FRES-NOTES

BEAR-LY AUGUST: Fresno has smacked 9 home runs and produced a .744 OPS across 11 games this month, piling up 145 total bases on 92 hits to go with 57 runs, 51 RBI and a dozen stolen bases. The lineup's patience has matched its pop – 56 walks against 100 strikeouts is a strong ratio for a group swinging it as hard as Fresno has in August. That kind of balanced attack has helped carry the Grizzlies to wins in two of their first three meetings with San Jose this series.

NEWTON APPLIES THE FINISHING TOUCH: Austin Newton has been outstanding since sliding into more of a relief role in August, posting a 1-0 record with a 1.42 ERA and 1.42 WHIP across four appearances, working 6.1 innings and allowing just one run on six hits while striking out eight against three walks. He opened the month with a win at Ontario on August 1 (3.0 IP, 4 H, 1 ER, 4 SO), then was untouchable the rest of the way – a two-inning save against Visalia on August 6, a one-out relief stint on August 9, and a scoreless, hitless inning against San Jose on August 13 (1.0 IP, 1 BB, 1 SO). Opponents are hitting just .250 against him this month, a sharp improvement over his .301 mark for the season, as he's shifted away from a rotation role that's accounted for 19 of his 23 appearances this year. With an ERA more than four runs lower than his season average and a save already banked, Newton's August workload has given the bullpen a dependable new weapon.

RENZ-ZILLA VS. THE GIANTS: Carlos Renzullo has made a habit of torching San Jose pitching, hitting .300 with 15 hits, 19 total bases, four doubles and 9 RBI across 14 career games against the Giants. His .725 OPS against San Jose is built on patience as much as contact, with four walks in 55 plate appearances producing a tidy .345 on-base percentage. He's scored 8 runs in those 14 meetings, proof that when he's on base against San Jose, he tends to find his way home. With three games left in the series, Renzullo's track record against San Jose have made him an X-factor in the series.
