WSH AFFILIATE NOTES

Double-A Harrisburg dropped their series finale in Portland (BOS) Sunday afternoon, 12-2...1B **BRANDEN BOISSIERE** homered and doubled in the losing effort, his 8th long ball of 2026.

SUNDAY SCARIES: With a chance to win three-straight and take five of six in Sunday afternoon's series finale, the Rochester Red Wings fell to the Syracuse Mets in a back-and-forth battle, 9-7...after a 70-minute rain delay to kick things off, the Red Wings stormed back from an early deficit to take the lead with a five-run fifth that included a pair of RBI singles, and a two-RBI double off the bat of C **MAXWELL ROMERO JR.**...Syracuse fought back in the sixth, and added an insurance run in the ninth to hand the Red Wings their second loss of the week...1B **RILEY ADAMS** finished the day as the only Rochester hitter with at least two hits, his third-straight multi-hit performance and ninth since the start of July...Rochester traveled to first-place Scranton/WB Monday for a six-game set beginning tonight...the Red Wings will send **LHP KONNOR PILKINGTON** to the mound against RailRiders RHP **Brendan Beck**.

PILK & COOKIES: LHP **KONNOR PILKINGTON** will take the ball first for Rochester in tonight's series opener at Scranton/WB, his second start as a Red Wing in 2026...the Mississippi native pitched in two games in the Red Wings previous series against Syracuse, tossing a combined 1.2 scoreless innings with three strikeouts and no walks...across four starts with the Red Wings since the start of 2025, Pilkington boasts a 1.00 ERA (1 ER/9.0 IP) on just three hits, with 15 strikeouts and a 1.11 WHIP...
R Since returning to Rochester, the former Toledo Mud Hen is 1-0 with a 1.29 ERA (1 ER/7.0 IP) with a .167 BAA in seven appearances (1 GS).

RILED UP: 1B **RILEY ADAMS** went 3-for-4 in Sunday afternoon's loss, including a double in the third, an RBI, and a run scored...Adams extended his hit streak to seven games, as well as his extra-base hit streak to four, the ladder of which is tied for the second-longest active XBH streak in Triple-A...since 6/19, the former Buffalo Bison ranks ninth among all qualified International League players (min. 30 AB) in batting average (.370), third in OPS (1.148), and seventh in slugging percentage (.679)...

R In games played on Tuesday (min. 20 AB), Adams has the highest on-base percentage (.458), the second-highest OPS (.958) and the third highest batting average (.350) and slugging percentage (.500) on the Red Wings.

GLASS HALF FULL: 2B **PHILLIP GLASSER** hit 1-for-3, scoring a run and logging a walk to extend his on-base streak to 11-straight games, the longest active streak on the team...since this streak began on 7/22, the second baseman is slashing .333/.500/.389...among all qualified International League players, Glasser has the eighth-highest batting average this season (.308)...additionally, he is now just four hits shy of 100 as a Red Wing.

RAND(RY) THEN SOME: RHP **ANDRY LARA** took over mound duties in the late stages of Sunday's losing effort versus SYR, slinging a scoreless eighth inning paired with a strikeout... he has improved his ERA as a reliever to 1.13 (1 ER/8.0 IP) with a WHIP of 1.25 in three appearances...the Venezuelan has also hurled seven strikeouts and allowed just one run, while also owning the second-lowest ERA (3.75) of any Red Wing pitcher on the road this season (min. 25 IP)...

R Lara is currently one strikeout shy of 100 as a Red Wing.

PUT A PIN(EDA) IN IT: RF **LEANDRO PINEDA** has now hit safely in four of his first five Triple-A games after going 1-for-3 with an RBI single, while adding a walk in Sunday afternoon's series finale...the Venezuela native has picked up seven hits in his first 15 at-bats with the team (.467), with three walks and a .556 OBP...he is now just four hits shy of 100 in his professional career, and seven RBI away from 250.

RED WINGS REWIND...

...1988 & 2005: Two different Red Wings pitchers combined to strike out 30 batters across two separate performances both 38 and 21 years ago today...on 8/4/1988, RHP **PETE HARNISCH** struck out 17 batters in a victory over the Toledo Mud Hens at Silver Stadium, the second-most punchouts in a game in franchise history...in 2005, southpaw **FRANCISCO LIRIANO** mowed down 13 Buffalo batters over 7.0 one-hit, shutout innings to lower his ERA to a 1.82 across nine starts.

- Remains at the third-lowest ERA (4.38) of any Red Wings pitcher with at least 50 innings of work.
- Recalled by Washington on 4/24 for his MLB debut the same day at Chicago-AL...allowed two earned on two hits across 2.0 innings of relief, striking out one and walking four.
