LAST TIME OUT: Brooklyn utilized a four-run eighth inning to salvage the final game of last week's homestand against Jersey Shore, 7-3...IB Nick Lorusso launched his team-leading 10th home run of the season, a solo shot in the first... Six Cyclones pitchers had a hand in the victory...RHP Josh Hejka earned the win following a blown save, while RHPs Ben Simon, Jake Stevenson, and Jeffrey Colón all notched holds...Brooklyn received multi-hit efforts from Lorusso, CF Nick Morabito, and SS Wilfredo Lara...Seven of nine Brooklyn batters recorded at least one base hit, while all nine reached base safely, in the win.

THIS DATE IN CYCLONES HISTORY: On June 25, 2001, the Cyclones played the first professional baseball game in the borough of Brooklyn since 1957 in a matchup against the Mahoning Valley Scrappers...Over 300 media members from around the world cover the event...Edgar Rodríguez clubbed a game-tying two-run home run with two out in the ninth before C Mike Jacobs' sacrifice fly walked it off in the bottom of the 10th...Current Seattle Mariners play-by-play broadcaster Daye Sims had the call on television. by-play broadcaster **Dave Sims** had the call on television.

SO LONG, STANLEY: OF Stanley Consuegra was transferred to Double-A Binghamton on Monday...Consuegra departs Brooklyn as the franchise's all-time leader in numerous offensive categories...Last Wednesday, the veteran surpassed UTL Jaylen Palmer (204) for the most games played in franchise history (209)...Consuegra also set the Cyclones' all-time doubles record (40) on June 8 vs. Aberdeen and the all-time hits mark (186) on May 29 at Jersey Shore...He is also the franchise's all-time leader in extra-base hits (81), home runs (35), RBI (121), and outfield assists (19)...Consuegra also holds the single-season mark for home runs (23), and extra-base hits (42), and is tied with INF Ronny Mauricio (63) for single-season RBI. Consuegra ended his time in Brooklyn with a bang, hitting .282/.389/.518 with a .907 OPS since May 17...The Santo Domlingo, D.R. native had scored 16 runs and added eight doubles, six home runs, and 20 RBI...In that time, Consuegra was tied for fourth in the South Atlantic League in extra-base hits (14), tied for eighth in total bases (57), and ninth in slugging (.518).

WELCOME TO CONEY ISLAND: INF Jesús Báez joined the Cyclones from Single-A St. Lucie on Monday...Baez is the No. 15 Prospect in the Mets' organization according to Baseball America and No. 22 by MLB Pipeline...At 19 years old, Báez checks in as the youngest player on Brooklyn's roster and will be the first player in franchise history born in 2005...Through 64 games at the Single-A level, Báez accumulated a .262 average (66-252) with 25 extra-base hits, 10 home runs, 39 RBI, and eight stolen bases...The Santo Domingo, D.R. native departed the Florida State League with the most total bases (112) in the circuit...Báez was also second in hits (66), tied for second in home runs (10), RBI (39), and avtra-base hits (25) fourth in runs scorred (40), sixth in slugging (444) and tied was also section in 13 (60), the 101 section in 10116 fulls (10), flur (35), and tied for sixth in doubles (16).

OMAR-I-GONE: OF Omar De Los Santos also rejoined Brooklyn's roster on Tuesday from Double-A Binghamton...In 13 games with the Rumble Ponies after being transferred on May 20, the 24-year-old was 3-for-22 (136) at the plate with two home runs, three runs batted in, and two stolen bases...Despite not appearing in a game for the Cyclones since May 19 at Bowling Green, De Los Santos still sits fifth in the South Atlantic League with 25 stolen bases...The Santo Domingo, D.R. native set Brooklyn's single-season stolen base record (37) in 2023 and broke UT Jaylen Palmer's all-time franchise mark for stolen bases (62) earlier this season on May 2 vs. Aberdeen...Since the start of the 2022 season, De Los Santos is tied for fifth across Minor League Baseball in swiped bags (135).

