**YESTERDAY:** The Flying Squirrels lost to the Bowie Baysox, 5-4. **Frankie Tostado** gave the Flying Squirrels a 2-0 lead in the bottom of the first inning with a two-run double. The Baysox tied the score in the fourth inning with a two-run double. In the fifth, Zach Watson hit a solo homer to put Bowie in the lead and Patrick Dorian added another solo homer in the sixth to extend the lead to 4-2. **Diego Rincones** hit a solo home run in the sixth to close the Flying Squirrels within a run. Tostado tied the score with an RBI single in the bottom of the seventh. Bowie reclaimed a 5-4 lead in the eighth inning with his second solo home run of the game. Richmond starter **Trenton Toplikar** allowed four runs (two earned) over 5.2 innings of work.

**DEADLINE DAY:** Two members of the Richmond Flying Squirrels were traded ahead of today's 4 p.m. MLB trade deadline. Starting pitcher **Caleb Kilian** was sent to the Chicago Cubs along with San Jose outfielder Alexander Canario in exchange for 2016 NL MVP and four-time All-Star Kris Bryant. Richmond reliever **Jose Marte** was traded to the Los Angeles Angels as part of a package for left-handed reliever Tony Watson. Former Richmond LHP **Sam Selman**, who pitched for Richmond in 2019, and RHP Ivan Armstrong were also part of the trade with the Angels.

**TODAY'S GAME:** The Flying Squirrels play the fourth of a six-game series against the Bowie Baysox, Double-A affiliate of the Baltimore Orioles. This series is the third of the season between the Flying Squirrels and Baysox. The Flying Squirrels lost four of six in Bowie's first trip to The Diamond from May 18-23. Richmond won four of six at Prince George's Stadium from July 6-11.

**THE FLYING SQUIRRELS** have lost seven of the last eight games. Prior to losing six straight games through Tuesday, Richmond had won 12 of the previous 16. They are in fifth place in the six-team Double-A Northeast Southwest Division, 7.0 games behind first-place Akron. For the season, the Richmond offense is ranked ninth in the league with a .236 batting average. The pitching staff is ranked third in the league with a 3.93 ERA for the season.

**THE BAYSOX** have won six of the last eight games and 10 of the last 14. Bowie's offense is ranked seventh in the league with a .245 batting average and the pitching staff is seventh with a 4.22 ERA. Bowie's roster includes six of MLB.com's top-30 Orioles prospects, including C Adley Rutschman (No. 1/No. 2 overall), RHP Grayson Rodriguez (No. 2/No. 18 overall), LHP D.L. Hall (No. 4/No. 53 overall), 2B Terrin Vavra (No. 10), OF Kyle Stowers (No. 22) and SS Joseph Ortiz (No. 29).

**FOR RICHMOND:** Right-hander **Aaron Blair** makes his second start for the Flying Squirrels. He made his Richmond debut in Akron last Saturday night and allowed three runs in 2.0 innings of work. He pitched through the first 2.0 innings without allowing a run before surrendering three walks in the third with no outs. Blair began the season with the independent West Virginia Power and had his contract selected by the San Francisco Giants on July 23. He made his first start of the year on May 29 against Southern Maryland, picking up a win after allowing one run over 5.0 innings with six strikeouts. He began a start on June 3 against Long Island but left in the first inning with an injury before the game was suspended for rain. Blair was the 36th-overall pick in the 2013 MLB Draft by the Arizona Diamondbacks out of Marshall University, the highest draft pick in the school's history. He was traded to the Atlanta Braves in December 2015 along with Dansby Swanson and Ender Inciarte for pitchers Shelby Miller and Gabe Speier. Blair reached the majors for the first time in 2016 with the Braves. He missed most of the 2018 season and all of 2019 after undergoing shoulder surgery. He signed with the Arizona Diamondbacks in 2020 but was released in May after the MiLB season was canceled due to the COVID-19 pandemic. **For more on Blair, see page two.**

