YESTERDAY: The Flying Squirrels lost to the SeaWolves, 5-0. Andrew Navigato and Julio Rodriguez worked bases-loaded walks in the first and Gage Workman added a sac fly to give Erie a 3-0 lead. In the sixth, Jake Holton brought in two with a double to extend the SeaWolves' lead to 5-0. Spencer Bivens worked around four hits and three walks to post three scoreless innings. Blake Rivera threw two scoreless innings. Erie starter Sawyer Gipson-Long struck out eight over six scoreless innings.

TODAY'S GAME: The Richmond Flying Squirrels play the finale of a six-game series against the Erie SeaWolves, Double-A affiliate of the Detroit Tigers. Today is the 18th of 24 head-to-head game sthis year. The Flying Squirrels went 4-2 against the SeaWolves at The Diamond from April 18-23. Erie won five-of-six at UPMC Park from May 9-14. Along with this week's series, the Flying Squirrels will head back to Erie for six games to close the regular season from September 12-17. In the current series, the Sea Wolves have outscored the Flying Squirrels, 40-11.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS snapped a seven game-losing streak, their longest since 2018, with Friday's win but have lost eightof-nine since May 25. The Flying Squirrels were 14-7 through their first 21 games but have lost 20-of-their-last-28. The record since May 3 is the worst in the Eastern League. Richmond starters have thrown 167.2 innings, which is the fewest in Double-A. Richmond relievers have thrown 253.1 innings this year, the most in Double-A. The Flying Squirrels bullpen has a 3.02 ERA, which is the lowest of all 120 teams in the minors.

THE SEAWOLVES are in first place in the Southwest Division, one game ahead of Altoona, and have won eight-of-their-last-11 games. The SeaWolves' offense leads the Eastern League in runs scored (294), hits (432), total bases (710), RBIs (273), OBP (.355) and OPS (.769) and ranks second in batting average (.252), triples (12), homers (58) and walks (245). Erie's roster includes seven of Baseball America's top-30 Tigers prospects, including RHP Wilmer Flores (No. 3), RHP Ty Madden (No. 4), INF Colt Keith (No. 5), C Dillon Dingler (No. 7), INF Wenceel Perez (No. 18), LHP Brant Hurter (No. 26) and INF Gage Workman (No. 27). Andrew Magno is rated by Baseball America as having the best curveball in Detroit's system, Dingler is rated as the best defensive catcher, Perez is rated as the best hitter for average and Workman is rated as the best defensive infielder and best infield arm. MLB.com's top-30 Tigers prospects list includes Keith (No. 2), Flores (No. 4), Madden (No. 5), Perez (No. 8), Dingler (No. 14), Hurter (No. 21), Workman (No. 28) and Keider Montero (No. 30).

FOR RICHMOND: Right-hander Ryan Murphy makes his ninth start of the season and his fifth appearance against the SeaWolves. He started the series-opener on Tuesday and allowed a season-high six runs (five earned) over 3.1 innings in a loss. Last year, Murphy began the season with High-A Eugene and went 1-0 with a 2.90 ERA in seven starts. He was promoted to Double-A Richmond in late-June and made two starts before being placed on the injured list for most of the rest of the season. Murphy was selected in the fifth round of the 2020 MLB Draft out of Le Moyne College near Syracuse, N.Y., and was the highest-drafted Division II player that year. Murphy is currently rated by Baseball America as the No. 20 Giants prospect and No. 27 by MLB. com. For more on Murphy, see page two.

**FOR ERIE:** Right-hander Wilmer Flores makes his 11th start of the season and his fifth against the Flying Squirrels. He pitched on Tuesday to open the series and picked up a win after allowing one run over five innings with a season-high eight strikeouts. After starting the year 0-2 with a 8.27 ERA (15 ER/16.1 IP) in five starts, he has gone 3-0 with a 2.16 ERA (6 ER/25.0 IP) in his last five starts since May 6. Flores faced the Flying Squirrels on April 18 at The Diamond and allowed a season-high seven runs over 2.2 innings in a loss. He started the series finale of that week on April 23 and threw four scoreless innings, his only scoreless outing in April. On May 12, he allowed one run in five innings in a win over the Flying Squirrels at UPMC Park. Flores signed out of Arizona Western with the Tigers in 2020 and made 19 starts for the SeaWolves in 2022, going 6-4 with a 3.01 ERA. He made two starts against the Flying Squirrels last year, striking out a season-high eight batters in both of them, on June 11 and September 12 at The Diamond. Flores is the younger brother of Giants infielder Wilmer Flores.

