JACKSONVILLE SHUTS OUT SUGAR LAND, 2-0

Four Jacksonville pitchers combined to shut out the Sugar Land Space Cowboys in the Jumbo Shrimp's 2-0 victory on Sunday. The only offense Jacksonville needed came in the fifth inning on RBI singles from **Matthew Etzel** and **Deyvison De Los Santos**. **Braxton Garrett** yielded only two hits with eight strikeouts in 4.2 innings. **Jake Walkinshaw**, **Jack Ralston** and **Josh White** then combined to fire 4.1 hitless innings, striking out seven. Jumbo Shrimp pitching totaled 15 punchouts against only three walks for the game.

SHUT DOWN CYCLE

Jacksonville earned its first shutout victory of the 2026 campaign by blanking Sugar Land 2-0 on Sunday. Thus, heading into play in Tuesday's series opener at Norfolk, Jumbo Shrimp pitching is riding a 17-inning scoreless streak. Over the last two games, Jacksonville has yielded just one run (a leadoff homer on Saturday by **Taylor Trammell**) on four hits. Jumbo Shrimp hurlers have combined to tally 24 (35.3 percent of their 68 batters faced) against eight walks.

GOOD MORNING, GOOD AFTERNOON, GOODNIGHT

Jacksonville has recorded double-digit strikeouts in all but two games thus far in 2026, with the lone exceptions being a pair of nine-punchout performances. Jumbo Shrimp hurlers have tallied at least 14 strikeouts in five of the last six games, totaling 81 against 25 walks during that span. As a result, heading into play on Tuesday, Jacksonville leads all of Triple-A with 110 strikeouts on the season. The club's pitchers have combined to fan 31.3 percent of opposing hitters (MLB average: ~24.1%).

'PEN PALS

Jacksonville's bullpen was arguably the club's biggest strength in their 2025 championship run, with the club leading Triple-A in ERA (3.64) and BAA (.214) while also throwing the fifth-most innings (700.2) of any bullpen at the level. However, over the first five games of the season, Jumbo Shrimp relievers combined to surrender 22 runs, 21 earned, on 27 hits (9.6 H/9) in 25.1 innings for a 7.46 ERA (21 BB, 7.5 BB/9, 38 K, 13.5 K/9). The club has seemed to start to turn that around over the last four contests, yielding only two runs, both earned, on six hits (2.7 H/9) in 20.1 innings for a 0.89 ERA (31 K, 13.7 K/9, 6 BB, 2.7 BB/9).

GET 'EM ON, GET 'EM OVER, GET 'EM IN

Jacksonville ranks last in Triple-A in several offensive categories, including average (.164), OBP (.304), SLG (.253), OPS (.557) and hits (44). The potential silver lining for the club has been they also own Triple-A's lowest BABIP at .211, far below the baseball-wide average of roughly .300. Perhaps encouragingly is that the Jumbo Shrimp rank much higher, even if not elite, at the level in barrel percentage (15th, 6.5 percent), average exit velocity (22nd, 87.7) and hard-hit percentage (26th, 32.3 percent).

MEN OF STEAL

In 2024, the Jumbo Shrimp mustered only 86 stolen bases, 29th in Triple-A and 119th out of the 120 MiLB teams. In 2025, the Jumbo Shrimp swiped a franchise-record 305 bags, second-most in Triple-A and sixth-best in MiLB. Jacksonville, which had not finished in the top five at their level in stolen bases since at least 2005, had more games with multiple stolen bases (84) in 2025 than games with either one steal (32) or no steals (34) combined.

FORMULA ONE

With a 29-14 (.674) record in one-run games in 2025, Jacksonville tied with Indianapolis for the most one-run victories in all of Minor League Baseball. The 29 one-run triumphs were the most for a Jacksonville club since 2014, when the Jacksonville Suns went 35-17 (.673) in one-run triumphs. In 2025, the Jumbo Shrimp went 58-34 (.630) in games decided by three runs or fewer, meaning 65.2 percent of their 89 victories came by those slim margins.

POPCORN SHRIMP

Brian Navarreto, the club's backup catcher, has the only caught stealing this season by a Jumbo Shrimp backstop... Until Tuesday, **Tyler Zuber** has almost exclusively been a thrower who comes out of the bullpen. He'll be marked down as a starter for just the third time out of 284 total appearances in his career. His only two prior starts happened in the backend of doubleheaders while pitching exclusively for Syracuse in 2025... The Jumbo Shrimp have netted five hits or fewer in five of their nine games in 2026... Even considering the Jumbo Shrimp's offensive struggles, the last five games has seen the club go just 5-for-49 in situations with runners in scoring position.
