He homered on the game's first pitch (423 ft to CF off LHP Joe Rock), doubled, and tripled in his first three at-bats, then struck out and walked in his final two (3-for-4, 2 RBI) ... It's the second time in his career that Kelenic has finished a single away from a cycle (7/7/22 with Triple-A Tacoma at Reno, 3-for-5, 2 RBI) ... The lone cycle by a Striper remains **Braden Shewmake** on 6/28/23 at St. Paul.

LEO STRIKES LAST: Eddys Leonard notched his first last-at-bat GWRBI with Gwinnett last night (9th-inning sacrifice fly), giving the Stripers their fourth last-at-bat win of the season ... He leads the club in total bases (45), extra-base hits (12), triples (2), homers (5), and OPS (.736).

GET A WHIFF OF THIS: Led by **Davis Daniel's** season-high eight strikeouts over 6.0 innings last night, the Gwinnett staff combined to fan 13 Durham hitters ... It's the Stripers' 18th double-digit strikeout effort in 35 games this season (51.4% of games played).

CAN'T STOP C-ROD: Carlos Rodriguez has hit safely in 24 of 28 games between Double-A Columbus and Gwinnett this season, batting .306 (34-for-111, 2 2B, 1 HR, 13 R, 10 RBI, 7 SB, .693 OPS) between the two levels ... Thus far in May, he's batting .346 (9-for-26) in seven games.

MAGIC WANDER: Wander Suero is 2-for-2 in saves after last night's outing (1.0 IP, 0 H, 0 R, 2 SO) ... Through 13 games with Gwinnett, he owns a 1.84 ERA (3 ER in 14.2 IP), 1.43 WHIP, and .250 BAA ... Over 209 career Triple-A outings with six teams (SYR, ROC, SL, OKC, SUG, GWN), Suero is 21-13 with a 3.20 ERA, 1.24 WHIP, .224 BAA, and 69 saves (69-for-78, 88.5%).

RETURN OF KIMBREL: Craig Kimbrel, back with Gwinnett for the first time since 2009-10, is 1-0 with a 2.84 ERA (2 ER in 6.1 IP), 1.26 WHIP, .136 BAA, and one save (1-for-2) in six relief appearances with the Stripers ... His 24 saves (24-for-28) with Gwinnett are second-most in club history behind only **Jairo Asencio** (53-for-64 from 2009-10).

ANDERSON BACK AGAIN: 2021 World Series hero **Ian Anderson** started for Gwinnett on Tuesday (ND, 3.0 IP, 5 H, 1 ER, 1 BB, 2 SO) in his first game since being outrighted by Atlanta on 5/1 ... He was claimed off waivers from the Los Angeles Angels on 4/27, just over a month after he was traded for current Stripers teammate **Jose Suarez** (3/23) ... Anderson's entire 25-start Triple-A career is with the Stripers (2019, 2021-24), as he has gone 5-6 with a 5.00 ERA, 1.57 WHIP, .257 BAA, and five quality starts.

THIS IS 40: **Jesse Chavez**, re-signed by Atlanta to a MiLB deal on 4/30, rejoined the Stripers for his third stint with the club this year (3/28-30, 4/4-22, 5/1-current) ... He is the first player in Gwinnett history to appear in two different seasons after turning 40 ... Since his 40th birthday on 8/21/23, he has posted a 0.66 ERA, 0.88 WHIP, .157 BAA, and two saves (2-for-2) in 11 games (1 start) with the Stripers.

HE GOES TO ELEVEN: **Nathan Wiles** set a career high with 11 strikeouts in a tough-luck loss on 5/2 vs. Nashville (6.0 IP, 5 H, 3 R, 3 ER, 0 BB) ... It was four more strikeouts than his previous high of seven (3x, last: 8/18/23 with Durham vs. Gwinnett) ... The total was two shy of matching the Gwinnett single-game record of 13, set by **Bryse Wilson** (8/15/18 vs. Louisville) and tied by **Spencer Strider** (4/10/25 at Norfolk) ... Through five starts with the Stripers, Wiles has a 2.16 ERA (6 ER in 25.0 IP), 0.96 WHIP, .198 BAA, two quality starts, and team-high 32 strikeouts.

47 AND COUNTING: **Ian Anderson** and **Austin Cox** are the 46th and 47th players to appear for Gwinnett already this season ... Last year's club had 66 players in 150 games ... The Gwinnett record for most players is 83 (2023).
