Two of Baseball America's top-30 Giants prospects are on the Richmond roster, including OF Vaun Brown (No. 11) and SS Diego Velasquez (No. 26). On Baseball America's Best Tools list, LHP John Michael Bertrand is rated as having (No. 17), OF/1B Victor Bericoto (No. 18) and OF Jairo Pomares (No. 26).

BOULEVARD TO THE BAY: This season, 11 former Flying Squirrels players have reached the majors for the first time. That is tied for the most in a season in franchise history. In 2014, a team-record 11 alumni made their MLB debuts, including Joe Panik, Adam Duvall, Andrew Susac, Matt Duffy, Jackson Williams, Edwin Escobar, Hunter Strickland, Chris Dominguez, Gary Brown, Brett Bochy and Chris Heston. The Flying Squirrels alumni to debut in the majors this season are Erik Miller (2023 Flying Squir-rels), Landen Roupp (2022-23), Kai-Wei Teng (2022-23), Nick Avila (2022), Randy Rodriguez (2022-23), Mason Black (2023), Gerson Garabito (2021), Spencer Bivens (2023), Raymond Burgos (2023), Hayden Birdsong (2023-24) and Parker Dunshee (2023). Dating back to 2022, 20-of-the-last-22 Flying Squirrels alumni who have reached the majors have debuted with the San Francisco Giants, with Garabito (Rangers) and Dunshee (Braves) being the only exceptions. Last year saw 10 former Flying Squirrels players debut in the big leagues, including a team-record five from that season's Richmond roster.

LOTTA INS, LOTTA OUTS, LOTTA WHAT-HAVE-YOUS: The have been 59 players who have seen action for the Flying Squirrels this year, which is one shy of the franchise record for a single season. In 2018 and 2019, the Flying Squirrels had 60 different players see time on the field. This season, there have been 30 different pitchers used by the Flying Squirrels, which includes appearances by **Andy Thomas** on June 1 against the SeaWolves and **Luis Toribio** on August 10 against the Yard Goats. There have been 30 different hitters who have seen at least one plate appearance with Richmond this season. In last week's series at Altoona, three players made their Flying Squirrels debuts, including **Zach Morgan, Justin Wishkoski,** and **Julio Rodriguez.** Pitcher **Jack Choate** made his Double-A debut on Tuesday night against the Yard Goats.