**FOR BOWIE:** Right-hander Grayson Rodriguez makes his 10th Double-A start. He last pitched on Saturday against Hartford and allowed a season-high four runs in 1.2 innings of work. He set a season high with 12 strikeouts in his previous start on July 18 at Erie over 5.0 innings. Rodriguez faced the Flying Squirrels on July 10 at Prince George's Stadium and allowed three runs over 5.0 innings with six strikeouts in a no-decision. Rodriguez was drafted by the Orioles in the first round (11th overall) in 2018 out of Central Heights High School in Nacogdoches, Texas. He pitched nine games in 2018 in the Gulf Coast League before spending all of 2019 Low-A Delmarva, where he went 10-4 with a 2.68 ERA in 20 starts. In 2019, he was named a South Atlantic League Post-Season All-Star and the SAL Most Outstanding Prospect while also earning a selection for the Futures Game in Cleveland. Rodriguez is currently ranked by MLB.com as the Orioles' No. 2 prospect and the No. 19 prospect overall.

**POWER SURGE:** This season, the Flying Squirrels rank tied for eighth in the circuit with 79 home runs. The team is on pace to hit 127 home runs this season in 120 games. The franchise record for the most home runs in a season is 109 in 2013. In 2019, the Flying Squirrels hit 84 homers in 139 games. Fernandez leads the team with 13 home runs this season. In 2019, **Gio Brusa** led the Flying Squirrels with 12 home runs for the season. This year, the team has combined for a .390 slugging percentage, which is 11th in the league but would be the highest in the franchise's history.

**SWINGING FOR THE VINCE:** In his last 22 games since June 30, **Vince Fernandez** is batting .324 (24-for-74) with six home runs, five doubles and 18 RBIs. Fernandez is ranked first on the team with 13 homers this season and second with 34 RBIs. In his last seven games since July 18, Fernandez is batting .152 (5-for-33) with 14 strikeouts.

**SIMON SAYS:** **Simon Whiteman** is batting .391 (18-for-46) over his last 14 games since July 15 with five doubles, one homer and five RBIs. Whiteman leads the team with 13 stolen bases this season, which is tied for third in the Double-A Northeast. For the year, Whiteman has picked up a total of 30 steals in 33 attempts, which includes his time with High-A Eugene, where he played 28 games to begin the season.

**BREAKING OUT:** **David Villar** has hit .309 (42-for-136) with six homers, 12 doubles and 16 RBIs over his last 36 games since June 16. For the season, Villar is second on the team with 11 homers and third with 32 RBIs.

**GO, DIEGO, GO!** **Diego Rincones** homered in three straight games from July 17-20, including a go-ahead homer on July 17 against Somerset in the eighth inning and a game-tying home run at Akron last Tuesday. He went on a seven-game hitting streak from July 17-25, which was snapped on Tuesday. Over that streak, Rincones hit .320 (8-for-25) with three homers, one double, one triple and 10 RBIs. He added his fourth homer at Double-A in Thursday's game against Bowie.

**LEFT ON BASE:** Over the last eight games, the Flying Squirrels have hit .149 (11-for-74) with runners in scoring position and have left 74 runners on base. For the year, Richmond has hit .125 (7-for-56) with the bases loaded, which is the lowest mark in all of minor league baseball this season.

**IN THE LEAGUE LEADERS:** **Vince Fernandez** is ranked tied for 10th with 13 home runs. **Frankie Tostado** is ranked tied for sixth with 48 hits. **Simon Whiteman** is tied for third with 13 stolen bases. **Frank Rubio** (26/T-4th), **Joey Marciano** (26/T-4th), **Patrick Ruotolo** (25/T-8th) and **Raffi Vizcaino** (25/T-8th) are in the top-ten in the league in games pitched. **RJ Dabovich** is tied for sixth in the league with six saves. **Norwith Gudino** and **Patrick Ruotolo** are tied for eighth in the circuit with five saves. **Caleb Kilian** is ranked second in ERA (2.43), fourth in BAA (.221), second in WHIP (0.94), first in compete games (2) and first in shutouts (1).

**PROSPECT WATCH:** The Flying Squirrels have three players included in *Baseball America's* Top-30 Giants prospects: **Will Wilson** (10), **Tristan Beck** (13 - on IL) and **Sean Hjelle** (14). **Simon Whiteman** is rated by *Baseball America* as being the "Fastest Baseline" in the Giants system, Hjelle is rated as having the "Best Control" and **Diego Rincones** is rated as having the "Best Outfield Arm." Three players, including Hjelle (11), Wilson (12), and Beck (20) are also ranked in MLB.com's Top-30 Giants prospects.
