LET'S GET OVER: After improbably getting back to .500 after being 12 games under just 16 days ago, the FredNats are very much in the picture in the Carolina League North Division in the first half with less than two weeks to go before the midpoint of the season. Tonight, the team will try to win its fourth straight against the Charleston RiverDogs and their sixth straight overall. The FredNats' only loss since May 23 came last Friday night against Delmarva. The team is now over .500 at home this year, and is 9-1 on this current two-week home stand. Tonight, Luke Young makes his second professional start after dominating the Shorebirds to the tune of just two base runners allowed in four innings in his first start last week.

ABOUT LAST NIGHT: Daylen Lile had a big game with a three-run homer and four total RBI, and Bryan Caceres allowed just one unearned run in five strong innings to earn his third win in a 6-1 triumph for the FredNats. Brad Lord pitched three scoreless innings of relief, and Matt Merrill finished it off for the win. Wilmer Perez also had an RBI double in the game.

STANDINGS WATCH: With less than two weeks to go in the first half, the FredNats have risen to third place in the North Division, just five games out of first place behind Down East and Carolina. The Wood Ducks are alone in first, one game ahead of the Mudcats. Carolina has lost the first three games of the week against Fayetteville, and Down East has won two out of three against Delmarva. The FredNats will need to keep winning and need some help, but with 12 games left in the first half, there is certainly time for the FredNats to make a move.

RE-LILE-BLE: Daylen Lile had one of his biggest games of his career so far last night, going 2-for-4 with a three-run homer, an RBI single and a walk. He tied a game-high this year for a FredNat with 4 RBI, and has now driven in 31 runs this year to lead the team. He has a wRC+ of 136 (100 is average), and a wOBA of .394, which is above average and shows that his extra base power has brought extra value to this FredNat offense.

BULLPEN WORK: In this unbelievable stretch for the FredNats, the bullpen has been a huge reason for the team's success. In the bullpen's last 60.1 innings, the group has allowed just 10 earned runs for an ERA of 1.49, and opponents are hitting .176 against the group. Six different pitchers have recorded saves this year, and the strikeout-to-walk ratio during this time frame is 4-to-1.

BIG HIT WITT: The emergence of Paul Witt as a reliable power bat for the FredNats has been one of the keys to this stretch of 12 wins in the last 13 games for the FredNats. He's hit the go-ahead home run in the 8th inning Wednesday night, his team-high 6th of the year. He put up a .966 OPS in the month of May, and now his OPS is .946 in June. He's been hitting in key spots in the FredNat order in the DH role for the past couple weeks, and has come through time and time again.

CARDIAC NATS: The FredNats have come up big in clutch situations of late, and the team's record has drastically improved because of it. The FredNats already have five walk-off wins this year, which leads all of MiLB. Three of those walk-offs came last week against Delmarva. The team is 10-6 in one-run games, including the first two games of this series, and have won six out of the last seven one-run affairs overall. The FredNats are also 4-1 in extra innings this year, with three of those wins coming in walk-off fashion.

THE SKIP IS BACK: The FredNats' leader from 2022 returns to the Managerial role for 2023. Jake Lowery is back for another year in the 'Burg after winning the Washington organizational Manager of the Year award last year after leading the FredNats to a 75-55 record. Lowery, 32, was selected by Cleveland in the fourth round of the 2011 Draft out of James Madison University, where he was given the Johnny Bench Award as the nation's top collegiate catcher. The Midlothian, Virginia native played in the Nationals organization from 2016 to 2019, including parts of two seasons with the Potomac Nationals. Lowery reached the Triple-A level in 2018 and transitioned to a managerial role in 2021 after nine seasons in the minor leagues. Lowery is the 28th manager in franchise history dating back to 1978.

THE STAFF: Joining Lowery on the staff is returning hitting coach Delwyn Young, pitching coach Justin Lord, returning developmental coach Carmelo Jaime, athletic trainer Jacob Meyer, strength and conditioning coach Nathan Sier, and Performance Analyst Josh Frelich. Young, 41, played parts of five major league seasons with the Dodgers (2006-08) and Pirates (2009-10), and participated in spring training with the Nationals in 2013. Under his guidance, The FredNats' offense scored the most runs in the Carolina League in 2022. He previously served as a hitting coach with Kingsport and Brooklyn in the Mets system, and spent the 2021 season managing the State College Spikes of the MLB Draft League.

Lord, 43, begins his fourth year in the Washington organization after serving as the Pitching Coach for the Double-A Harrisburg Senators last season. Lord was scheduled to be the FredNats' Pitching Coach in the team's inaugural season in Fredericksburg in 2020, but that season was ultimately canceled due to Covid. Jaime, 37, was Detroit's 24th round selection in the 2008 Draft out of Miami Dade College. The Santo Domingo, Dominican Republic native reached Double-A in his three-year minor league career, and he returns with Lowery and Young as holdovers from last year's FredNat coaching staff. Meyer begins his sixth season in the Washington organization and first in Fredericksburg after spending the first five years of his Nationals career at the Spring Training facility in West Palm Beach, Florida. Sier begins his first year in the Washington organization after previous stops with Macomb Community College in Metro Detroit (Mich.), and 2SP Sports. Frelich steps into the newly-created Performance Analyst role after previous stops with the L.A. Dodgers and Boston Red Sox.

TONIGHT'S START: Luke Young makes his second professional start for the FredNats tonight against the Charleston Riverdogs. Young's season, much like his fellow relievers, started out a bit rocky before turning around in May. Young worked to an ERA of 8.49 in April, but dropped it to 3.00 in five appearances throughout May.

SELF MADE: Young was very lightly recruited as a high-schooler, with his fastball sitting in the mid 80's. He elected to go to Midland Junior College in Texas, where he got the heater up to 96 MPH. That earned him an offer to pitch at Oklahoma State, but Young elected to sign with the Nationals.

LAST TIME OUT: Jake Lowery described Young as "dominant" in his first pro start last week against the Shorebirds. Young was nearly flawless in his four innings, allowing just one base hit and hitting a batter as he shutout Delmarva, while striking out four.
