RIDERS HANG ON LATE FOR WIN OVER HOOKS:

The Frisco RoughRiders opened the floodgates offensively with 13 hits on Thursday, scoring all 11 runs by the fifth inning and holding off a late rally to win 11-10 over the Corpus Christi Hooks at Riders Field. Frisco (29-25, 60-62) moved within two games of first-place Amarillo in the second half standings and took a 2-1 lead in the series over Corpus Christi (26-28, 59-64). The Hooks mounted a comeback in the ninth inning, scoring five runs and putting the tying run on third base before **Aidan Anderson** struck out Zach Daniels to collect the save. **Trevor Hauger** went 2-for-4 on Thursday with a double and a two-run home run. His 427-foot blast was his 12th homer of the year, leading Frisco's active roster. **Kellen Strahm** and **Liam Hicks** followed Hauger in the batting order; all three had two hits and two RBIs. **Seth Nordlin** (2-5) went five innings for his sixth consecutive start. He earned the win, allowing three runs and four hits with four strikeouts. The Riders scored in the first inning for the fourth time in the last five games. Hicks completed a two-out rally with an RBI single after Hauger and Strahm drew free passes. The Riders fell behind 3-1 in the second inning but matched Corpus Christi with a three-run frame. The first four batters all recorded hits, beginning with singles by **Frainer Chavez** and **Angel Aponte**, plus **Keyber Rodriguez's** RBI single. **Jax Biggers** tacked on a two-run double to retake the lead. Aponte's single was his first hit in his first Double-A at bat. Frisco then planted five runs in the fourth inning, featuring another string of four consecutive hits. After Rodriguez's leadoff walk and stolen base, **Aaron Zavala** singled him home, Hauger doubled, Strahm singled for two runs and Hicks doubled for another run. Chavez added an RBI bunt single later in the frame. **Robby Ahlstrom** pitched a scoreless sixth inning for Frisco, matched by **Triston Polley's** 1-2-3 frame with two strikeouts in the eighth. The loss went to Blair Henley (3-6), who was roughed up by the Riders for nine hits and eight runs over 3.1 innings. Zavala reached base three times: a walk, single and hit by pitch. He has three hits and five free passes in the three games this series.

DRIVERS, START YOUR ENGINES:

The RoughRiders have scored in the first inning in five of the last six games. The Riders lead the Texas League in first-inning runs with 95 over their 122 games. As a team, Frisco is hitting .274/.369/.441/.810 in the first inning with 14 home runs.

WALK IT LIKE I TALK IT:

For almost the entire season, the RoughRiders have lead the Texas League in walks as an offense. Frisco has already shattered their franchise record for most walks in a season with 613 and counting (5.0 per game). Frisco's .358 on-base percentage is on pace to set a new franchise record as well. In the six games in Midland, the Riders walked 38 times (6.3 per game) with **Chris Seise**, **Trevor Hauger** and **David Garcia** leading the way with five.

HE'S DOING BIG(GERS) THINGS:

RoughRiders infielder **Jax Biggers** has been showing off in the power department this season for Frisco. Entering 2023, his career high in home runs was four and on Wednesday, he hit his 11th long ball of the season. In his last 29 games, he has clubbed six homers while hitting .288 (32-for-111)/.397/.532/.929 with five doubles, two triples, six home runs, 19 RBIs, 19 walks and 19 runs scored. In August, he had a .902 OPS, which leads the team.

NEW MONTH, NEW ME:

The RoughRiders have struggled on the mound this season, but in the month of August, they have been fantastic. In the 27 games in August, (14-13 record) the RoughRiders were third in the Texas League with a 4.13 ERA while allowing a league-low 21 home runs. **Ryan Garcia** was brilliant three Tuesdays ago in Corpus, allowing just two base runners on walks over six no-hit innings with six strikeouts. **Nick Krauth** then followed up with a second quality start, giving the RoughRiders their first back-to-back quality starts since May 31st and June 1st when **Owen White** and **Jack Leiter** completed the feat. On the offensive side in the month, Frisco is second-to-last in the Texas League with a .727 OPS and tied for last in runs per game with 4.8 per contest. Their 17 homers were last in Double-A.

