THIS DATE IN HISTORY

On April 8, 2003, one day after John Wasdin's perfect game against the Isotopes, the streak finally ended. Albuquerque scored in the third inning to snap a streak of 36 2/3 scoreless innings by Nashville pitchers.

Tonight's Game: The Nashville Sounds and Durham Bulls face off for game four of the six-game series tonight at First Horizon Park. The Bulls took game three of the series behind a pair of Jim Haley home runs last night. Right-handed pitcher Jason Alexander will make his first career start for the Sounds against Durham's left-handed pitcher Zack Erwin.

Jason Alexander: 29-year-old Jason Alexander will take the mound for his first start in the Brewers organization. The right-hander from Morgan Hill, Calif. went 1-1 with a 1.37 ERA in 7 games (6 starts) with Triple-A Jacksonville (5), Double-A Pensacola (1) and Rookie-Level FCL Marlins (1) last season. He spent around four months on the injured list in limited work. Alexander made his Triple-A debut in 2018 with Salt Lake, going 0-1 with a 6.75 ERA in two games (1 start) with the Bees that season. He was originally signed as an undrafted free agent by the Los Angeles Angels in 2017.

Zack Erwin: 28-year-old Zack Erwin is scheduled to make his second appearance and first start of the season for Durham. The left-handed pitcher who resides in Sunset, S.C. threw a scoreless 1.1 innings on Opening Day while striking out two Sounds. He signed as a free agent with Tampa Bay on January 4, 2022 and made three appearances for the Rays in spring training (7.71 ERA, 4.2 IP, 8 H, 4 R, 4 ER, 4 BB, 3 K). Erwin split the 2021 campaign between Double-A Midland and Triple-A Las Vegas in the Athletics organization, going 6-4 with a 4.00 ERA (28 ER/63.0 IP) in 49 games between the two levels. He also tied for seventh among Athletics minor leaguers in wins. He was originally drafted in the fourth round of the 2015 First-Year Player Draft out of Clemson University by the Chicago White Sox.

Who Turned Off the Heat?: The coldest first pitch temperature in First Horizon Park history occurred on April 16, 2018, when the Sounds hosted the Omaha Storm Chasers. The Sounds took the victory on a walk-off wild pitch, with B.J. Boyd scoring from third base in the 9th inning. The second coldest first pitch in ballpark history was on April 15, 2018, with the first pitch temperature at 47 degrees.

Singleton Smashing: Though he failed to register a hit last night, Jon Singleton walked in the fourth inning to reach safely in all three games this season. He also had an RBI groundout in the fifth to stretch his RBI streak to three games. Singleton is tied for second in the International League lead in homers with nine other hitters (Ryan Fitzgerald of Worcester leads the IL with three homers in three games).

Off And Running: After not stealing a base in the first two games, the Sounds recorded three stolen bases last night. Jonathan Davis, Jon Singleton and Corey Ray all swiped second base last night, respectively.

Gunning Them Down: Nashville catcher Brian Navarreto threw out three runners attempting a stolen base last night. It is the sixth time he has thrown out three attempted base stealers in a game and his first since July 25, 2017, with Advanced-A Fort Myers at Lakeland.

Just Keep Hitting, Jamie: Jamie Westbrook notched his second multi-hit game of the season in as many appearances, going 2-for-3 with a walk. He currently ranks second in the International League in batting average (.667) and in on-base percentage (.714).

How Sweet It Is: Sounds manager Rick Sweet begins his third season overall and second consecutive season at the helm of the Nashville club. Sweet led the Sounds to a 70-58 record in 2021 and a 77-67 record in 2014. He has served as the manager for Milwaukee's Triple-A club since the 2014 season and has compiled a 510-462 record during this span.

Nobody's Perfect: The Sounds enter the day in a tie for fifth place in the International League's West Division, 1.0 game back from Gwinnett, Omaha and St. Paul. No team in the division is unbeaten through three games, while Lehigh Valley and Scranton/Wilkes-Barre are 2-0 on the season through Thursday.

The Brew Crew: The Milwaukee Brewers played the first game of the 2022 Major League Baseball season yesterday at Wrigley Field against the Chicago Cubs. The Brewers' current active roster includes 11 former Sounds, including Aaron Ashby, Lorenzo Cain, Jake Cousins, Jandel Gustave, Keston Hiura, Eric Lauer, Hoby Milner, Jace Peterson, Tyrone Taylor, Rowdy Tellez and Christian Yelich.

The Future Brew Crew: Nashville opens the 2022 season with four players on the roster who are listed on MLB Pipeline's Top-30 Milwaukee prospects. Infielder Brice Turang is the No. 4 prospect, left-handed pitcher Ethan Small is the No. 7 prospect, catcher Mario Feliciano is the No. 21 prospect and right-handed pitcher Dylan File is the No. 25 prospect.

LAST OUTING: Alexander earned his only win of the season in his final start on September 30, 2021 with Jacksonville at Gwinnett. He tossed 5.0 scoreless innings and allowed just four hits while striking out five.

AGAINST OPPONENT: Alexander has made one start against the Bulls back on May 14, 2021 with Jacksonville. He did not receive a decision after allowing three runs (1 ER) and three hits over 3.2 innings pitched. He allowed a solo home run to current Rays hitter Taylor Walls. The Jumbo Shrimp did rally for a 6-4 win over Durham in that contest.

2022 SEASON HIGHLIGHTS:

- Tonight's start will be Alexander's first start of the season with Nashville. He made two appearances (1 start) for the Brewers in spring training, allowing two hits and one walk over 4.0 scoreless innings.