NICK SQUARED: OF Nick Morabito and IF Nick Lorusso have been two of Brooklyn's biggest offensive contributors as of late...The duo each put together multi-hit games in Sunday's win over Jersey Shore...Lorusso is seventh in the South Atlantic League in slugging (.495), eighth in OPS (.864) and total bases (108), and tied for eight in extra-base hits (26)...Lorusso is tied for second among New York Mets' full-season minor leaguers in OPS (.864), third in slugging (.495) and extra-base hits (26), tied for fourth in home runs (10 and triples (3), fifth in batting average (.271), hits (59), RBI (36), and total bases (108), and tied for fifth in doubles (13)...Morabito is 10th in Minor League Baseball in onbase percentage (.438) and tied for 10th in stolen bases (32)...Since making his South Atlantic League debut on May 7, the former second-round pick is second in the league in steals (21), third in runs scored (29), and tied for seventh in hits (45)...The 21-year-old leads all full-season Mets farmhands in batting average (.330), on-base percentage (.438), and stolen bases (32)...He also is second in hits (76), tied for second in OPS (.864) third in runs scored (43), and fourth in walks (38).

SUERO SUAVE: C **Chris Suero** has started to find his rhythm offensively in the South Atlantic League...Since May 17 at Bowling Green, Suero has reached safely in 25 of 26 games, hitting .258/.407/.404 with an .811 OPS...The Bronx native has scored a whopping 21 runs with a double, four home runs, 18 RBI, and 22 walks...Since that date, Suero is fourth in the SAL in walks (22) and ninth in on-base percentage (.407)...The third-year pro has also reached in 14-straight contests since June 6...Suero is hitting .271/.429/.479 with a .908 OPS in that span, accumulating 11 runs, a double, three home runs, 13 RBI, and 14 walks to 15 strikeouts.

vs. ABERDEEN: Brooklyn hits the road for its first six-game series of the season's second half against the Orioles' High-A affiliate...Aberdeen boasts five of Baltimore's top 30 prospects per MLB Pipeline: OF Enrique Bradfield Jr. (5), INF Mac Horvath (11), LHP Luis De León (17), RHP Jack-son Baumeister (18), and C Creed Willems (29)...The Cy-clones took 4-of-6 from Aberdeen in the first meeting (April 30-May 5) and split a six-game set in the most recent ren-dezvous (June 4-9)...Aberdeen does not return to Brooklyn 30-May 5) and split a six-game set in the most recent rendezvous (June 4-9)...Aberdeen does not return to Brooklyn in the 2024 regular season, hosting the final 12 meetings...In 2023, Brooklyn went 7-5 against Aberdeen on Coney Island and 3-3 at Leidos Field...The Cyclones were 11-6 in Lakewood and 4-5 on Coney Island...In 251 meetings dating back to 2002, Brooklyn leads the all-time series, 133-118 (.530)

JUNIOR MINTS: INF Junior Tilien saw his 26-game on-base streak come to an end in last Saturday's loss to Jersey Shore...The streak is tied for the third-longest of the year in the South Atlantic League...Only Rome INF Sabin Ceballos (27) and Greenville's INF Kristian Campbell (34) put together longer streaks... The 21-year-old accumulated a .268/.357/.402 slash line with a .759 OPS during the streak, adding five doubles, a triple, two home runs, 13 RBI, and 14 walks...The infielder is the first Cyclone to record an on-base streak of 20 or more games since INF José Peroza reached in 31-consecutive games from July 29 until September 2, 2022...Tilien also posted a 10-game hitting streak from May 26 until June 9...He slashed .375/.409/.550 with a .959 OPS in that time.

WALK THIS WAY: INF William Lugo has had a keen eye at the plate in 2024, drawing 48 walks...That number ranks second in the South Atlantic League, while his 19.4% walk rate is first...Among minor leaguers with 240 or more plate appearances, Lugo sits fourth in walk rate...Lugo's former Cyclone teammate and Double-A Binghamton's IF/OF Ryan Clifford checks in at second in Minor League Baseball (21.8%), behind only former Aberdeen and current Norfolk INF, Major League Baseball's top prospect INF Jackson Holliday (22.0%).

OH, HENRY!: The Cyclones added RHP Henry Henry from Single-A St. Lucie on Tuesday...The 25-year-old made his Brooklyn debut on June 19th vs. Jersey Shore, tossing one scoreless inning of relief work where he accumulated two strikeouts and allowed one hit...Signed by New York as a minor league free agent on May 16, the San Cristóbal, D.R. native spent the first eight seasons of his professional career in the San Diego Padres...Between High-A Fort Wayne and Double-A San Antonio, Henry was 3-4 with a 5.19 ERA (29 ER in 50.1 IP) with 35 walks and 37 strikeouts in 34 appearances (three starts) in 2023...Henry Henry is not to be confused with former Pittsburgh Pirates infield prospect Henry Henry or the Cyclones' legendary on-field emcee King Henry.

