TODAY'S GAME: The M-Braves continue a six-game road series against the Montgomery Biscuits, the last series between the two clubs. This caps off five series and 30 total meetings.

ABOUT LAST NIGHT: The M-Brave lost a two-run lead late in a 3-2 loss to the Shuckers. Drew Campbell and Landon Stephens each homered in the second and the third. LHP Domingo Robles spun six innings of two-run ball.

LAST TIME VS MONTGOMERY: The M-Braves lost a highly competitive seven-game series to the Biscuits in the first week of August. Drew Lugbauer recorded the first ever three-homer game on Trustmark Park on August 5 and hit five home runs in the series. The series consisted of three one-run games and two two-run games.

JESSE'S STREAK: Jesse Franklin V is riding a 32-game on-base streak*. Over the streak (July 16), he is batting .257 with five home runs, four doubles, 17 RBI, 17 walks and a .382 OBP. The streak is the longest by an M-Brave this season, and the longest active streak in the league. He topped a 31-game on-base streak by Michael Harris to open the 2022 season.

Other top on-base streaks: Christian Bethancourt (40, 2013, club record), Ozzie Albies (36, 2016), Drew Waters (30, 2019).

CAN'T CATCH A BREAK: The M-Braves have lost 12 of their last 14 one-run games, all coming since June 18. The M-Braves are 12-26 since the All-Star Break and have lost six straight series.

YEAH, WE GOT PROSPECTS: The M-Braves had some movement on the prospect list, most notably a huge bump for LHP Luis De Avila.

The prospects include No. 14 LHP Luis De Avila, No. 21 INF Cal Conley, No. 22 OF Jesse Franklin V, and No. 27 RHP Tyler Owens.

TOP PITCHING STAFF: The M-Braves lead the Southern League, and rank 4th in Double-A, with a 4.16 ERA. The pitching staff has given up just 89 home runs, the fewest, by five, in Double-A. The M-Braves bullpen is 5th in Double-A with a 3.87 ERA.

RETURN OF THE PEARL CITY BOMBERS: The M-Braves have two of the top-five home run hitters in the league with Drew Lugbauer (22, 1st), and Landon Stephens (20, 5th). Cade Bunnell (14), and Jesse Franklin V (14) have double digit long balls.

M-Braves opponents have just 26 home runs at Trustmark Park this season.

GRAND SALAMI TIME: The M-Braves have a club record six grand slams, including the first-ever multi-grand slam game on June 16 at Pensacola (Cade Bunnell, Luke Waddell). Waddell hit grand slams on June 16 at Pensacola and July 1 at Biloxi.

20-HOMER CLUB: With a homer on August 26, Landon Stephens became the fifth M-Braves player to hit 20 home runs in a season. He joined Drew Lugbauer (2022, 2023), Shea Langeliers (2021), Ryan Casteel (2019), and Ernesto Mejia (2011).

SLUGBAUER TO TRIPLE-A: 1B Drew Lugbauer was promoted to Triple-A Gwinnett on August 15. He recorded his first career three-homer game and the first in Trustmark Park history on August 5 vs Montgomery. He went on a 14-game hitting streak from June 1-July 23, batting .465 with 5 2B, 4 HR, 11 RBI, 8 BB, .558 OBP, and 1.418 OPS over the streak. It's the club's longest hitting streak this season.

Despite not qualifying for the league leaders due to an IL stint, Lugbauer currently leads the Southern League with 22 home runs.

He's the first M-Braves player to ever have multiple 20-home run seasons. In 283 games for the M-Braves, Lugbauer slashed .231/.342/.491 with 68 home runs, 53 doubles, two triples, and 191 RBI. On May 23, Lugbauer cranked a 117-mile-per-hour home run, ranking 5th among MLB players for hardest-hit balls.

The M-Braves all-time and single-season home run leader slugged his 50th career M-Braves home run on April 30 at Biloxi. Lugbauer has a club record, and Double-A franchise record 68 home runs over parts of three seasons. Lugbauer also has a club-record 191 RBI. He hit 18 homers in 2021 and led the Southern League and Braves minor league system with 28 homers in 2022.

WADDY: Luke Waddell leads the league with a .296 batting average and ranks 4th in the league with a .395 OBP.

COUNTIN' ON CAL: Cal Conley leads the league with 115 games played, and ranks among the league leaders in hits (104, 4th), and stolen bases (27, T-8th).

HOT SOUP COMIN' THROUGH: Drew Campbell is currently riding a 15-game on-base streak. Over the streak (July 30), he is batting .391 with two homers, two doubles, four RBI, three walks, a .481 OBP, and 1.046 OPS.

RANGEL'S RESURGENCE: Alan Rangel has taken his game to another level in August, posting a 2.04 ERA in four starts this month. The right-hander has allowed four earned runs in 22.1 innings with two walks and 25 strikeouts. Despite this, he is an unlucky 1-3 in August.

THE HARTFORD BRAVES: On July 24, Atlanta announced a trade with the Colorado Rockies for RHP Pierce Johnson. RHP Victor Vodnik (No. 10) and RHP Tanner Gordon (No. 26) were sent to the Rockies organization. Both were assigned to Double-A Hartford after the trade.

On August 1, Atlanta announced another trade with Colorado, sending M-Braves RHP Alec Barger for LHP Brad Hand, a three-time all-star. Barger was also assigned to Double-A Hartford after the trade.

WEEKLY ADDITIONS: Add: C Hendrik Clementina (GWN), OF Brandon Parker (ROM), LHP Justus Sheffield (GWN), RHP Patrick Halligan (ROM), RHP Daniel Martinez (ROM). Sheffield has since been moved back to Triple-A Gwinnett.
