SUNDAY: The Flying Squirrels beat the Fisher Cats, 5-0, for their ninth shutout win of the year, which is tied with Akron for the most in the Eastern League this year. Carson Ragsdale started and pitched six innings, striking out eight. Kyle Cody threw two innings and José Cruz worked the ninth, striking out two. Will Wilson opened the scoring with an RBI single in the top of the fifth. In the sixth, Jairo Pomares hit a solo homer, his sixth of the year and his third of the series. Andy Thomas pushed the lead to 3-0 in the top of the seventh with an RBI single. In the eighth, Christian Koss scored on a wild pitch and Brandon Martorano brought home a run with a double to extend the lead to 5-0. Wilson finished the day 3-for-5 and scored a run. Koss and Carter Howell both had two hits. The victory clinched a series win for the Flying Squirrels against the Fisher Cats in the first leg of the current 12-game road trip.

TODAY'S GAME: The Flying Squirrels face the Portland Sea Dogs, Double-A affiliate of the Boston Red Sox, in the opener of a six-game series on the second leg of a 12-game road trip to New England. This week's series is the final road set for the Flying Squirrels this year against the Northeast Division. It is also the only series between these two teams this year. The Flying Squirrels are 1-5 in road series openers this year.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS snapped a five-game losing streak with their win on Wednesday night and have now won four-of-five. They had gone 3-9 in their previous 12 from since May 29 through Tuesday. In their previous 13 games from May 15-28, they went 11-2. That stretch came following a span where they went 1-12 over a 13-game span from April 28-May 12, including 1-11 on their road trip to Akron and Erie. They have won three-of-their-last-five series, taking five-of-six in back-to-back series against Reading from May 15-19 and on the road at Bowie from May 21-26, before dropping four-of-six against Erie at The Diamond from May 28-June 2 and again against Altoona from June 4-9 and then winning four-of-six last week at New Hampshire.

THE SEA DOGS are in second place in the Northeast Division, a half-game behind first-place Hartford with six games remaining in the season's first half. The Sea Dogs lead the Eastern League in batting average (.267), runs (349), hits (561) and walks (265). Portland's roster includes nine of Baseball America's top-30 Red Sox prospects, including OF Roman Anthony (No. 1), SS Marcelo Meyer (No. 2), C Kyle Teel (No. 3), RHP Wikelman Gonzalez (No. 5), 3B Blaze Jordan (No. 17), INF/OF Eddinson Paulino (No. 20), RHP Hunter Dobbins (No. 25), RHP Angel Bastardo (No. 26) and INF Kristian Campbell (No. 30). The roster also includes 10 players ranked on MLB.com's top-30 Red Sox prospects list, including Mayer (No. 1), Anthony (No. 2), Teel (No. 3), Gonzalez (No. 5), Jordan (No. 19), Paulino (No. 22), Dobbins (No. 25), Bastardo (No. 26), RHP Bryan Mata (No. 27) and Campbell (No. 30).

FOR RICHMOND: Right-hander Nick Sinacola makes his third Double-A start. He last pitched last Wednesday at New Hampshire and threw five scoreless innings in a combined shutout win over the Fisher Cats. Today, he pitched less than three hours from his hometown of North Attleboro, Mass., and about two hours from his college town. He began the season with High-A Eugene and went 4-1 with a 2.68 ERA in 10 outings, including two starts. At the time of his promotion to Double-A, Sinacola ranked second among Northwest League pitchers (min. 40 IP) in WHIP (0.79), third in BB/9 (1.56), third in BAA (190), ninth in ERA (2.68), and 10th in K/9 (8.48). He spent the entire 2023 season with the Emeralds and went 2-5 with a 4.58 ERA over 23 outings (20 starts). Sinacola was selected by the Giants in the seventh round of the 2021 MLB Draft out of the University of Maine, where he was the America East Pitcher of the Year that season as a senior. FOR PORTLAND: Right-hander Hunter Dobbins makes his 11th start of the season and the third of his career against the Flying Squirrels. Last time out, he threw seven innings and allowed two runs (one earned) in a win at Reading last Wednesday. He pitched at The Diamond on July 27, 2023 and allowed five runs (four earned) over five innings in a loss. He picked up a win against Richmond in Portland last year on August 22, 2023, allowing two runs over seven innings. Dobbins was selected by the Red Sox in the eighth round of the 2021 MLB Draft out of Texas Tech after missing time recovering from Tommy John surgery. He first reached Double-A last June with a promotion from High-A Greenville and went 5-5 with a 4.27 ERA in 13 outings with the Sea Dogs.

PACKING THE HOUSE: The Flying Squirrels drew an average of 7,113 fans in April for their home games at The Diamond to open the season, their highest April average in franchise history. The previous high was 6,891 in 2014 followed by 6,571 in 2019. This season, the Flying Squirrels are leading all 30 Double-A teams and are ranked fourth among the 120 minor league clubs in average home attendance (7,008).

