YESTERDAY: The Flying Squirrels lost to the Baysox, 4-3. The Baysox took a 2-0 lead with back-to-back RBI doubles in the third. **Charlie Szykowny** singled in a run in the fourth and **Jancel Villarroel** tied the score with a solo homer in the fifth. In the bottom of the fifth, **Fernando Peguero** put the Baysox ahead, 3-2, with a solo homer. **Colin Tuft** added a solo homer in the seventh for a 4-2 Baysox lead. In the top of the ninth, **Zane Zielinski** hit an RBI single to pull the Flying Squirrels within a run. **Gerald Ogando** recorded back-to-back strikeouts to end the game and strand two runners on base.

POSTSEASON BOUND: The June 12 win clinched the Eastern League Southwest Division title for the Flying Squirrels, locking in a postseason berth. The Flying Squirrels will play the second-half division champion in the Division Series. Game 1 will be at the home of the second-half champion on Tues., Sept. 15. Game 2 and, if necessary, Game 3 will be at CarMax Park on Thurs., Sept. 17 and Sat., Sept. 18. If Richmond advances to the EL Championship Series, Game 1 will be at CarMax Park on Sun., Sept. 20. This year marks the fifth postseason appearance in franchise history and the first since 2023.

TODAY'S GAME: The Flying Squirrels face the Chesapeake Baysox, Double-A affiliate of the Baltimore Orioles, in the finale of a six-game series and the 12th of a 12-game road trip. This is the second of three series between these two teams this year. The Flying Squirrels lost four-of-six in Bowie from June 16-21, their first of three series losses this season. The Baysox will come to Richmond for a six-game series to conclude the regular season from Sept. 8-13. Richmond is looking for a win to secure its first series win since June 23-28 against Akron and first on the road since April 14-19 at Hartford.

RECORD YEAR: The Flying Squirrels' 10-game win streak from April 4-15 was the longest in franchise history, surpassing an eight-game win streak from May 5-13, 2021, also beginning with the second game of the season. The 69-48 record is the best in team history through 117 games, ahead of a 67-50 record in 2014. Richmond has won seven series, split 10 and lost three so far this year. After opening the season with a 27-7 record through May 13, the Flying Squirrels are 42-41 in their last 83 games since.

RELENTLESS: In their 69 wins this year, the Flying Squirrels have come from behind in 35 of them. In 23 of the wins, Richmond has taken the lead in the eighth inning or later. The Flying Squirrels have 11 walk-off wins at CarMax Park this season, including at least one in all but one home series. **Diego Velasquez** has three walk-off hits this year, all in 10th innings. **Drew Cavanaugh**, **Parks Harber** and **Dayson Croes** each have two walk-off winners this year. Richmond has four wins after trailing by five-or-more runs this season. The Flying Squirrels are batting .283 in the ninth inning this year, which leads the EL and is sixth in MiLB. The Flying Squirrels have won 27 one-run decisions this year, the most in the EL.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS won the Southwest Division first-half title by seven games over second-place Erie. For the year, Richmond is tied for first among all 30 Double-A teams in batting average (.268), tied for first in sacrifice flies (47), fourth in hits (1042), fourth in doubles (210) and fourth in triples (29). The team has combined for 113 homers this year, surpassing 12 of the franchise's previous 15 season totals. On Aug. 18 at Chesapeake, the Flying Squirrels set new single-season record for stolen bases, passing 168 in 2014. The Flying Squirrels are on pace to set offensive single-season franchise records for batting average, runs, total bases, doubles, RBIs, OBP, SLG, OPS and sacrifice flies. Richmond's No. 9 batters have combined to hit .315 this year, which leads the minors. The Flying Squirrels have scored 10-or-more runs 12 times this year, passing 2023 (11) for the most in a season in franchise history. The Richmond pitching staff has thrown 10 shutouts this season, which is tied for first in the Eastern League, tied for second in Double-A and tied for third in MiLB.