HAUV YOURSELF A YEAR:

Trevor Hauger has been fantastic recently for the RoughRiders on the offensive side. On June 16th, he was hitting .218/.337/.368/.705, but in the 56 games since, he is batting .300/.413/.486/.899 with 16 doubles, seven home runs, 33 RBIs and 41 walks. In those games, he has raised his average 45 points and his OPS 106 points.

HICKS IS THE CORRECT PICK:

Liam Hicks has been as hot as anyone at the plate for the RoughRiders. Over the last 34 games, Hicks is batting .322 (38-for-118)/.438/.424/.862 with seven doubles, a triple, a home run, 20 RBIs, 22 walks and 15 runs scored. In his last 22 games, he is batting .333 (24-for-72) with a .882 OPS.

K'S BY KELLY:

RoughRiders reliever **Antoine Kelly** has been incredible out of the Riders bullpen recently. He allowed an earned run for the first time on August 17th in his last 21.2 innings. During that stretch, he had 25 strikeouts to three walks while recording four saves. He has converted on all 11 save opportunities this season. He was named Texas Rangers Minor League Reliever of the Month for July.

ONE HOME RUN, PLEASE. AND MAKE IT GRAND:

The RoughRiders have had a knack for grand slams this year with **Evan Carter** hitting Frisco's ninth grand slam of the season. They are one of two teams with at least nine grand slams in all of Minor League Baseball. Seven different players have accounted for the grand slams (**Liam Hicks**, **Luisangel Acuña**, **Jax Biggers**, **Dustin Harris**, **Trevor Hauger**, **Thomas Saggese** (3) and **Evan Carter**). On July 5th, the Riders allowed their first grand slam this year, becoming the final Texas League team to do so.

ABOUT RYAN

-Went to La Salle High School in Pasadena, California. There, his senior year, he owned a 1.16 ERA while striking out 48 in 42.1 innings, but played primarily infield.

-Went to UCLA camp as an infielder and asked one of the coaches if he could pitch the last inning of one of the games. He ended up throwing well enough that UCLA invited him out for a visit as a pitcher. He came back two weeks later and committed on the spot.

-At UCLA, he was named Pac-12 Pitcher of the Year and a consensus First Team All-American in 2019 as a junior. Over 16 games (13 starts), Garcia went 10-1 with a 1.44 ERA. In 94.0 innings, he whiffed 117 batters while walking just 26 and holding opponents to a .160 batting average. In his career with the Bruins, he went 20-2 with a 2.11 ERA. His 2.11 career ERA is seventh in UCLA history.

-His best start during his junior year came against Utah on April 26th, 2019. Over a 9.0-inning complete-game, shutout he struck out 14 batters while allowing just three base runners (two hits and one walk). The 14 strikeouts were the most by a UCLA starter since Trevor Bauer in 2011.

-Led the Wareham Gatemen of the Cape Cod League to a championship in 2018, going 2-0 with a 1.28 ERA over 10 outings.

-Now lives in Surprise, Arizona, about two blocks away from the Rangers Spring Training Complex.

2023 SEASON

-In his Double-A debut on April 11th at San Antonio, Garcia allowed just two solo home runs while tying a career-best five innings.

-Allowed career-high eight runs over 2.2 innings against Wichita on 5/10 during a day game.

-Went a career-high seven innings at Corpus Christi, finishing with just 83 pitches.

2022 SEASON

-Was activated in late May while continuing his rehabilitation from injuries.

-His thought for the 2022 season was "I have built a house this season, coming back from injury, and next season, I will be able to fortify the house."

-Averaged 11.8 K/9 over his 14 games (13 starts).

2021 SEASON

-Missed the entire 2021 season with a right lat strain. That required two months of rest and then trying to build back up, but he strained his lat three different times and was unable to get back on the mound.

2019 SEASON

-Three starts into his professional career, he went on the Injured List with a right elbow strain and underwent "Tommy John" surgery on March 16th, 2020.

-During his TJ rehab, he built a computer from scratch and is very interested in technology.