THOMAS THE TANK ENGINE: Andy Thomas is batting .315 (29-for-92) over his last 26 games since May 15 with two homers, seven doubles, a triple and 18 RBIs, raising his batting average for the year from .193 to .261. On May 24 at Bowie, he clubbed his first homer of the year, a grand slam, and finished the game with six RBIs, tying his career high. Last Wednesday at New Hampshire, he went 3-for-3 with a walk and caught a shutout. He finished the series with seven hits in five games started.

OPEN THE GATES: This season, **Evan Gates** has posted a 1.27 ERA (5 ER/35.1 IP), which is the lowest in the Eastern League (min. 30 IP). Gates posted a 0.86 ERA (2 ER/21.0 IP) over his first 12 appearances of the season through May 18. After allowing four runs (three earned) in his two outings May 23 and 26 against the Baysox, he pitched 3.1 scoreless innings on May 31 against the SeaWolves, the longest outing of his career, and struck out four batters. In that appearance, he issued a walk to the first batter he faced before retiring the next 10 batters in order to finish his night. Gates followed with a six-out save against the Curve in a combined shutout on June 4. He has not allowed a run in his last five outings since May 31, spanning 10.1 innings. Since joining the Flying Squirrels in 2022, Gates has pitched 68 Double-A games, combining for a 3.16 ERA (35 ER/99.2 IP).

BERICOTO BASHING: In his last nine games dating back to June 6, **Victor Bericoto** is hitting .333 (13-for-39) with two homers, three doubles, two walks and seven RBIs. After leading the Giants organization in homers (27) last year, Bericoto hit just one homer in his first 34 games this season through May 21. From May 22-28, he homered three times in five games. He went deep again on Friday night. In his last 19 games since May 22, Bericoto is batting .296 (21-for-71) with five homers, four doubles, nine walks and 16 RBIs.

HELLO, JAIRO: In this last week's series in Manchester, Jairo Pomares hit .409 (9-for-22) with three homers, two doubles and eight RBIs. He went 1-for-4 last Tuesday before picking up a pair of hits, including a double, on Wednesday night, driving in a season-high three runs. He matched the three RBIs on Thursday night with a double and a homer. Pomares homered for the second straight game on Friday night, one of his two hits in the game. On Sunday, he added a solo homer for his third longball of the road trip.

MARTY PARTY: Brandon Martorano hit his first Double-A homer of the year on Saturday night, a two-run shot in the Flying Squirrels' 3-2 win over the Fisher Cats. In his four games with Richmond, Martorano is batting .313 (5-for-16) with the homer and a walk. In parts of four seasons with the Flying Squirrels, Martorano has played 201 games. His 23 career homers are tied for ninth in Flying Squirrels franchise history, even with Tyler Fitzgerald, Dylan Davis and Hunter Cole and two behind the next spot on the list, with is 25 by Frankie Tostado in eighth.

SERVING UP THE DONUTS: On Sunday, the Flying Squirrels threw their ninth shutout win of the season, which is tied with Akron for the most in the Eastern League this season, both one ahead of third-place Harrisburg. The Flying Squirrels have pitched shutouts in six-of-their-last-10 wins dating back to May 25. Last week, they started and ended the series in New Hampshire with 5-0 shutout wins on Tuesday and Sunday.

BIG-LEAGUE BIVENS: Former Flying Squirrels pitcher **Spencer Bivens** made his MLB debut for the Giants on Sunday afternoon at Oracle Park. He picked up a winning decision in the Giants' 13-6 win over the Angels. Bivens started his outing with a strike-out of Zach Neto before surrendering a homer to Nolan Schanuel. Following the home run, he retired his final eight batters in order and finished his day with four strikeouts, Bivens pitched 27 games for the Flying Squirrels last year, going 5-4 with a 3.69 ERA. Bivens became the third Virginia-born Flying Squirrels player to reach the majors in team history, joining **Jarrett Parker** and **Conner Overton**.

PROSPECT WATCH: Four of Baseball America's top-30 Giants prospects are on the Richmond roster, including OF Vaun Brown (No. 10), RHP Eric Silva (No. 20), C Adrián Sugastey (No. 23), RHP Ryan Murphy (No. 26) and LHP José Cruz (No. 28). On Baseball America's Best Tools list, Sugastey is rated as the best defensive catcher and John Michael Bertrand is rated as having the best control. MLB.com's top-30 Giants prospects list includes five Richmond players, including Brown (No. 15), OF/1B Victor Bericoto (No. 19), Sugastey (No. 23), OF Jairo Pomares (No. 26) and RHP Carson Ragsdale (No. 30).