THE BAYSOX are in second place in the Southwest Division second-half standings, 6.5 games behind first-place Erie. They went 3-2 in last week's road series at Reading with Sunday's series finale being canceled. The Chesapeake roster features eight players ranked in Baseball America's top-30 Orioles prospects list, including RHP Antony Eyanson (No. 1), LHP Joseph Dzierwa (No. 3), LHP Caden Hunter (No. 4), RHP JT Quinn (No. 13), SS Wehiwa Aloy (No. 15), LHP Sebastian Gongora (No. 24), 2B/OF Aron Estrada (No. 25) and RHP Brock Moore (No. 28). MLB.com's top-30 Orioles prospects list features six Baysox players, including Eyanson (No. 2), Dzierwa (No. 3), Hunter (No. 4), Aloy (No. 8), Estrada (No. 13) and Quinn (No. 14).

FOR RICHMOND: Left-hander **Greg Farone** makes his 23rd Double-A start and his fourth against the Baysox. He started the series opener on Tuesday and allowed four runs over five innings in a loss. Farone was Richmond's Opening Day starter on April 4 at Erie in his Double-A debut and allowed one run over 4.2 innings. He had eight strikeouts, tying the franchise record for the most strikeouts on Opening Day. He pitched his first professional season in 2025 and split the year between Low-A San Jose and High-A Eugene. He made 12 starts for San Jose, going 2-1 with a 3.73 ERA. At the time of his promotion in June, he ranked third in the California League in strikeouts (73). Farone closed the year with 11 starts at High-A, going 4-2 with a 4.25 ERA. Farone began his college career at Herkimer College in New York, where he led the team to the program's first NJCAA national title in 2022, going 7-0 with a 1.65 ERA and was named the NJCAA Division III Player of the Year and MVP of the World Series. He transferred to the University of Louisville for the 2023 season and pitched at the University of Alabama in 2024 before being selected by the Giants in the seventh round of that year's MLB Draft. **For more on Farone, see page two.**

FOR CHESAPEAKE: Left-hander Sebastian Gongora makes his 20th start of the season and his fourth appearance against the Flying Squirrels. He last pitched on Tuesday out of the bullpen and allowed one run over three innings. He also made two appearances against Richmond, including one start, in mid-June. Gongora is 2-0 with a 2.03 ERA (3 ER/13.1 IP) in his three appearances facing the Flying Squirrels. Gongora was selected by the Orioles in the 11th round of the 2024 MLB Draft out of the University of Louisville, where he was teammates with Gavin Kilen, after spending the previous two seasons at Wright State, where he was the 2023 Horizon League Pitcher of the Year. In the Eastern League this season, Gongora is ranked tied for second in wins (9), third in ERA (3.88), sixth in WHIP (1.34) and eighth in innings pitched (104.1).

KILEN IT: In his first 31 Double-A games, **Gavin Kilen** is batting .308 (37-for-120) with a homer, 10 doubles, three triples and 16 RBIs. For the season, he is tied for second among all MiLB hitters with 37 doubles. He is third among all Giants minor league hitters with 81 RBIs this year. After playing in the All-Star Futures Game in Philadelphia, Kilen was promoted to Double-A on July 17. He has at least one hit in 24 of his 31 games in the Eastern League. Kilen was selected by the Giants last year out of the University of Tennessee with the 13th overall pick in the MLB Draft. He is tied for the third-highest pick in the MLB Draft in Flying Squirrels franchise history with Patrick Bailey (2020) and trailing only Joey Bart (2, 2018) and Hunter Bishop (10, 2019). On August 13, he became the sixth player in Flying Squirrels franchise history to triple twice in the same game. On Wednesday, he tied his career high with four hits and drove in the go-ahead run in the ninth.

SABIN SURGING: **Sabin Ceballos** had his third two-homer game of the season on Wednesday night. He has eight walks over his last seven games dating back to August 14. Ceballos has 63 walks this season, the fourth-most in a season in franchise history. He is three walks behind Hayden Cantrelle (66, 2023) for third place on the list. In his career, Ceballos has worked 110 walks, which is fifth-most in Flying Squirrels franchise history and two behind Ricky Oropesa (112, 2013-16) for fourth.

