LAST GAME

The Baysox dropped their second-straight contest to the Erie SeaWolves 5-3 on Friday night. Bowie allowed three home runs on the night, including a two-run shot from Chris Meyers in the bottom of the first inning. Two more home runs for the SeaWolves contributed to a three-run seventh to stretch Erie's lead to five runs. Bowie once again attempted to rally late, as John Rhodes singled home a run in the eighth inning to get the Baysox on the board. Bowie plated two more in the ninth via a Donta' Williams solo home run and Max Wagner RBI groundout, but were ultimately unable to complete the rally.

The Erie SeaWolves enter tonight with an overall record of 65-52 on the season. The Double-A affiliate of the Detroit Tigers, the SeaWolves are 28-21 in the second half, already first half champions in the Southwest division. Erie has excelled in 2023, sitting second in the Eastern League in team average (.247) and home runs (149) at the plate, while holding the third-highest fielding percentage (.980), and the second-best ERA (3.79) amongst a starting staff. The SeaWolves' roster includes seven of the top 30 prospects in the Tigers' system, per MLB Pipeline, including IF Jace Jung (No. 4 DET/No. 71 OVR), RHP Ty Madden (No. 6 DET), RHP Wilmer Flores (No. 7 DET), LHP Brant Hurter (No. 12 DET), OF Justice Bigbie (No. 21 DET) IF Danny Serretti (No. 25 DET), and RHP Tyler Mattison (No. 28 DET).

TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

Left-hander Lael Lockhart is set to take the mound for Erie this evening. Lockhart joined the Tigers' organization via a trade from the Dodgers in late May. He pitched just under 50 innings at the level with Double-A Tulsa prior to the trade. In 58 innings with Erie this season, the southpaw has only walked 24 and posted a 2.79 ERA after totaling a 4.93 ERA at the level with Tulsa last season, and walking 13 through his first 15 innings in the Dodgers' system this season. Lockhart is coming off a rough start, however, allowing a career-high nine hits and six earned runs in 4.2 innings against Akron this past Sunday. The left-hander allowed two home runs on Sunday, after allowing just three long balls and 12 earned runs across his first 14 appearances with the SeaWolves. Originally a ninth round pick of the Dodgers in 2021 out of Arkansas, Lockhart features a fastball, curveball, and changeup

HAPPY HOLLIDAY

Top prospect Jackson Holliday has reached safely in 25 of his first 28 games at the Double-A level. He's posted the fifth-highest batting average (.327) and highest on-base percentage (.417) in the Eastern League (min. 100 PA) since his Double-A debut on 7/14. Holliday's overall on-base percentage of .452 across the three levels he's played in 2023 is second in all of Minor League Baseball, while his nine triples are also the second-highest total across the minor leagues. Holliday is the ninth player to play for the Baysox prior to his 20th birthday and the first 19-year-old to make his debut with Bowie since Manny Machado and Dylan Bundy in 2012.

ONE RUN REBOUND

The Baysox are 14-3 in their last 17 one-run games, dating back to 6/22. Bowie is 24-14 overall in games decided by one run in 2023 - the thirdmost one-run victories in Minor League Baseball, while playing in the fifth-most one-run games. Last season, the Baysox were just 21-29 in such games, giving them the most one-run losses in Minor League Baseball in 2022, along with the second-lowest winning percentage in the Eastern League in such games. 11 of the last 18 Baysox wins this season have been by a single run.

LEAVE IT TO BEAVERS

OF Dylan Beavers joins Bowie from High-A Aberdeen after one of the best performances across Minor League Baseball in the month of July. The No. 9 prospect in the O's system, per MLB Pipeline, hit .397 last month - second-highest in Minor League Baseball among players with at least 60 plate appearances, while his 1.185 OPS was fourth-best and led the Orioles' minor league system. Beavers also led the Baltimore farm with his .494 on-base percentage in the month of July. He's picked up right where he left off with Bowie in the month of August, hitting .360 with the Baysox - the fourth-best average in the Eastern League (min. 90 PA) this month. Beavers has collected 10 multi-hit games in his first 18 at the Double-A level.

WEEKEND WARRIORS

After struggling to finish series strong in the first half, Bowie has flipped the script as the summer has gone on. The Baysox posted a 16-18 record in the final three games of their series in the first half. Bowie has already surpassed that total in the second half of the season, going 17-8 in the back half of series.

COACHING STAFF

Manager - Kyle Moore

2023 will be Kyle Moore's second sea-son as the manager of the Baysox, and his 14th within the Orioles' organization. After leading Bowie to a division-best 41-28 through the back half of last season, Moore continues to display consistency at the helm of recent successful teams throughout the Orioles system. Moore led Class-A Delmarva to a minor leaguebest 90 wins as manager in 2019. The Shorebirds were named MiLB.com's Team of the Year and Moore won South Atlantic Manager of the Year honors. Moore's career managerial record sits at 254-216 (.540) entering the 2023 season. Prior to his managerial career Moore also spent three seasons as a player/coach in the Orioles system (2013 Frederick Keys, 2014 Bowie Baysox, 2015 Delmarva Shorebirds). He then took a position as the Shorebirds hitting coach in 2016, before joining the Keys in the same role in 2017. Moore played collegiately at Alabama, before signing with Baltimore as an undrafted free agent in 2010. He currently resides in Sarasota alongside his wife Whitney, and his two daughters, Madilyn and Cameron.

Hitting Coach - Sherman Johnson

Sherman Johnson makes his coaching debut, as he joins the Baysox staff as the hitting coach in 2023. Johnson had a brief stint in the major leagues with the Los Angeles Angels back in 2018 and spent parts of nine minor league seasons across the Angels, Reds and Minnesota Twins organizations Johnson's playing career most recently landed him in independent ball this past season with the Kane County Cougars. Johnson also played two seasons collegiately at Florida State.

Pitching Coach - Forrest Herrmann

Forrest Hermann joins the Bowie Baysox coaching staff in his second season with the Orioles organization. He served as the pitching coach of the Aberdeen Iron-Birds during the 2022 season, helping Aberdeen clinch a first-half division title Aberteen clinich al inst-nail of/sision tuie and make it all the way to game three of the South Atlantic League Championship Series. Hermann guided one of the best staffs in the SAL last season, which led the league in strikeouts. Prior to joining the Orioles organization, Hermann neart two screames are a clicking acade spent two seasons as a pitching coach within the Cincinnati Reds organization. Hermann also served as a pitching strat-egist in 2019 for the Seattle Mariners organization at their facility in Peoria. Hermann also worked with current Orioles' left-hander John Means at P3 Premier Pitching Performance center in Missouri. He pitched for three seasons at the University of Evansville prior to his coaching career.

Fundamentals Coach - Tim DeJohn

Tim DeJohn returns to the Baysox in 2023 for a second season as Funda-2023 for a second season as Hunda-mentals coach. However, DeJohn also received a promotion this season and will also serve as the Minor League Infield Coordinator at all levels. DeJohn has been a part of the Orioles' staff since November 2019. Prior to joining the organization, DeJohn had an extensive backrorum in the college ranks. He background in the college ranks. He served as an assistant coach at the University of Memphis between 2017 and 2019 and was an assistant at the University of Hartford the two seasons prior. DeJohn played at Western Con-necticut State from 2003-2008.

Development Coach - Ryan Goll
