TONIGHT'S GAME

Round Rock and Oklahoma City face off for game five on Saturday, with first pitch set for 6:05 p.m. at Dell Diamond. Express RHP Tyson Miller is slated to take the mound against Dodgers LHP Robbie Erlin.

Express Director of Broadcasting Mike Capps handles play-by-play duties while Texas Radio Hall of Fame member and Mr. Country Music, Bob Pickett, provides color commentary.

LET'S RECAP

The Express fell 6-5 facing the Dodgers on Friday. CF Leody Taveras and LF Zach Reks each hit solo home runs in the first inning to make it 2-0. In the second, Dodgers' CF Jason Martin hit a sacrifice fly to make it 2-1. In the fourth, C Tomas Telis singled to tie the game at two apiece. SS Zach McKinstry came up next and worked a bases-loaded walk to make it a 3-2 contest. With the bases still loaded in the fourth, 3B Miguel Vargas singled and brought the Dodgers lead to 4-2. Following the Vargas single, 1B Jake Lamb hit into the second double play of the night for Oklahoma City and scored McKinstry from third base, extending the advantage to 5-2. The E-Train cut the lead to 5-4 after 1B Matt Carpenter and SS Davis Wendzel knocked back-to-back home runs in the fourth. Round Rock tied things up at five when RF Steele Walker hit into a fielder's choice, stole second base and scored on a single from 2B Nick Tanielu. In the ninth, Round Rock RHP Jesus Tinoco was called for a balk with the bases loaded and the Express fell 6-5.

MILLER A STARTER AGAIN

Express RHP Tyson Miller returns to the starting rotation. His last two appearances were out of the bullpen. He last started on April 27 vs Salt Lake. The righty has a 3.43 ERA (8 ER/21.0 IP) and has walked nine while striking out 26.

REKS REVENGE

E-Train LF Zach Reks went yard for the first time this season in his first at-bat since returning from the Texas Rangers. The former Oklahoma City Dodger launched the sixth pitch he saw onto the center-field shed to contribute to Round Rock's four homers. Reks finished 1-for-3 with one run scored, one RBI and one walk.

BACK-TO-BACK

Round Rock 1B Matt Carpenter and SS Davis Wendzel hit the first back-to-back home runs of the season for the Express. It was the first time the feat has happened since October 3, 2021 when INF Charles Leblanc and INF Domingo Leyba went back-to-back against Sugar Land. The home run for Wendzel came on a 3-0 count, which marked the first time that Round Rock has hit a home run on a 3-0 count this season.

WINN STARTS STRONG

Round Rock RHP Cole Winn tossed a season-high six innings in his start. It is the first time a Round Rock starting pitcher has gone six innings since RHP Kohei Arihara on April 23 against Albuquerque. Friday marked just the seventh time that Winn has pitched more than six innings in his career. The last time came on July 2, 2021 while pitching for Double-A Frisco.

MORE HOME RUNS

After being held scoreless on Thursday, the Express totaled four home runs on Friday night, which is the fourth time this season that Round Rock has hit four dingers in a game. In the previous three games, Round Rock went on to finish with 13 or more runs in each contest. Despite the four home runs, the Express dropped to 17-9 in games where they hit home runs.

SECOND...FOR NOW

Round Rock entered Friday's game tied for first place with the Dodgers in the PCL East division. After the Oklahoma City win, the Express will enter Saturday's game in second place. It marks the first time that the Express haven't held at least a share of first place since April 14th.

STATING THE FACTS

American-born players hail from 12 different states, including Alabama, Arizona, California, Colorado, Florida, Illinois, Louisiana, Michigan, New York, North Carolina, Pennsylvania and Texas. The team's lone Texan, RHP Justin Anderson hailed from Houston before a collegiate career at the University of Texas at San Antonio.

EXPRESS MANAGER MATT HAGEN

The 2022 season marks Round Rock Express Manager Matt Hagen's Triple-A coaching debut. A resident of Austin, Hagen spent the last two seasons as the Texas Rangers' Minor League Field Coordinator. He is entering his seventh season in the Rangers organization after previously managing the Low-A Hickory Crawdads in 2018 and 2019 as well as the Short-Season Spokane Indians in 2017. In his three seasons as a manager, Hagen has compiled a .550 winning percentage, combining to post a 192-157 overall record, including capturing the South Atlantic League Championship with Hickory in 2019. He originally joined the Texas organization in 2016 as a coach for the Crawdads.

Prior to joining the Rangers, Hagen spent three years as the head coach at Four Points Baseball in Austin. Upon the conclusion of his playing career in 2012, Hagen returned to his alma mater, Liberty University, as an assistant coach. He also had a stint on the Liberty staff in 2007 and spent three off-seasons as a strength coach for the Flames' baseball, men's soccer and football programs.

An infielder in his playing days, Hagen was selected by the Seattle Mariners in the 12th round of the 2002 MLB Draft and spent time in both the Seattle and San Diego Padres organizations, reaching Double-A Mobile in 2006. Hagen continued his playing career in the independent Frontier and Atlantic Leagues from 2007-2012, earning Atlantic League All-Star honors three times. Hagen was a first team All-Big South selection at Liberty University, leading the conference in home runs and RBI as a junior, and was a member of Liberty's 2000 Big South Championship team that advanced to the NCAA Tournament. Hagen graduated from Liberty in 2012 with a degree in Sport Management.
