YESTERDAY: The Flying Squirrels lost to the Rumble Ponies, 8-2. Ryan Clifford and Nick Lorusso each had sacrifice flies in the top of the first inning. In the second, Wyatt Young, Jett Williams and Clifford each hit RBI doubles to extend the lead to 5-0. D'Andre Smith hit an RBI single in the third. In the bottom of the fifth, **Jairo Pomares** hit an RBI single and **Victor Bericoto** added a sacrifice fly to close the score to 5-2. J.T. Schwartz hit a solo homer and Kevin Parada doubled in a run to extend the Binghamton lead to 8-2 in the top of the seventh. **Nick Sinacola** threw three scoreless relief innings. **Will Bednar** struck out four over 1.2 scoreless innings. **Michael Stryfeler** did not allow a run, throwing the ninth inning.

TODAY'S GAME: The Flying Squirrels play the finale of a six-game series against the Binghamton Rumble Ponies, Double-A affiliate of the New York Mets. This is the last series between these two teams this year. Richmond went 1-5 in Binghamton from May 20-25.

PACKING THE HOUSE: Last year, the Flying Squirrels led all 30 Double-A teams in average (6,595) and total (435,295) attendance. Among the 120 MiLB teams, the Flying Squirrels were 10th in average attendance. It was the third straight year the Flying Squirrels led all 30 Double-A clubs in average and total attendance, which had not been done prior to 2022. Last year's total attendance is the highest since 2013 (434,769) and the fourth-highest average in team history. April 4 marked the 15th consecutive Opening Night sellout, marking every home opener in franchise history to date. This year, the Flying Squirrels are averaging 6,779 fans per home game, which ranks third among all 120 MiLB clubs. Their average of 7,290 in the season's first month was the highest April attendance in franchise history.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS are 6-18 in their last 24 games and have dropped three straight since Thursday. They lost four-of-six on the road last week in Erie and in their last home series against the Senators. Of Richmond's 43 losses this season, 23 of them have been by two runs or less (15 by one, eight by two). The Richmond offense is 11th in the Eastern League in runs scored (201). Richmond's pitching staff has a league-high 4.88 ERA.

THE RUMBLE PONIES clinched the Northeast Division First-Half title with a Hartford loss on Friday night. They are locked into this year's postseason in September. Since May 17, Binghamton is 22-3 in its last 25 games, including a 12-game win streak from May 24-June 5. Two of the three losses in that stretch are against Richmond. Binghamton's roster features six players ranked in Baseball America's top-30 Mets prospects list, including SS **Jett Williams** (No. 1), RHP **Jonah Tong** (No. 3), 1B **Ryan Clifford** (No. 9), OF **Nick Morabito** (No. 12), RHP **Jonathan Pintaro** (No. 25) and RHP **Jack Wenninger** (No. 26). MLB.com's top-30 Mets prospects list features six Binghamton players, including Williams (No. 1), Tong (No. 4), Clifford (No. 5), Morabito (No. 17), Pintaro (No. 23), and Wenninger (No. 28).

FOR RICHMOND: Left-hander **John Michael Bertrand** makes his 13th start of the season and the fourth of his career against the SeaWolves. He started the series opener on Tuesday and allowed two runs over five innings, setting a new career high with nine strikeouts. Bertrand threw four scoreless innings in Binghamton on May 23. In his last seven starts since May 4, Bertrand has gone 1-2 with a 2.75 ERA (12 ER/39.1 IP). Bertrand started on Opening Day for the Flying Squirrels on April 4 against Akron, becoming the first pitcher to start back-to-back season openers for the Flying Squirrels. Last year, he was named the Flying Squirrels' Pitcher of the Year after going 7-9 with a 4.32 ERA in 28 outings (27 starts). Bertrand also won the team's Community Service Award. He made two starts with Triple-A Sacramento to close the season. For the year, Bertrand led all Eastern League pitchers with 10 scoreless starts, all at least five innings. He also led all MiLB pitchers defensively in assists (31) and ranked second in total chances (38). He finished the season ranked first among all MiLB pitchers in double plays induced (23), five ahead of the next closest pitcher. Bertrand was named Eastern League Pitcher of the Week twice last year, first for throwing seven perfect innings against the Baysox on April 27 and then for working six hitless innings in Bowie on May 23. Entering 2025, he is rated by Baseball America as having the best control in the Giants system for the second straight year. Bertrand began his collegiate career at Furman University in South Carolina before playing his final two seasons at the University of Notre Dame. He was selected by the Giants in the 10th round of the 2022 MLB Draft. **For more on Bertrand, see page two.**