YOU'LL GET NOTHING AND LIKE IT: RHPs Dakota Hawkins (5.0 IP), Joey Lancellotti (1.0), and Joshua Cornielly (3.0) combined on the first nine-inning no-hitter in Brooklyn Cyclones history June 4's 3-0 win vs. Aberdeen...The only previous no-hitter came on August 23, 2009, when RHP Brandon Moore tossed a seven-inning no-no in a 5-0 win during Game 1 of a doubleheader at Aberdeen...It is one of four no-hitters in Minor League Baseball in 2024...The effort was the first no-hitter by a Mets minor league affiliate since RHP Joander Suárez hurled a seven-inning one on September 7 at Hartford...It was also the first nine-inning no-hitter thrown in the borough of Brooklyn since RHP Sal Maglie tossed a no-no for the Dodgers against the Philadelphia Phillies on September 25, 1956, at Ebbets Field.

ATOP THE HEJ-ES: RHP Josh Hejka earned his first save of the season on May 5 vs. Aberdeen, making his Cyclones' franchise-record-setting 48th pitching appearance in the process...The 27-year-old broke a tie with Hunter Parsons (47) for the most pitching appearances in Cyclones franchise history...In his 62 career outings for Brooklyn since 2019, Hejka has accumulated a 6-3 record with a 2.48 ERA (28 ER in 101.2 IP) and 7 saves, walking just 25 and striking out 91.

AMAZIN' STARTS HERE: The Brooklyn Cyclones have several Top 30 prospects according to Baseball America and MLB Pipeline...The 'Clones have four of the Top 30 per BA: Jesús Báez (15), Kade Morris (21), Jonah Tong (22) and Calvin Ziegler (29)...Ziegler is currently on the full-season injured list...Plus five of the Top 30 per MLB: Tong (20), Báez (22), Ziegler (23), Wilfredo Lara (24), and OF Nick Morabito (26).

CHANGE OF PLANS: Pintaro's final start for the Pioneer League's Glacier Range Riders (Kalispell, Mont.) was cut short due to great news...The 26-year-old tossed 2.0 innings of one-run ball against the Great Falls Voyagers on June 2 before being told by manager Paul Fletcher that he would not continue...Pintaro's day came to a close because his contract had been purchased by the New York Mets, officially signing the following day..."It was surreal. After the second inning I came to the dugout and I heard him (Fletcher) say somebody get warm and I kind of gave him a look,' Pintaro to the Daily Inter Lake...In three starts for the Range Riders, Pintaro was 1-0 with a 4.40 ERA (7 ER in 14.1 IP), one walk, and 23 strikeouts...The Pelham, Ala. native had a 14.44 strikeouts-per-nine innings ratio in the MLB Partner circuit...Pintaro was teammates with 2024 BlueClaws INF **Chad Castillo** with the Range Riders.

REMEMBER ME?: Following the 2021 and 2022 collegiate seasons, Pintaro pitched for the Frederick (Md.) Keys of the MLB Draft League...During that time, the 26-year-old was a teammate of a few current and former Cyclones...In 2021, Pintaro pitched alongside RHP **Dylan Tebrake**, who was a member of the 2023 bullpen and is currently on Double-A Binghamton's 60-day injured list...During the 2022 season, the Shorter University alum was a teammate of RHP **Jordan Geber** (2023-24) who is currently with Double-A Binghamton and current Cyclones RHP **Jonah Tong**...In 25 games (17 starts) for the Keys, Pintaro was 3-9 with a 4.55 ERA (44 ER in 87.0 IP), 41 walks, and 108 strikeouts.

SHORTER STACK: Pintaro became the first Shorter University alum to sign a contract with a Major League team since becoming an NCAA program in 2013...During his time with the Hawks, the Alabama native was Gulf South Conference Pitcher of the Year in 2021 and 2022...Pintaro accumulated a 20-7 record with a 3.19 ERA (70 ER in 197.1 IP), 76 walks, and 286 strikeouts during those two seasons...Shorter is located in Rome, Ga. and its campus is located 3.7 miles southwest of the Rome Emperors' AdventHealth Stadium.
