LAST TIME OUT: Brooklyn earned its 6th-straight victory and 2nd-consecutive home sweep with a 4-3 come-from-behind win on Sunday afternoon vs. Aberdeen...The Cyclones collected their 2nd-straight walk-off win when C **Chris Suero** brought in the game's final two runs on an infield single to third, plus a throwing error from 3B **Anderson De Los Santos**...Aberdeen committed 3 errors in the 9th inning to help Brooklyn complete the comeback...Prior to the 9th inning, the Cyclones had seen 13 consecutive hitters retired in order...Aberdeen started the game by sitting down Brooklyn's first 10 hitters, too...The 'Clones only 2 baserunners before the 9th came on a CF **Carson Bengé** single and a Suero 2-run home run in the 4th...RHP **Trey Gibson** took a no-decision for the IronBirds after striking out a South Atlantic League season-high 13 batters over 6.0 innings of 2-hit, 2-run ball.

THE NUMBER ONE SPOT: The Cyclones are mired in a 3-team race for the South Atlantic League First Half North Division crown...Entering play on Tuesday, Brooklyn (36-15) holds a 1.5-game lead on Greensboro (34-16) for 1st place in the division...The Cyclones are 4.5 games up on 3rd-place Hudson Valley (31-19) with 15 games remaining in the first half...Brooklyn does not play Hudson Valley or Greensboro for the remainder of the half...Greensboro has played one series (April 15-20 vs. Jersey Shore) against a North Division foe and will not play another until the second half (July 1-6 vs./at Aberdeen).

IT'S A WALK-OFF: C **Chris Suero** provided Brooklyn's 2nd walk-off win in as many days in Sunday's 4-3 victory vs. Aberdeen...With 2nd and 3rd and 2 out, the 21-year-old reached on a run-scoring infield single, while a throwing error from 3B **Anderson De Los Santos** enabled the winning run to cross...On Saturday, C **Ronald Hernandez** helped Brooklyn complete another come-from-behind win, clobbering a walk-off solo home run with 1 out in the 9th in a 5-4 Cyclones win...The walk-off homer was Brooklyn's 1st since 3B **Jeffrey De Los Santos** hit a game-tying 2-run blast and LF **Omar De Los Santos** smashed the game-ending solo shot on July 28, 2024, vs. Rome...Hernandez also delivered a walk-off winner with a run-producing fielder's choice in the bottom of the 10th on May 18 vs. Winston-Salem...2B **Marco Vargas** collected Brooklyn's 1st walk-off win of the year, slapping a game-ending RBI single in the bottom of the 10th on April 29 vs. Wilmington.

KEEP THE 'COASTER MOVING: The Cyclones remained perfect in series through the first 51 games of the 2025 season with Friday's win over Aberdeen, clinching another series victory...Through Brooklyn's first 9 series of the year, the Cyclones hold a 7-0-2 record...In home series, Brooklyn is 4-0-1, splitting their first full 6-game set with Hudson Valley from April 8-13...The Cyclones have not lost a series since they dropped 5-of-6 at home vs. Jersey Shore from August 20-25, 2024...Since then, Brooklyn is 9-0-2 in a series of any length.

BREAK OUT THE BROOMS: Brooklyn secured its 2nd-straight home sweep with a 4-3 walk-off win vs. Aberdeen on Sunday...The Cyclones secured their 1st sweep vs. Winston-Salem in walk-off fashion, as well...On May 18, C **Ronald Hernandez's** game-ending RBI fielder's choice in the bottom of the 10th helped the Cyclones complete their first 6-game sweep since 2022 and their first at home since 2021...Prior to May 18, Brooklyn had not completed a 6-game sweep since taking all 6 contests at Jersey Shore from August 23-28, 2022...The Cyclones outscored the BlueClaws, 53-18, in that series...It was Brooklyn's first 6-game sweep on Coney Island since July 20-25, 2021, vs. Wilmington...The 'Clones outscored the 'Rocks, 41-22, in that set...Brooklyn's 6-game winning streak was snapped Tuesday at Jersey Shore...Additionally, the Cyclones' 36-15 record through 51 games is the franchise's best record through 51 games in Minor League Baseball's Digital Era (2005-present)...Brooklyn's 35-16 mark through 51 games in 2007 and 2010 is tied for 2nd-best.

