"FUN IS GOOD" FACTOIDS

LAST TIME OUT: Maddux Houghton broke a scoreless deadlock in the fifth with his first career Triple-A home run and Saints pitching did the rest in a 4-1 victory on Saturday night at CHS Field. Both starting pitchers were locked in for a second straight night, with Darren McCaughan wriggling out of two big jams. The first came in the third inning when he loaded the bases with nobody out on a walk, single, and walk. McCaughan coaxed a shallow fly to right, a groundout to first that erased the runner at the plate, and then fielded a comebacker that he calmly threw home to end the inning. He also had runners at second and third with one out in the fifth, but got some help from Carson McCusker; the Saints right fielder fired a dart home for a fly-ball double play that caught Jose Rojas at home. Houghton touched off for a one-out solo fly in the fifth, the first blemish on Yankees' No. 10 prospect Cam Schlittler, who struck out eight over 5.0 innings of one-run ball on the other side, but took the loss. The Saints kept tacking on with a run apiece in each of the final four innings, and the Saints bullpen combined for 4.0 innings and one run allowed. Righty Kyle Bischoff gave up the lone tally, but worked two innings for the second time in the series. Lefty Richard Lovelady has posted three straight scoreless appearances and retired the last 12 batters he's faced since June 1 with another 1-2-3 inning for his fifth save.

THIS IS OUR HOUSE: After falling behind three games to one, the Saints now have a chance to avoid their first series loss at CHS Field this year after taking Saturday night's contest. The Saints have split twice already at home and won their other three home series, including a "sweep" in a one-game series to open the year vs Indianapolis due to two rainouts. Scranton are the first team this year that handed the Saints defeats in three of the first four games of a home series. During the past five seasons as a Triple-A club (2021-25), the Saints are 6th in all of Minor League baseball with 181 home wins.

MCCRUSHER KEEPS MCCRUSHIN': Recently returned from his first-ever stint in The Show, Saints outfielder Carson McCusker currently ranks 5th in Triple-A in average exit velocity (see below). After homering in back-to-back games for the first time this season Thursday and Friday, the Sparks, Nevada native ranks t-3rd in the league in homers (12) and leads all qualifiers in slugging% and OPS. On Thursday vs Scranton, he demolished a 463 foot homer that jumped off the bat at 115.2 mph, marking the third-hardest batted ball in Saints franchise history (Matt Walner-115.6 mph & Trevor Larnach-115.5 mph). It was the 7th-longest tracked homer in the history of CHS Field, the fourth-furthest hit by a Saints batter. McCusker has the four hardest hit balls by a St. Paul hitter this season and five of the top-10, including three batted balls that rank among the top-10 in exit velocity in Saints history.

IF THE SH(EW)MAKE FITS: RailRiders shortstop Braden Shewmake has gone 7-for-16 (.438), 2 HR and 5 RBI in four games this week. Entering the series, he had been 12-last-73 (.164) since hitting his first two home runs of the season on back-to-back games on April 3-4. It's not the first time Shewmake has put up big numbers against the Saints; two years ago while with the Gwinnett Strippers (ATL), he hit for the second-ever cycle at CHS Field in the Saints' Triple-A era on June 28, and finished that series 8-for-18 (.444). Shewmake now leads all visiting players with a career 1.366 OPS in nine career games at CHS Field, and ranks second in batting average (.441, 15-34) among all opposing hitters with at least 25 at-bats in Lowertown the last five seasons.

ED(WALK) JULIEN: Saints second baseman Edouard Julien now has the most walks in all of baseball (majors & minors) with 25 free passes since May 11. In that stretch, Julien has drawn at least one free pass in 15 the 23 games he's appeared in and owns a .429 on-base percentage.

COMEBACK KIDS: Following Wednesday's win in which they trailed by a run in the middle of the sixth, 18 of St. Paul's 30 wins this year have been in come-from-behind fashion this season, tied for the most in the International League with Charlotte and trailing only 10 teams in all of baseball (majors or minors, Triple-A El Paso lead the pack with 22).

GOING, GOING, GONE: After hitting just 7 homers in their first 12 games of the season, which ranked tied for the 2nd-fewest in the Int'l League at the time, the Saints have touched off for 66 round-trippers in their last 47 games since April 14, which rank 3rd in the minors in that stretch, trailing only Charlotte (74) and Greensboro (70). The Saints' streak of homering in consecutive games came to an end at 10 straight on Wednesday night, marking the longest stretch for the club since they homered in 11 in-a-row from April 27-May 10 last year. The Saints have gone deep at least once in 27 of their last 32 games since May 2. The Saints are 16-5 this season when they hit more homers than their opponents and 6-13 when being outscored.

