## INDY BITS

**ABOUT YESTERDAY:** Andrés Alvarez tied his career high with four hits, Brenden Dixon homered, and the Indianapolis Indians used back-to-back four-run innings to defeat the Columbus Clippers 11-6 on Wednesday afternoon at Victory Field. Facing an early 3-0 deficit, the Indians recorded five runs in the first three innings to grab a brief 5-4 lead. Alvarez's first triple of the season opened the bottom of the first inning, and it turned into a little league home run thanks to a throwing error. Trailing 4-1 in the third, Indy notched its first four-run frame, highlighted by Dixon's two-run, go-ahead roundtripper to round out the inning. After Micah Pries tied the game at 5-5 with a solo shot, Indianapolis regained the lead for good in the fourth with four runs on three doubles by Jackson Glenn, Canaan Smith-Njigba and Matt Gorski, the latter two pushing Indy's lead to 8-5. Columbus' pitching could not limit the damage, as the Indians tacked on single runs in the sixth and seventh.

**LITTLE LEAGUE HOME RUN:** Andrés Alvarez went 4-for-5 with three runs and a triple to tie his career high in hits yesterday. The four-hit performance was the second of his career, the first coming with High-A Greensboro on July 1, 2021, at Bowling Green. Down 3-0, he jumpstarted the Indians offense with a triple and subsequent throwing error, resulting in a little league home run. The infielder has now hit safely in each of the first two games against Columbus after singling in the series-opener on Tuesday.

**BRENDEN CAN BOP:** With two outs in the bottom of the third inning, Brenden Dixon launched his third home run of the season and second career Triple-A bomb to give the Indians a 5-4 lead after entering the frame down by three runs. His first Triple-A home run came in dramatic fashion as well, when he hit a grand slam in just his second career game with the Indians on April 26, 2023, vs. Columbus. Dixon paired that Triple-A longball with 11 High-A home runs last season, launching a career-high 12 in 69 total games between levels.

**MATT FOR MORE BASES:** Matt Gorski, a native of Fishers, Ind., has carried a scorching-hot May into June, going 2-for-5 with a run, double and RBI last night in Indy's win over Columbus. With the Indians leading, 7-5, Gorski roped a double on a seven-pitch at-bat to trade places with Canaan Smith-Njigba. On Sunday, he launched his 10th home run dating back to May 16. In that time, he leads all International League batters in home runs, RBI (28), slugging percentage (.836), extra-base hits (16) and total bases (61). He also ranks among leaders in runs (T-2nd, 19), triples (T-2nd, 2), OPS (4th, 1.190) and hits (T-7th, 23). Nine of his 11 homers this season came in May, which were the third-most by an Indians batter in a single month since 2005 and are the most since Michael Ryan launched 10 in July 2007.

**WELCOME TO TRIPLE-A:** Jackson Glenn, making his Triple-A debut last night after being promoted from Double-A Altoona on Tuesday, went 1-for-4 with a double, walk and run in last night's victory over Columbus. The infielder, who was selected in the fifth round (133rd overall) of the 2021 First-Year Player Draft, hit .284 (101-for-356) with 19 doubles, three triples, 12 home runs and 60 RBI during his 2023 campaign split between High-A Greensboro and Double-A Altoona.

**SWIPERS KEEP SWIPING:** Four different Indians baserunners swiped a base against the Clippers last night, with the four marking a new team season high. Andrés Alvarez, Matt Gorski, Canaan Smith-Njigba and Mike Jarvis combined for the effort. It is the most stolen bases by the Indians since stealing six on Sept. 13, 2023, at Omaha.

**FLEMING FLEXING:** Southpaw Josh Fleming tossed 3.0 one-hit, shutout innings last night to hold the Indians lead as the offense continued to pile on insurance runs. After giving up three runs in one inning in his Indians debut on May 22 after being designated for assignment by Pittsburgh, Fleming has been one of Indianapolis' most effective relievers. In his last five outings (9.0ip), he has given up just one run with a 0.56 WHIP, .100 batting average against (3-for-30) and four strikeouts.

**TEAM STATS:** As a team, the Indians lead the International League with a .271 batting average (509-for-1875). They also rank among top-10 team leaders in triples (2nd, 16), hits (4th), doubles (T-6th, 106), on-base percentage (7th, .354), and OPS (T-8th, .782) and slugging percentage (9th, .428). The Indians pitching staff is also tied with Durham (546) for the fifth-most strikeouts this season, trailing Norfolk (608), Iowa (600), Columbus (561) and Toledo (555).

**TONIGHT:** The Indians continue their 13-game homestand with the third game of a six-game set vs. the Columbus Clippers, Triple-A affiliate of the Cleveland Guardians, today at 7:05 PM ET at Victory Field. The Indians went 1-6 against the Omaha Storm Chasers to begin the homestand, and are looking to take a series lead tonight against the worst record in the International League. Continuing the series today for Indianapolis is RHP Domingo Germán (0-2, 6.46) making his third career start against Columbus. In those games, both coming in 2017 with Scranton/Wilkes-Barre, he is 1-1 with a 4.26 ERA (6er/12.2ip) and nine strikeouts. Countering for the Clippers tonight is LHP Will Dion (2-2, 6.95) in his career debut against the Indians.

**THIS DATE IN 2001:** The Indians swept a twinbill vs. Durham at Victory Field behind a walk-off home run in Game 1 and a four-run seventh inning to mount a comeback in Game 2. Right fielder Micah Franklin smacked three extra-base hits on the day, making him one single away from the doubleheader cycle. Franklin hit a double and a solo home run in the opener, his seventh of the season, in a 4-3 walk-off win. Franklin would go on to pace the team with 23 home runs in 2001. In the nightcap, trailing 5-3, a four-run seventh inning was highlighted by a bases-clearing triple off the bat at Franklin as the Indians sealed the doubleheader sweep with a 7-6 win.

## TODAY'S PITCHER

**Domingo Germán:** Right-hander Domingo Germán is set to make his fourth start of the year for Indianapolis against the Columbus Clippers, today at 7:05 PM at Victory Field.

**Last Outing:** Germán toed the rubber for his first start on the road with Indians on 5/25 as he fanned five batters across 5.1 innings and took the no-decision.

**Against the Clippers:** Germán has faced Columbus twice in his career. He tossed a combined 14.0 innings while punching out 14 hitters across both games.

**Historic Germán:** Domingo Germán spent the 2023 season with the New York Yankees. He made 20 total appearances (19 starts) while tossing the 24th perfect game in major league history on 6/28 at Oakland which was the fourth in Yankees history. He was placed on the restricted list on 8/2 and missed the remainder of the season.

**Miscellaneous:** Germán was signed by the Florida Marlins as an international free agent on May 27, 2010. On Dec. 19, 2014, he was traded to New York (AL) with RHP Nathan Eovaldi and RF Garrett Jones in exchange for RHP David Phelps and 3B Martin Prado. He had his contract first selected by the Yankees on November 4, 2016 and he made his MLB debut on June 11, 2017 vs. Baltimore. He was signed by Pittsburgh as a minor league free agent on March 16, 2024.