GOING STRIKING: The Cyclones enter Tuesday's series opener riding a season-high-tying 6-game winning streak...Brooklyn also won 6 in a row from May 13-18 vs. Winston-Salem...It is the 1st time the Cyclones have accrued multiple winning streaks of 6 more since the 2022 campaign...Brooklyn secured 7-straight wins from August 23-30, 2022, at Jersey Shore and vs. Wilmington...That was the 'Clones most recent 7-game winning streak...The Cyclones then won 6 consecutive contests from September 3-9 vs. Wilmington and at Winston-Salem...Brooklyn's winning streak from May 13-18 was the first time the team had won 6-straight since that stretch in 2022...During that win streak, the Cyclones clinched the Second Half South Atlantic League North Division crown at Winston-Salem.

HOME COOKING: Brooklyn continued their dominance at Maimonides Park on Sunday with a 4-3 walk-off victory vs. Aberdeen...Sunday's triumph was the Cyclones' 13th-consecutive home win...Brooklyn's franchise record for consecutive home wins is 19, set in the inaugural 2001 campaign...Entering play on Tuesday, Brooklyn holds the best home record in the South Atlantic League at 22-5 (.815)...No one else in the league has more than 16 home victories (Greensboro, Greenville, Hub City, Hudson Valley)...The 22 home wins are the most at the High-A level and tied with the Athletics' Triple-A Las Vegas for the 2nd most in Minor League Baseball...Detroit's Triple-A Toledo is 1st (23)...Brooklyn's .815 home winning percentage is the best in MiLB...Los Angeles-NL's Single-A Rancho Cucamonga and Detroit's High-A West Michigan (.810) are tied for 2nd.

CAN'T TUCC THIS: LHP **Jonathan Santucci** has found his form in 2025...The 2024 Mets' 2nd-round selection is a perfect 3-0 over his last 3 outings, including a 5.1 scoreless inning performance in relief to earn the win on Thursday vs. Aberdeen...Since May 16 vs. Winston-Salem, the 22-year-old has an 0.59 ERA (1 ER in 15.1 IP) with 6 hits allowed, 6 walks, and 17 strikeouts...Since that date, Santucci is tied for the South Atlantic League lead in wins (3), 2nd in batting average against (.115) and ERA (0.59), 5th in WHIP (0.78), and 10th in innings pitched (15.1).

REIMER SHINE: INF **Jacob Reimer** remains scorching hot to start the 2025 season...Entering play on Tuesday, Reimer is tied for 2nd in Minor League Baseball in runs scored (46), 6th in extra-base hits (27), and 10th in OPS (.993)...The former 4th-round pick also leads the South Atlantic League in runs scored (46), OPS (.993), extra-base hits (27), and doubles (16), and is tied for the league lead in hits (56)...Reimer also ranks 2nd in total bases (102) and slugging percentage (.580), tied for 2nd in RBI (35), 3rd in batting average (.318), tied for 6th in games played (47), and 7th in on-base percentage (.413)...Reimer was limited to just 35 games in 2024 with a hamstring injury.

vs. WILMINGTON: After sweeping their 2nd-straight home series, Brooklyn hits the road for a 6-game series with the Blue Rocks...Wilmington enters the series after taking a 4-of-6 games in Wappingers Falls against Hudson Valley...The Blue Rocks are 12-12 at home this season...Brooklyn is 7-2 in 9 contests against Wilmington in 2025...The Blue Rocks boast 6 of the Nationals' Top 30 prospects per MLB Pipeline: RHP **Travis Sykora** (1), LHP **Alex Clemmey** (5), C **Caleb Lomavita** (8), LHP **Jackson Kent** (20), OF **Elijah Green** (23), and OF **Brenner Cox** (29)...Green is currently on the development list...In 116 meetings since 2021, the Cyclones lead the all-time series, 64-52 (.552)...Brooklyn is 26-30 (.464) in 56 games at Daniel S. Frawley Stadium.

ALL BÁEZ ON ME: After recovering from knee surgery, INF **Jesús Báez** has slowly returned to form...The 20-year-old reached base safely in 17-of-23 plate appearances in the series against Jersey Shore and went 6-for-8 at the plate in May 23's doubleheader with 3 runs scored, a double, 2 home runs, and 7 RBI, en route to winning South Atlantic League Player of the Week honors...During the week, Báez hit .647 (11-17) with 6 runs scored, 2 home runs, and 10 RBI...The infielder led the circuit in batting average (.647), on-base percentage (.739), slugging percentage (1.059) OPS (1.798), and was tied for the league lead in RBI (10)...After OF **A.J. Ewing** won Player of the Week for May 13-18, it marked the first time Brooklyn hitters had won a league's Player of the Week award in consecutive weeks in franchise history...Báez also was recognized on MiLB.com's "Prospect Team of the Week" for his efforts...The Santo Domingo, D.R. native has reached safely in 23-straight games since May 3 vs. Wilmington, hitting .351/.468/.527/.995 with 16 runs scored, 4 doubles, 3 home runs, 21 RBI, 3 stolen bases, and 17 walks to 9 strikeouts...Báez had a 10-game hitting streak since May 15 vs. Winston-Salem snapped on Tuesday...He went 16-for-30 (.533) at the plate with 9 runs scored, a double, 2 home runs, 12 RBI, and 7 walks to 1 strikeout...On May 20, the infielder tied a Cyclones' single-game franchise record, working 4 walks at Jersey Shore...The feat has been accomplished 11 times, most recently by LF **Ryan Clifford** on April 21, 2024, at Jersey Shore...Since the start of May, Báez leads the South Atlantic League in on-base percentage (.456) and RBI (24), is 3rd in batting average (.341) and OPS (.993), tied for 6th in walks (17), and 9th in slugging percentage (.537).