HEY MICKEY YOU'RE SO FINE: Since being optioned to Triple-A St. Paul on May 5, Saints utility man Mickey Gasper has hit .349 (37-106) with 10 doubles, 7 HR, and 18 RBI in 28 games. Gasper leads the Int'l League in hits (37) and extra-base hits (17) since that date and his OPS ranks 5th in the International League (min 50 AB) in that stretch. Gasper has quite simply been one of the best hitters in the minors the last two years. Since the start of 2024 with the Boston org, he ranks as the 2nd best hitter in the minors by wRC+ (weight runs created plus, where 100 is league average, a ballpark and league adjusted measure):

TWINS REPORT: The Twins (34-30) dropped their third straight yesterday afternoon with a 5-4 loss to Toronto at Target Field. Chris Paddack Down turned in his fourth quality start of the season, but the bullpen failed to hold the lead after the Twins broke a 2-2 tie with a Matt Walner solo homer in the sixth, Walner's fourth of the year. Down on the farm, Double-A Wichita (29-27) fell on the road at Northwest Arkansas 6-4 and try again for a series win this afternoon with Burnsville native Aaron Rozek (3-1, 2.78) on the mound. High-A Cedar Rapids (32-23) have dropped back-to-back games at Wisconsin (MIL) and try to force a split today with the T-Rats. Low-A Fort Myers (26-30) won 3-1 yesterday at home to Palm Beach (STL) and have a chance to win a series today.

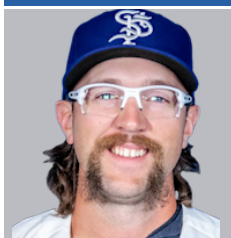

LAST APPEARANCE: Made a spot-start on three days rest Wednesday vs Scranton/Wilkes-Barre in David Festa's turn in the rotation after Festa was got a major league call up. Pitched around traffic in all four innings, but settled in to throw up three zeros after a run allowed in the first when a leadoff single by Jesus Rodriguez came around to score following a double by T.J. Rumfield and a sac fly by Bryan De La Cruz. Threw 21 sliders (31%), 17 sinkers (25%), 16 changeups (24%), and 13 four-seamers (19%). Induced seven swings-and-misses, led by four on his slider. Tallied his lone punchout on the slider, getting Everson Pereira in the second at-bat of the game.

THAT'S MISTER SAINT TO YOU: In 2024, Dobnak eclipsed several single-season pitching records for the Saints franchise. Both Caleb Boushley (134.1) and Dobnak (133.1) exceeded the previous record for innings thrown in a single-season (126.1 by Dobnak in '23), while Dobnak set new single-season franchise marks with 12 wins and 134 strikeouts. Dobnak still holds the single season mark for starts in a season, when he began 33 games on the bump in 2023, four more than Simeon Woods-Richardson's total that same season. Dobnak's 281 Career Strikeouts and 297.2 IP in a St. Paul uniform are both the most in the club's short Triple-A history entering 2025.

KNOW ANY GOOD PIRATE JOKES? NEITHER DO AYYYY: Dobnak grew up a huge Pittsburgh Pirates fan and we would often go to PNC Park. His favorite food to get there was nachos with pulled pork and cheese. He finally pitched at PNC Park on August 5, 2020. The irony was no fans were allowed in, not even his parents. He tossed 6.0 shutout innings allowing three hits and striking out one.

A BATTLE(R) OF WILLS: You can be forgiven if you've never heard of the DII school that Dobnak attended from 2014-17. He spent four years at Alderson Broadus (WV) University, located in Philippi, a town of 3,380. During his time with the Battlers he finished his career as the conference's all-time leader in ERA (2.61) and strikeouts (284). In his sophomore season in 2015, Dobnak threw a no-hitter against Bluefield State.

TWILIGHT SPARKLE, MEET BUTTERCUP: Upon graduating from Alderson Broadus, Dobnak went undrafted and was looking for a way to continue his career. He got his break with the Utica Unicorns in the United Shore Professional Baseball League (a four team league where all four teams play in the same ballpark in Utica, MI near Detroit). He signed with them because he caught the eye of manager Jim Essian (a one time Cubs manager in 1981 & also played from 1973-84 in the Majors), whose son played with Dobnak at Alderson Broadus. Dobnak would become the only player to reach the Major League's out of the USPBLL.

THERE'S ALWAYS THAT ONE PERSON: In order to make ends meet in the USPBLL, Dobnak drove for Uber and Lyft. He began driving for both in October, 2017. His Uber rating was stellar, but not perfect. He had a 4.99/5.0 rating which meant he received all five-star ratings with the exception of one four-star rating. According to Dobnak, "I have one four-star. I'm hoping it was a mistake. I don't remember doing anything bad."

NOTE QUITE MIKE ROWE: Just prior to joining the big leagues, Dobnak worked as a consultant for Jordan Tax & Accounting Services in Bethel Park, PA (2017), an accounting clerk at Accountant and Associates in PA (2017), pizza delivery for Italian Village Pizza in South Park, PA (2012-13) and supermarket stocker at Foodland in Pittsburgh (2010-12).

WE'RE BETTER THAN YOU, AND WE KNOW IT: Dobnak got married to Aerial Munson on September 28, 2019, never thinking he'd be in the Major Leagues. He returned home after the Twins finished a series in Detroit and got married on a Saturday. He wasn't exempt from the rookie ritual of having to dress up in a crazy costume. He had to dress up in a Globo Gym outfit and flew commercial home instead of the chartered flight. He showed up to his fiancée's in full attire.