PACKING THE HOUSE: Last year, the Flying Squirrels led all of Double-A in total attendance (406,560) and average attendance (6,160) for the first time in franchise history. This year, they are again leading the level in average attendance (6,829) and total attendance (170,726). The Flying Squirrels are ranked eighth of the 120 MiLB teams in average attendance.

GLDW SHDW: Infielder Jimmy Glowenke was assigned to Double-A Richmond on Tuesday and made his Double-A debut on Wednesday. He was selected in the second round (68th overall) by the Giants in the 2020 MLB Draft out of Dallas Baptist. Glowenke started the season with High-A Eugene. Among Northwest League hitters (min. 100 PA) this year, Glowenke ranked sixth in OPS (.956), sixth in batting average (.313), sixth in wRC+ (146), seventh in OBP (.413), tied for seventh in doubles (10) and eighth in SLG (.542). He also had the fourth-lowest strikeouts percentage (14.3) in the league. He picked up his first Double-A hit on Thursday night, an RBI single, and he has four hits over his last three games.

WHERE THERE'S A WILLIAMS THERE'S A WAY: Carter Williams has hit safely in each of his last six games since last Saturday at Binghamton. During that stretch, he is batting .375 (9-for-24) with two homers, a double, two RBIs and five runs scored. He homered in back-to-back games last Sunday at Binghamton and Tuesday against Erie. Last year in his first full professional season, Williams hit .336 over 80 games between Low-A San Jose and High-A Eugene, which ranked second among Giants minor league hitters (min. 300 PA).

ROCKET RANDY: Reliever Randy Rodriguez has gone 1-1 with one save and a 0.84 ERA (2 ER/21.1 IP) over his last 10 appearances since April 27, striking out 29 batters and with a .114 BAA. He struck out a season-high five batters over two innings on May 21 against the RubberDucks. On Thursday, he threw 2.2 scoreless innings, allowing one hit with no walks and three strikeouts. Among Eastern League relievers (min. 25 IP, zero starts), Rodriguez has the highest K/9 (11.97) and strikeout percentage (32.0) and ranks third in ERA (2.45).

IN THE LEAGUE LEADERS: In the Eastern League, Luis Matos is ranked fifth in batting average (.304) and 10th in OBP (.398). Ismael Munguia is tied for sixth in batting average (.300). Tyler Fitzgerald is tied for second in triples (3). Evan Gates is tied for eighth in saves (4). Kai-Wei Teng is tied for fourth in strikeouts (55).

WHERE THE SEAWOLVES RANK: Among the Eastern League leaders, Colt Keith is second in batting average (.324), tied for fifth in homers (10), second in RBIs (41), ninth in OBP (.401), third in SLG (.568), third in OPS (.969), second in hits (60), fourth in extra-base hits (23), second in total bases (105) and tied for fifth in runs (34). Jake Holton is eighth in OBP (.406) and eighth in walks (33). Trei Cruz is ninth in OPS (.891) and tied for third in runs (35). Wenceel Perez is tied for fifth in runs (34). Angel De Jesus is tied for first in games pitched (18)

PROSPECT WATCH: The Flying Squirrels have eight players ranked in *Baseball America*'s Top-30 Giants prospects, including Marco Luciano (No. 1, No. 30 overall), Vaun Brown (No. 6), Mason Black (No. 9), Carson Seymour (No. 12), Landen Roupp (No. 13), Ryan Murphy (No. 20), Wade Meckler (No. 23) and Randy Rodriguez (No. 30). Luciano is rated by Baseball America as the organization's best power hitter. Roupp is rated as having the best curveball. Brown is rated as the best hitter for average and the best athlete. Meckler is rated as having the best strike-zone discipline. MLB.com's Top-30 Giants prospect list includes Luciano (No. 2, No. 20 overall), Brown (No. 5), Black (No. 10), Roupp (No. 13), Seymour (No. 17), Rodriguez (No. 26) and Murphy (No. 27).