TOP SKIPPER: Flying Squirrels manager **Dennis Pelfrey** has led the team to 329 wins in his career, which is a franchise record all-time wins record for a manager. He passed the record with Richmond's 6-1 win at Binghamton on May 23, 2025. From 2011-2013, **Dave Machemer** won 216 games as Richmond's manager, leading the team to the Eastern League postseason for in 2011. Pelfrey, who has been with Richmond since the 2022 season, led the team to back-to-back postseason appearances for the first time in franchise history in 2022 and 2023. He also managed the 2021 Eugene Emeralds to the High-A West championship. Of Richmond managers since 1954, Pelfrey is second in wins behind Eddie Haas (1968, 1981-84), who had 351 wins.

IN THE LEAGUE LEADERS: In the Eastern League, **Charlie Szykowny** is tied for third in triples (4), eighth in hits (107) and tied for ninth in total bases (178). **Sabin Ceballos** is tied for fifth in walks (63). **Diego Velasquez** is fifth in batting average (.295) and seventh in OBP (.384). **Jonah Cox** is tied for first in triples (5) and ninth in stolen bases (27). **Tyler Vogel** is first in saves (15) and tied for seventh in wins (8). **Trystan Vrieling** is first in shutouts (1), tied for first in complete games (1) and seventh in ERA (4.26).

PROSPECT WATCH: Richmond's roster features four players ranked in Baseball America's top-30 Giants prospects, including **Gavin Kilen** (No. 10), **Trevor Cohen** (No. 12), RHP **Miguel Mendez** (No. 20), and RHP **Yunior Marte** (No. 27). Jordan is rated as the organization's best athlete. MLB.com's top-30 Giants prospects list features five Richmond players, including Kilen (No. 6), Cohen (No. 14), Mendez (No. 16), **Jancel Villarroel** (No. 19), Marte (No. 25) and **Lisbel Diaz** (No. 30).

MISC NOTES: **Tyler Vogel** is the first Eastern League reliever to reach 15 saves in a season since Portland's Luis Guerrero (18) in 2023. He now has the fifth-most saves in a season in franchise history, with **Heath Hembree's** 17 saves in 2011 next on the list. Vogel is also seventh in franchise history in career saves with 21, trailing **Josh Osich** (2013-2016) and **Tyler Myrick** (2023-2025) for a tie for fifth with 22. // **Lisbel Diaz** hit his first Double-A homer on Friday and his 25th overall this season between Low-A San Jose, High-A Eugene and Richmond, which is tied with Bo Davidson, who also homered on Friday, for the most in the Giants organization this year. // Former Richmond pitcher **Taylor Raschi** (2022) made his first appearance for the Athletics on Thursday, allowing one run over two innings. He was designated for assignment by the Diamondbacks in June and the Twins in August before being claimed the Athletics. // Former Flying Squirrels reliever **Erik Miller** (2023) pitched a scoreless inning against the Giants on Friday night at Fenway Park. He has not allowed an earned run over 8.1 innings with the Red Sox since being traded on August 3. // There have been 47 Flying Squirrels alumni who have played in the majors this year (plus **Donovan Walton**, who had previous MLB experience before playing in Richmond), including 25 with the Giants.

THIS DATE IN RICHMOND BASEBALL HISTORY

1958: The Richmond Virginians beat the Miami Marlins, 7-1, on the road. Miami committed four errors, including three by Jerry Snyder, in the first inning to post four runs against starter 51-year-old Satchel Paige. The four unearned runs were the only runs allowed by Paige over five innings. **1961:** The Richmond Virginians beat the Jersey City Jerseys, 9-8, at Parker Field. With two outs in the bottom of the 10th, George Riskey drove a pinch-hit triple and came in to score on a game-winning single to left by Jake Gibbs. **1977:** The Richmond Braves lost to the Pawtucket Red Sox, 12-4, at Parker Field. The game was aired on WXEX (present-day WRIC), the first televised game in Richmond Braves history. Randy Blair provided the play-by-play. He was joined by a rotation of color commentators including Eddie Kasko, Bobby Bragan and Hank Aaron. **1979:** The Richmond Braves beat the Pawtucket Red Sox, 3-2, at Parker Field. Glenn Hubbard won the game with a walk-off, two-run triple. **2019:** The Flying Squirrels lost to the Akron RubberDucks, 4-3, in 10 innings. It was the team's fifth-straight game to go to extra innings.