BENGE IT LIKE CARSON: OF **Carson Bengé** has been heating up at the plate over the last few weeks...The Yukon, Okla. native was recognized on MiLB.com's "Prospect Team of the Week" from May 20-25 after hitting .412 (7-17) with 8 runs scored, 3 doubles, 2 triples, an RBI, 8 walks to 3 strikeouts, 2 stolen bases, and 2 hit-by-pitches in 6 games at Jersey Shore...The 2024 first-round pick enters Tuesday tied for the South Atlantic League lead in triples (4)...He is also 2nd in runs scored (38), 4th in on-base percentage (.425) and OPS (.925), tied for 4th in extra-base hits (19) and doubles (11), tied for 5th in walks (32), 7th in batting average (.304), total bases (79) and slugging percentage (.500), and 8th in hits (48).

EWING-ING IT: IF/OF **A.J. Ewing** has had a marvelous start to his 2025 season and was recognized as the South Atlantic League Player of the Week for May 13-18 vs. Winston-Salem...In 5 games, the 20-year-old went 9-for-18 (.500) at the plate with 5 runs scored, 2 doubles, a triple, 3 RBI, 5 walks, and 6 stolen bases...Ewing led the SAL in steals (6) and on-base percentage (.609) for the week...He was the first Cyclone to receive a league weekly honor since INF **Nick Lorusso** and LHP **Felipe De La Cruz** took home Player and Pitcher of the Week, respectively, for May 20-26, 2024...Entering play on Tuesday, the Springfield, Ohio native is tied for the Minor League lead in triples (7)...He is also 2nd in batting average (.364), tied for 8th in hits (63), and 10th in on-base percentage (.451)...Since debuting with Brooklyn on April 29, Ewing leads the league in steals (23), is 2nd in batting average (.343) and hits (37), tied for 2nd in triples (3), 5th in runs scored (22), 7th in on-base percentage (.415), and tied for 7th in total bases (51)...Overall, Ewing is tied for 2nd in the SAL in stolen bases (23)...The 2023 4th-round pick had a 33-game on-base streak since April 18 snapped on Sunday...During the on-base streak, Ewing hit .359/.450/.500/.950 with 27 runs scored, 5 doubles, 5 triples, a home run, 18 RBI, 21 walks, and 30 stolen bases.

SWIPER KEEP SWIPING: Brooklyn is off to a historic start on the basepaths in 2025...The Cyclones' 7-6 win over Wilmington on April 29 saw them nab a franchise record 9 stolen bases, courtesy of 7 players...The mark topped a previous high of 8 on August 2, 2017, vs. Tri-City...Brooklyn enters play on Tuesday with 117 steals, good for the 2nd most in the South Atlantic League behind only Aberdeen (132)...The 117 steals are 8th in Minor League Baseball...Cleveland's Single-A Lynchburg leads MiLB (144)...The 117 swiped bags are the most by the Cyclones through the team's first 51 games in Minor League Baseball's Digital Era (2005-present) by 39 swipes...The 2024 club is 2nd with 78 steals through 51 games...The Cyclones' single-season franchise record is 181 steals set in 2024.

THIS DATE IN CYCLONES HISTORY: On June 3, 2021, DH **Brett Baty** powered a pair of home runs, including a go-ahead 3-run shot in the 7th, in a 6-4 win at Jersey Shore...Baty finished with 3 hits and 4 RBI in the win...SS **Ronny Mauricio** added 3 knocks, including a 2-run blast in the 9th.