FOR BINGHAMTON: Right-hander **Jonah Tong** makes his 12th start of the season and his third of the season against the Flying Squirrels. He started the first game of the series on Tuesday and struck out eight batters, allowing one run over 5.1 innings to pick up his third straight win. Tong faced the Flying Squirrels on May 23 and allowed two runs over four innings with six strikeouts in a loss, the most earned runs he has allowed in a start since April 16. Since joining the Rumble Ponies, he has been named Eastern League Pitcher of the Week three times. He was also named EL Pitcher of the Month for May. Tong threw 6.2 innings in a combined seven-inning perfect game on May 10 against Reading, striking out 13 batters. For the season, Tong leads the Eastern League in strikeouts (91) and BAA (.143) and ranked second in ERA (1.99) and fifth in WHIP (1.09). Tong was selected by the Mets in the seventh round of the 2022 MLB Draft out of high school.

DON'T RUN ON RICHMOND: The Flying Squirrels' catching unit of **Adrián Sugastey**, **Zach Morgan** and **Onil Perez** have combined to catch 31 stolen base attempts this season, which is third among the 30 Double-A teams and leads the Eastern League. Sugastey is third among Double-A catchers with 19 runners caught stealing, which is second in the EL. Morgan, now with Triple-A Sacramento, is tied for fourth in the Eastern League with 12.

BERI'S BACK: Outfielder/first baseman **Victor Bericoto** returned to the Richmond roster on June 3. He was placed on the injured list with Triple-A Sacramento on May 9 and played six games with the ACL Giants on a rehab assignment before returning to the Flying Squirrels. Bericoto opened the season with Richmond and hits .319 with three homers, four doubles and eight RBIs in 13 games before being promoted to the River Cats on April 20. In his Richmond career dating back to 2023, Bericoto has homered 26 times, which is the eighth-most in franchise history, one behind a four-way tie for fourth place (**Devin Harris**, **Sean Roby**, **Shane Matheny** and **Will Wilson**).

TAKING THE JAIRO: **Jairo Pomares** has picked up at least one hit in nine-of-his-last-12 games dating back to May 29, batting .372 (16-for-43) with two homers, two doubles, seven RBIs and four walks, raising his season batting average from .185 to .220. That stretch includes five multi-hit games. He hit a solo homer on June 11 at Erie, his first since May 2, snapping a 25-game homerless streak. He went deep again June 8. Pomares leads the team with 22 RBIs this season.

YO ADRIAN: **Adrian Sugastey** has picked up seven RBIs over his last five games dating back to last Sunday. In the series finale at Erie last Sunday afternoon, he went 3-for-5 with a homer, two doubles and a career-best five RBIs. On Tuesday, he drove in the Flying Squirrels' only run with a single. In Wednesday's win, he belted his sixth homer of the year, a solo shot in the fourth, to set a new single-season career high.

NIGHT AT THE ROXBY: Reliever **Braxton Roxby** closed his second save of the season on Wednesday night, recording two outs in the eighth to strand two inherited baserunners before a 1-2-3 ninth. Dating back to April 29, Roxby has pitched 11 consecutive games without allowing an earned run, spanning 15 innings with 18 strikeouts and four walks. The only two runs he has surrendered in that stretch were a pair of unearned runs in the 10th inning on May 27 against the Senators. He has also held opponents hitless in his last two outings since June 6, spanning 4.2 innings.

