INDY BITS

ABOUT LAST NIGHT: Nick Yorke finished a triple shy of the cycle and Thomas Harrington recorded his team-leading fourth quality start as the Indianapolis Indians overcame a two-run deficit to defeat the Rochester Red Wings 6-4 on Wednesday afternoon at Victory Field. With the game knotted at two in the fifth inning, Yorke launched a two-run homer – his third hit of the game – to straightaway center field to give the Indians their first lead of the day. Jack Suwinski followed Yorke's fifth-inning blast with one of his own off starter Spenser Watkins for the third set of back-to-back home runs by Indians batters this season and first since Gilberto Celestino and Grant Koch hit consecutive homers on June 13 at Jacksonville. Rochester took a 2-0 lead in the top of the first inning on a sacrifice fly and solo home run by Riley Adams. The Indians tied the game at 2-2 in the third with an RBI double off the bat of Liover Peguero and sacrifice fly by Suwinski. After the three-run fifth, Ji Hwan Bae drove in an insurance run with a sacrifice fly in the eighth inning. The Red Wings erased the run in the ninth with an RBI double by Joey Meneses and a run-scoring balk in the ninth.

IN THE HUNT: The Indians won yesterday's matinee, their 14th win in their past 15 games at Victory Field, to stay put at 3.0 games behind first-place Columbus. Worcester is currently in second place in the International League second-half standings and holds a half-game lead over the Indians. The Indians have not finished above .500 since going 73-67 in 2018. Indianapolis is now 12-3 overall since Aug. 27 vs. Louisville.

THOMAS THE TRAIN: Thomas Harrington tossed his fourth quality start – the most by an Indians pitcher this season – in seven outings with Indianapolis last night vs Rochester, allowing two runs over 6.2 innings with two walks and four strikeouts. After yielding a pair of runs in the first, he held the Red Wings offense hitless until the seventh inning. Harrington is currently rated as the No. 91 prospect in MiLB by *Baseball America* and No. 96 according to MLB Pipeline and is 4-1 with a 3.51 ERA (16er/41.0ip), 33 strikeouts, a 0.83 WHIP and .196 batting average against (28-for-143) in seven starts with Indianapolis since making his Triple-A debut on Aug. 4. In that time, he ranks among International League leaders in WHIP (1st), innings pitched (1st) and batting average against (5th).

BACK-TO-BACK JACKS: The Indians packed a punch in the fifth frame, after Nick Yorke and Jack Suwinski jumped on Spenser Watkins to give Indianapolis their first lead of the game with back-to-back homers. It was the first time the Indians had back-to-back home runs since Edward Olivares and Jose Rojas went back-to-back with round trippers in the sixth inning on Aug. 17 vs. St. Paul. Yesterday's showing marked the fourth pair of consecutive home runs for Indians batters this season also joining Billy McKinney and Matt Gorski on April 6 (2) vs. Memphis, and Gilberto Celestino and Grant Koch on June 13 at Jacksonville.

START SPREADING THE NEWS: Nick Yorke has now reached base safely in each of his eight September games after going 4-for-4 with a run, home run and two RBI yesterday. He finished a triple shy of the cycle while going a season-high 4-for-4 for his first four-hit game since June 20, 2023, with Double-A Portland vs. Reading, one hit shy of his career high. The stretch follows a torrid month of August when he was named Indianapolis' Player of the Month, and since joining the Indians on July 31 he has hit safely in 29 of 36 games with a .375 batting average (51-for-136) with 24 runs, 17 doubles, one home run and 25 RBI.

LAMB CHOPS: Jake Lamb powered the Indians offense yesterday, going 2-for-3 with a run, single and his first triple since 2022 with Los Angeles (NL). It was his third multi-hit performance in his last six games with a .320 batting average (8-for-25), five runs, one double, one triple and four RBI. Lamb is hitting .267 (89-for-333) with 46 runs, 28 extra-base hits and 51 RBI in 92 games while leading qualifiers in batting average and on-base percentage.

PEPPERED BY PEGUERO: Liover Peguero supported the Indians offense last night, going 1-for-5 with a run, double and RBI. In his last 19 games since Aug. 21, Peguero has been scorching at the plate with a .342 batting average (25-for-73), 11 runs, seven doubles, one triple, four home runs and 14 RBI. He currently is tied for the sixth-most RBI in the International League with 77.

HEY BAE: Ji Hwan Bae made a spectacular grab in the outfield during yesterday's matinee and logged his sixth hit this month, going 1-for-3 with two runs, a double, an RBI and a walk. His performance continues to show why he has been one of Indy's most reliable hitters when facing right-handed pitching. This season against right-handers, he has a .399 batting average (63-for-158) with eight doubles, three triples, five home runs and 24 RBI in 52 games.

BACKED BY JACK: Jack Suwinski extended his hitting streak to 10 games since Aug. 29 last night while going 1-for-3 with a run, home run and two RBI. He has now hit safely in 16 of his last 18 games since Aug. 21 with a .333 batting average (22-for-66), 10 runs, seven doubles, four home runs and 14 RBI. Suwinski was 12-for-79 in his first 21 games with Indianapolis.

TONIGHT: The Indianapolis Indians and Rochester Red Wings, Triple-A affiliate of the Washington Nationals, continue their six-game series at Victory Field this evening at 6:35 PM. It is the second series between the two teams this season and first at Victory Field after the Indians dropped five of six from June 25-30 at Innovative Field. Continuing the set for the Indians tonight is RHP Beau Sulser (3-7, 5.68), making his second start with the Indians since being assigned to Indianapolis on Aug. 20. Countering for the Red Wings is RHP Ty Tice (1-0, 5.26), who faced Indy twice with Buffalo in 2019 with a 2.45 ERA (1er/3.2ip) and four strikeouts.

THIS DATE IN 1939: In Game 1 of the American Association semifinals, the No. 3 seeded Indians topped No. 1 Kansas City by a score of 3-0 in a contest that lasted just 1 hour and 35 minutes. Left fielder Allen Hunt went 2-for-4 with two doubles and three RBI, and Indy went on to defeat the Yankees-affiliated Blues in five games, 4-1. Bob Logan, Indianapolis' all-time leader with 1,019 strikeouts, fanned six batters over 9.0 shutout frames. The Blues' lineup featured shortstop Phil Rizzuto and outfielder Vince DiMaggio, brother of Joe DiMaggio.