AMAZIN' STARTS HERE: Brooklyn's roster features no shortage of talent...According to MLB Pipeline, the Cyclones boast 12 of the Mets' Top 30 prospects...Those include OF **Carson Bengé** (3), INF **Jesús Báez** (7), LHP **Jonathan Santucci** (12), INF **Boston Baro** (13), INF **Marco Vargas** (14), RHP **Nate Dohm** (18), INF **Jacob Reimer** (20), C **Chris Suero** (21), OF **Eli Serrano III** (22) and C **Ronald Hernández** (26), OF **A.J. Ewing** (27), and RHP **Will Watson** (29)...The Cyclones also possess 10 of the Mets' Top 30 farmhands per *Baseball America*...The list features Báez (3), Bengé (7), Baro (15), Santucci (16), Vargas (17), Suero (20), Reimer (21), Dohm (23), Ewing (24), and RHP **Raimon Gómez** (26)...Brooklyn also hosts 11 of SNY's Top 30 from **Joe DeMayo**...Benge (5), Báez (6), Baro (13), Santucci (15), Vargas (17), Dohm (20), Reimer (21), Serrano (22), Suero (25), Hernández (26), and Gómez (28).

LAST TIME OUT: Did not factor into the decision last Wednesday afternoon vs. Aberdeen...Permitted a season-high 4 runs (3 earned) on 5 hits in a season-low 3.0 innings...Walked 2 and struck out 5...Threw 56 pitches and 39 strikes (69.64%)...Relieved by RHP **Cristofer Gómez** to start the top of the 4th inning with Brooklyn trailing 4-0...Cyclones would rally for 4 runs in the 4th inning to tie the game and take the lead with a pair of runs in the 7th, beating the IronBirds, 6-4...Gómez (3.0+ IP), RHP **Saúl García** (1.0 IP), and RHP **Raimon Gómez** (2.0) combined for 6.0 innings of 1-hit shutout relief in the win, adding 11 strikeouts.

2025: Broke camp with Brooklyn...Registered a no-decision in his professional debut on 4/8 vs. HV (4.1 IP, 3 H, 2 R, 2 ER, 1 BB, 4 K)...Earned the 1st victory of his pro career piggybacking off Major League rehabber RHP **Paul Blackburn** on 4/19 @ABD (4.0 IP, 3 H, 2 R, 2 ER, 3 BB, 4 K)...Struck out a career-high 9 over a career-long 5.0 innings to earn the win on 4/25 @JS (5.0 IP, 3 H, R, ER, BB, 9 K)...Picked up the win piggybacking off of Blackburn again on 5/2 vs. WIL (4.1 IP, 2 H, 3 BB, 4 K)...Tossed a career-long 6.0 innings, earning the victory, on 5/14 vWS (6.0 IP, 2 H, R, ER, 3 BB, 7 K)...Punched out 7 over 4.2 innings in a no-decision on 5/22 @JS (4.2 IP, 4 H, R, ER, 2 BB, 7 K).

DUCK TALES: Gordon spent his four-year collegiate career at the University of Oregon...As a junior in 2024, the Santa Clarita, Calif. native accumulated a 7-6 record with a 5.13 ERA (54 ER in 94.2 IP), 46 walks, and 87 strikeouts in 17 starts for the Ducks...Gordon was named All-PAC 12 Honorable Mention...Recognized on the University's Dean's List in the Winter of 2023...Served as Oregon's Opening Day starter in 2024...Was the Game 1 starter in every regular-season series, as well as the Santa Barbara Regional and the Bryan-College Station Super Regional...Led the PAC-12 in games started (17)...Also ranked 2nd in innings pitched (94.2), tied for 3rd in wins (7), and 8th in strikeouts (87)...Gordon was initially recruited to Eugene as a two-way player.

ON THE MEND: The 23-year-old returned to the bump for the Ducks in 2024 after missing and redshirting the entire 2023 season due to a UCL injury that required internal brace surgery to correct...Despite missing an entire campaign, Gordon still finished his career at Oregon tied for 10th in program history in games started (28)...Finished his college career with a 14-9 record, a 5.22 ERA (106 ER in 182.2 IP), 1 save, 89 walks, and 155 strikeouts in 51 appearances (28 starts).

BOTH WAYS: Gordon finished his high school career at West Ranch High School in Stevenson Ranch, Calif., before attending the University of Oregon...The 23-year-old spent his sophomore and junior seasons at Notre Dame High School...Was a freshman when Cincinnati Reds RHP **Hunter Greene** was a senior...During high school, the right-handed pitcher also served as a gifted outfielder, hitting .414 (12-for-29) with a home run, 4 RBI, and 1.204 OPS in a COVID-shortened senior season...In high school, Gordon faced off as a hitter against 2024 National League Rookie of the Year and Pittsburgh Pirates RHP **Paul Skenes**, who attended El Toro High School (Lake Forest, Calif.), registering a double.

FORE!: R.J. is far from the only athlete in the Gordon family...R.J.'s father, **Jason**, is an accomplished professional golfer who has played on the Canadian PGA Tour, the PGA Tour, and the Nationwide Tour.