IN THE LEAGUE LEADERS: In the Eastern League, **Diego Velasquez** is tied for fifth in hits (59) and ranks 10th in OBP (.373). **Seth Lonsway** is fifth in innings pitched (61.0), fifth in strikeouts (65) and ninth in ERA (3.25). **Jack Choate** is fifth in strikeouts (65) and tied for eighth in BAA (.236). **Joe Whitman** is tied for 10th in strikeouts (58). **John Michael Bertrand** is sixth in innings pitched (60.2).

TOP SKIPPER: Flying Squirrels manager **Dennis Pelfrey** has led the team to 221 wins in his career, which is a new franchise record all-time wins record for a manager. He passed the record with Richmond's 6-1 win at Binghamton on May 23. From 2011-2013, **Dave Machemer** won 216 games as Richmond's manager, leading the team to the Eastern League postseason for in 2011. Pelfrey, who has been with Richmond since the 2022 season, led the team to back-to-back postseason appearances for the first time in franchise history in 2022 and 2023. He also managed the 2021 Eugene Emeralds to the High-A West championship.

PROSPECT WATCH: Richmond's roster features five players are ranked in Baseball America's top-30 Giants prospects, including **Joe Whitman** (No. 5), **Diego Velasquez** (No. 10), **Sabin Ceballos** (No. 21) and **Jack Choate** (No. 26). **John Michael Bertrand** is rated as having the best control in the Giants system. **Adrian Sugastey** is ranked as the top defensive catcher. **Aeverso Arteaga** is rated as the best defensive infielder and best infield arm. MLB.com's top-30 Giants prospects list features five Richmond players, including Whitman (No. 7), Velasquez (No. 15), Arteaga (No. 16), Ceballos (No. 23) and Choate (No. 27).

THIS DATE IN RICHMOND BASEBALL HISTORY

1959: The Richmond Virginians beat the Rochester Red Wings, 10-4, at Parker Field. Deron Johnson went 4-for-4 with a triple, an RBI and scored twice. Fritz Brickell had a homer. Frank Leja had a triple, a double and two RBIs.

1970: The Richmond Braves beat the Louisville Colonels, 3-2, at Parker Field. Richmond trailed by a run entering the ninth before Jim Breazeale singled in Ralph Garr to tie the score. Louisville took a 2-1 lead in the top of the ninth. In the bottom of the ninth, Garr tied the game with an RBI single. Hal Breeden won the game with a bases-loaded single to bring home Dusty Baker. Julio Navarro pitched a complete game and struck out 10 batters.

1981: The Richmond Braves beat the Syracuse Chiefs, 8-5 at Parker Field. Jerry Keller won the game with a three-run, walk-off homer in the bottom of the 10th inning. Syracuse led early before Randy Johnson tied the game with a two-run triple and scored on a single by Steve Hammond. Greg Wells hit a solo homer in the eighth to tie the score for Syracuse.

1986: The Richmond Braves beat the Maine Guides, 8-0, at The Diamond. Brad Komminsk hit two homers and drove in five runs in a 3-for-4 game. Paul Zuvella had four hits and drove in two runs. Charlie Puleo started and threw six scoreless innings with five strikeouts.

1991: The Richmond Braves beat the Toledo Mud Hens, 10-4, at The Diamond. Richmond scored eight runs in the first inning, all with two outs. Francisco Cabrera started the scoring with a single. After four straight walks, Victor Rosario hit a two-run single to open a 5-0 lead. Deion Sanders capped the inning with a three-run homer, his third with the R-Braves. Yorkie Perez started for Richmond and allowed three runs over six innings. Randy Kramer was scheduled to start the game but was scratched with shoulder inflammation.

2014: The Flying Squirrels beat the New Hampshire Fisher Cats, 2-0. Adalberto Mejia, Hunter Strickland and Cody Hall combined for a Father's Day shutout at The Diamond. Mejia struck out seven over seven innings. Devin Harris drove in the game's only runs with a two-run homer in the sixth.
